



**Matthew 04:18 And Jesus, walking

fishers.




Mark 01:29 And forthwith, when

James and John.




Mark 03:18 And Andrew, and

Mark 13:03 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately,




Luke 06:14 Simon, whom he also named Peter, and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,
