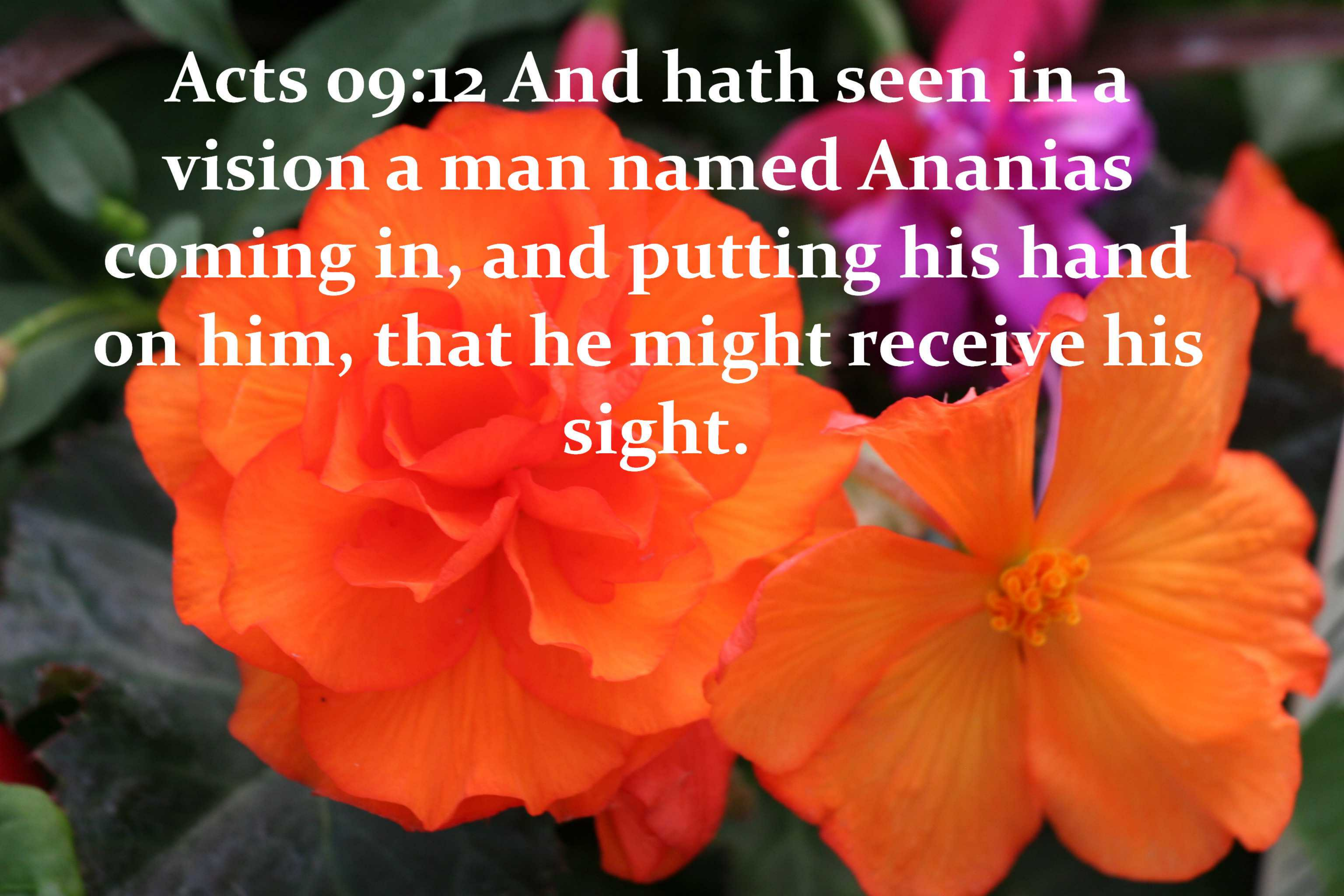


Acts 05:03 But Peter said, Ananias,

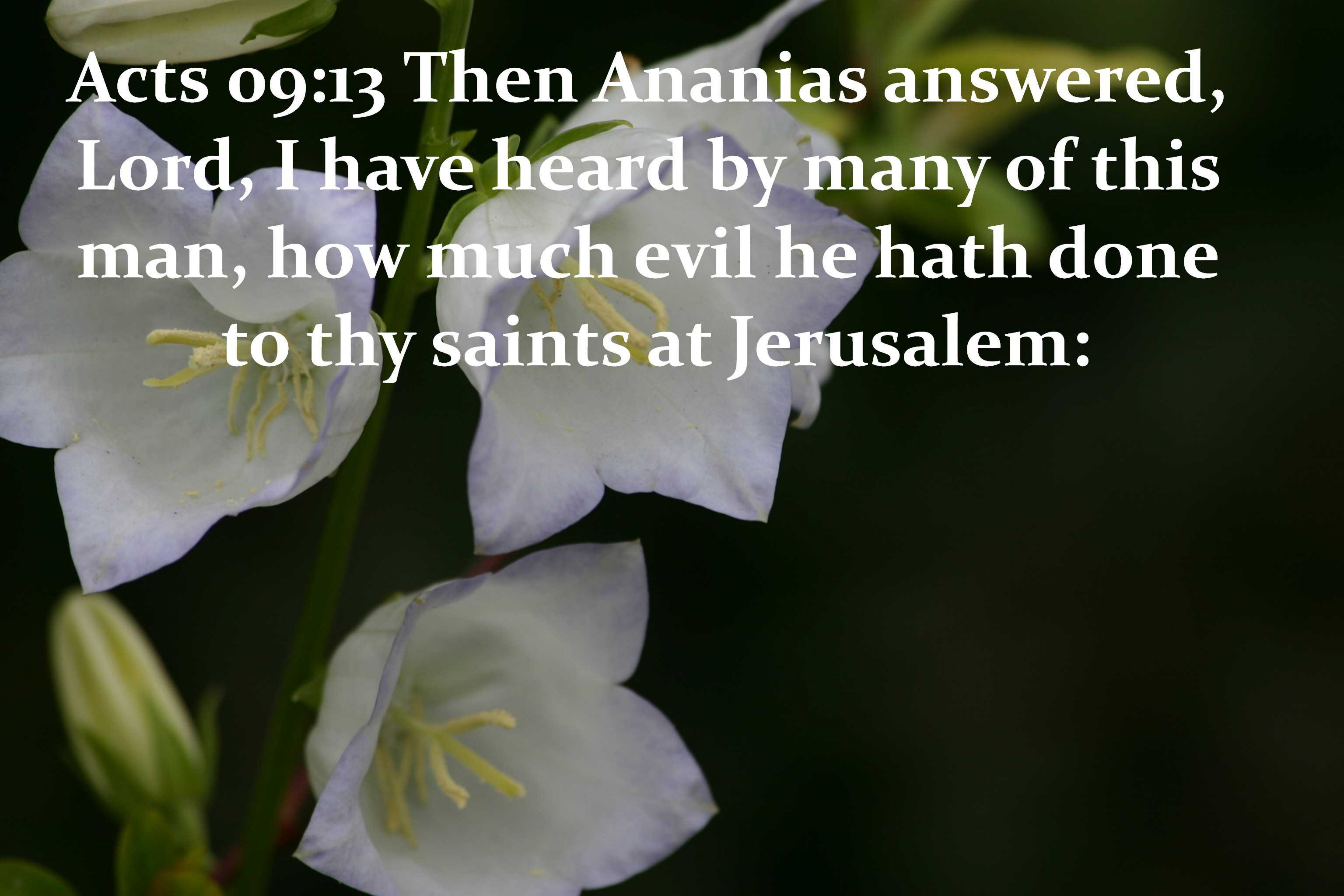
Acts 05:05 And Ananias hearing

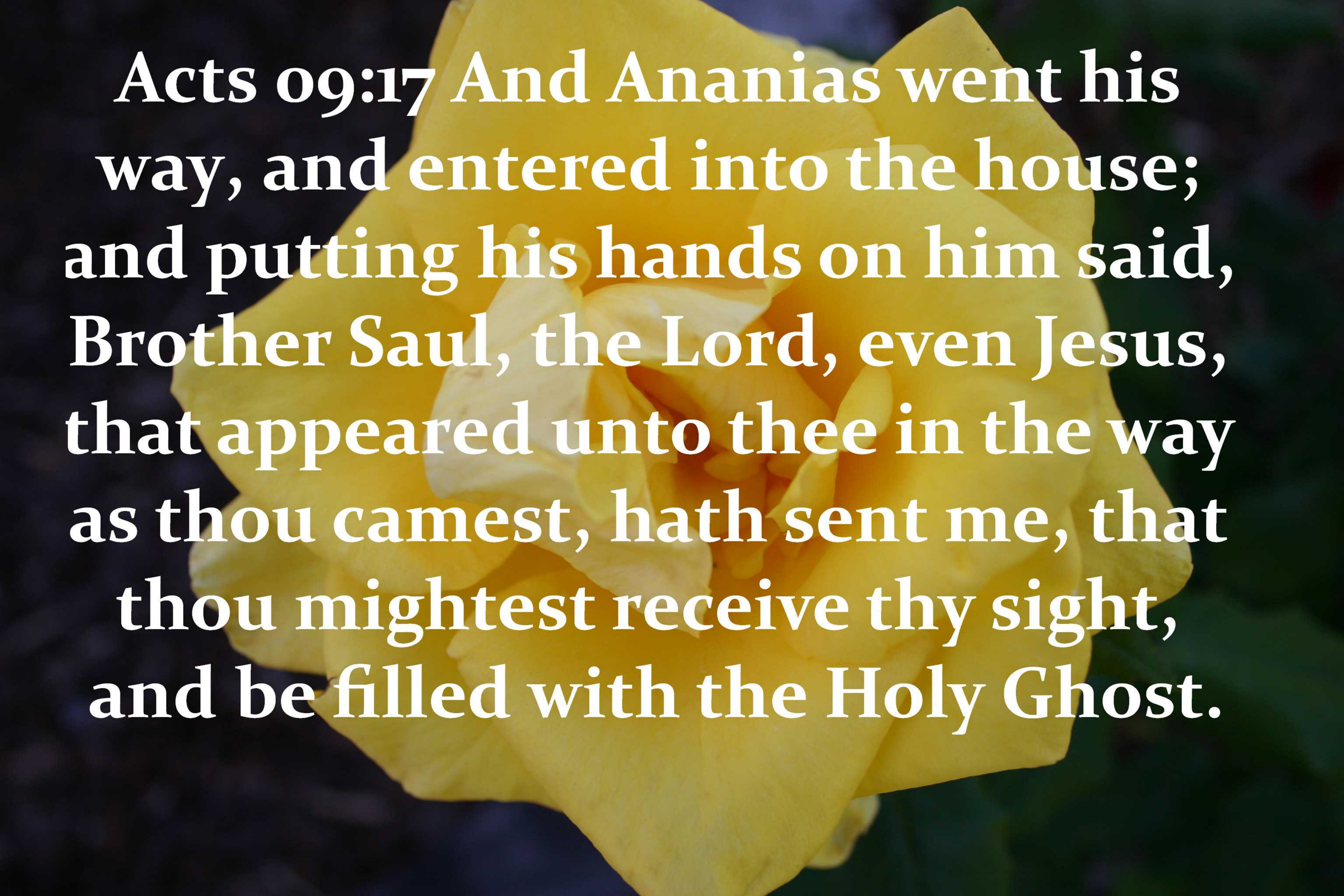
Acts 09:10 And there was a certain

to thy saints at Jerusalem:**

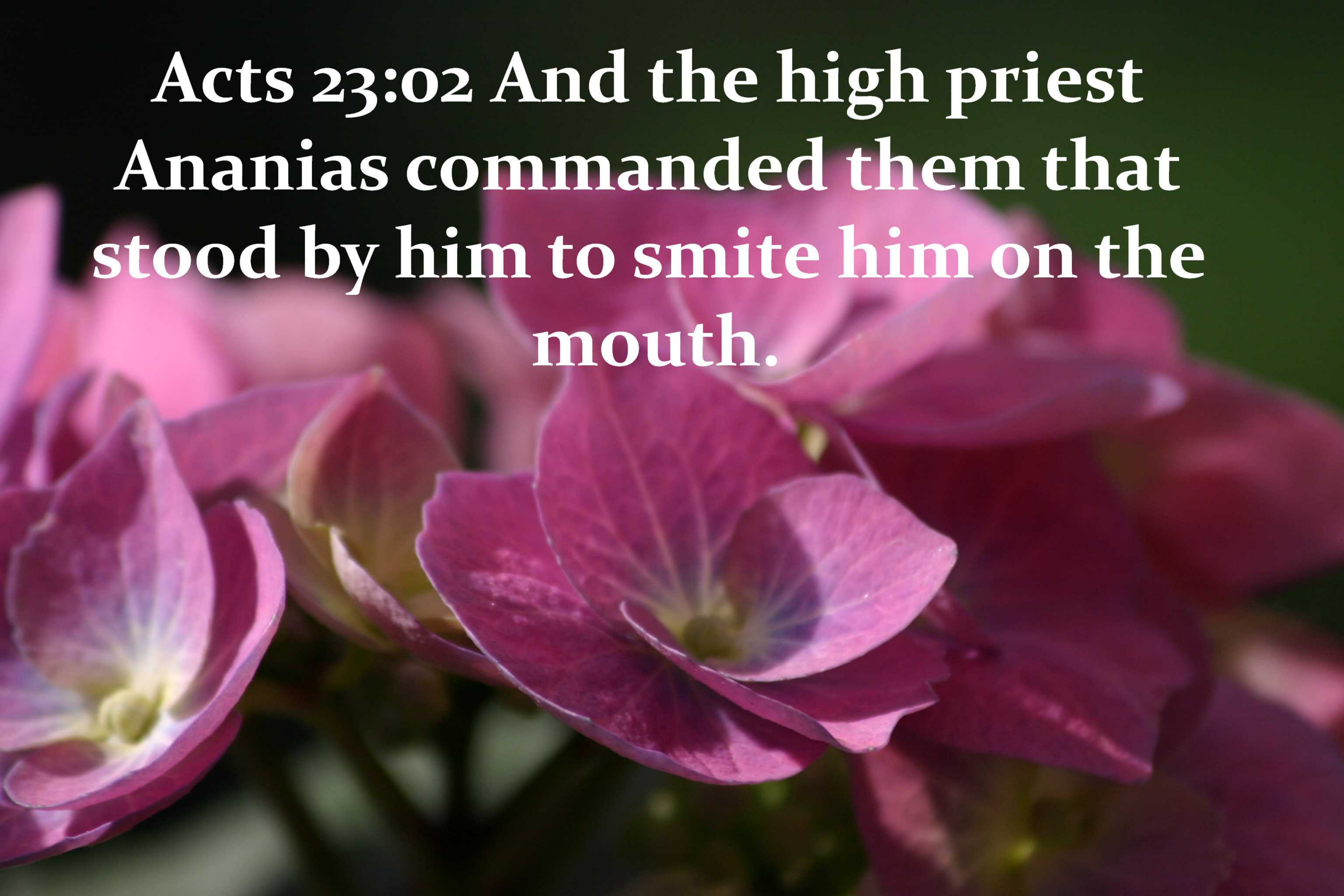

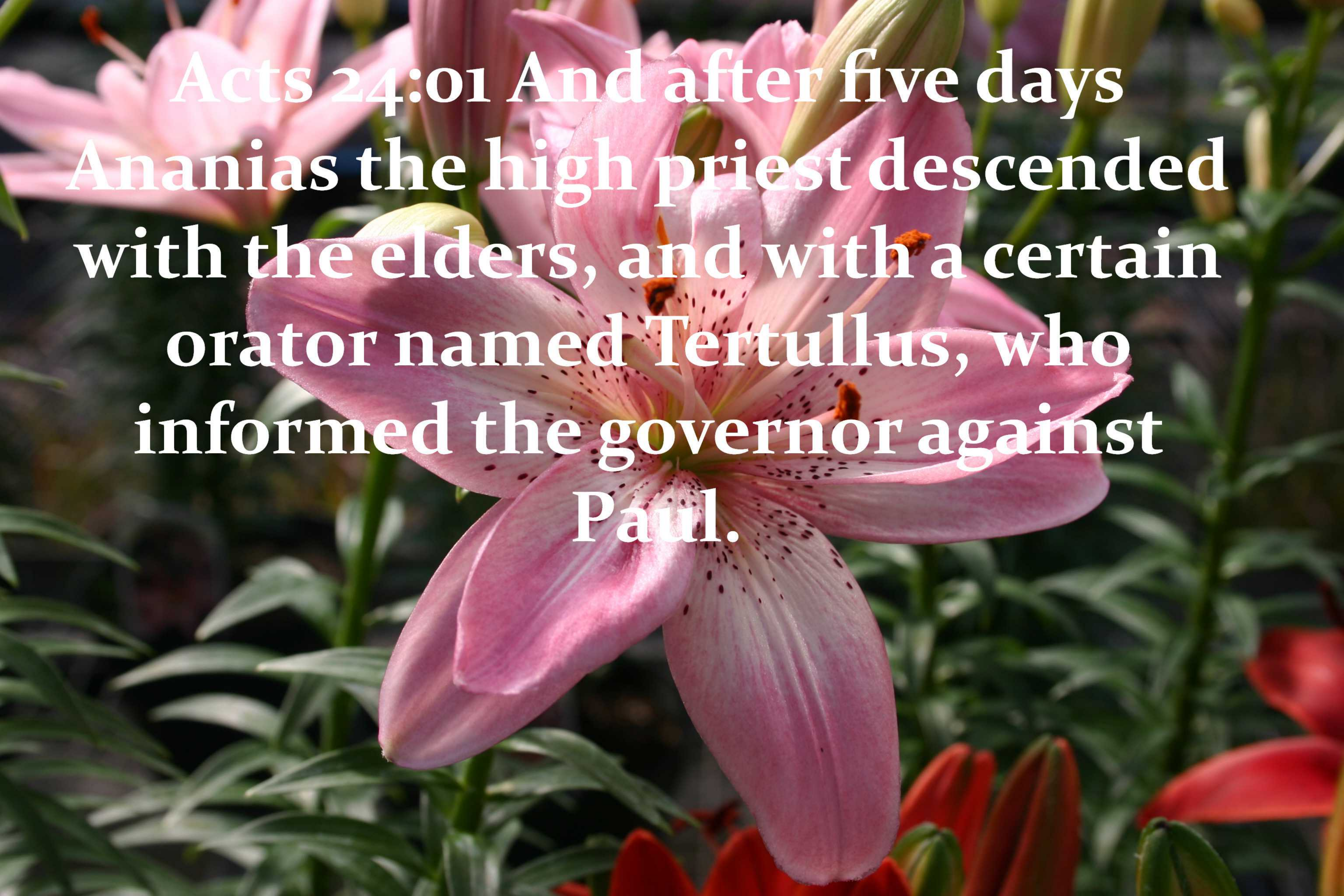
