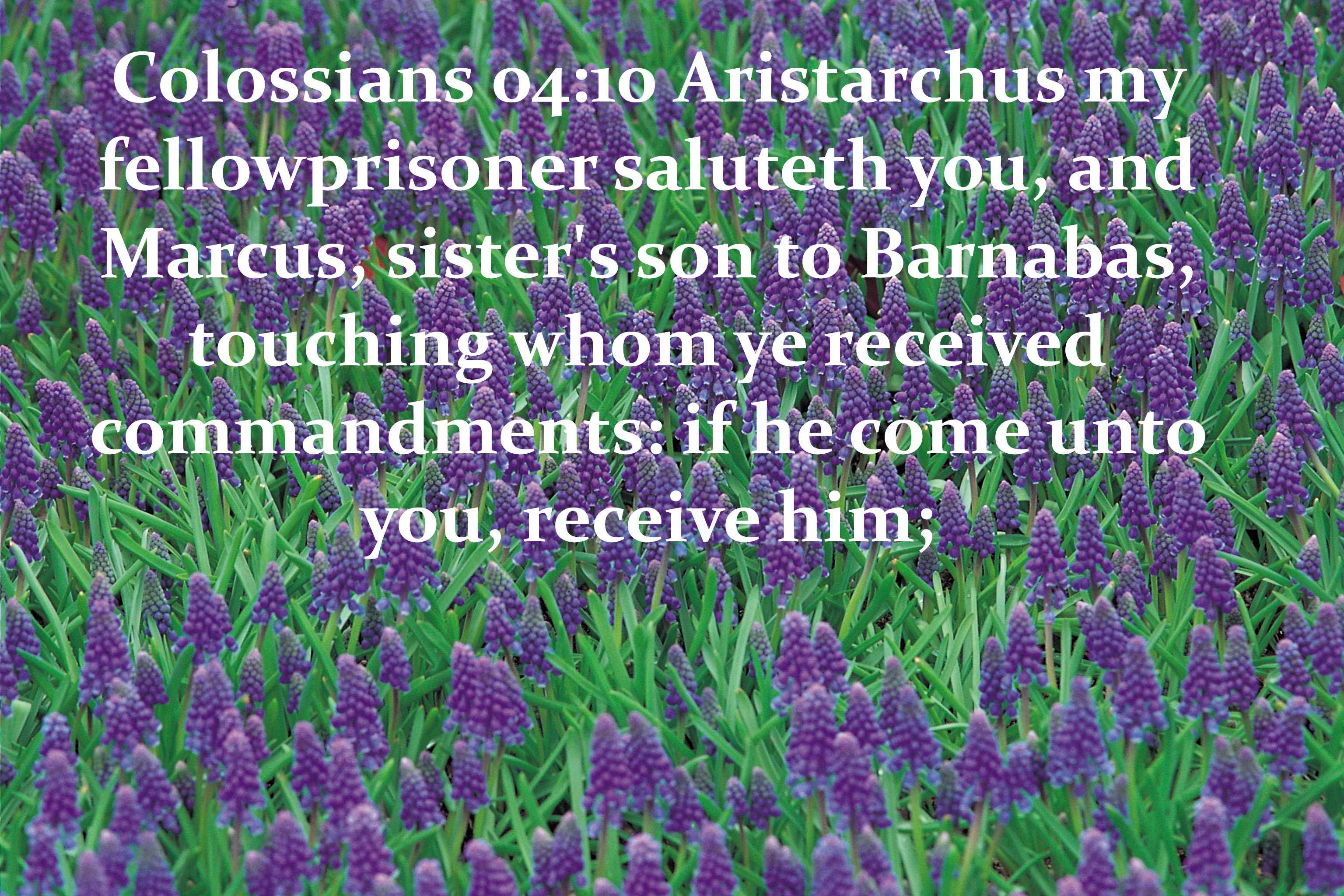
Acts 20:04 And there accompanied
