



1st Kings 15:09 And in the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel reigned Asa over Judah.








1st Kings 15:16 And there was war between Asa and Baasha king of Israel all their days.



Ist Kings 15:17 And Baasha king of Israel went up against Judah, and built Ramah, that he might not suffer any to go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.


