


Ezra 04:07 And in the days of

Syrian tongue.


Ezra 04:08 Rehum the chancellor

river, and at such a time.**



by force and power.




Ezra 07:01 Now after these things,


Ezra 07:07 And there went up some

king.






Ezra 07:12 Artaxerxes, king of

a time.




Ezra 07:21 And I, even I Artaxerxes

it be done speedily,




Ezra 08:01 These are now the chief
