roe.



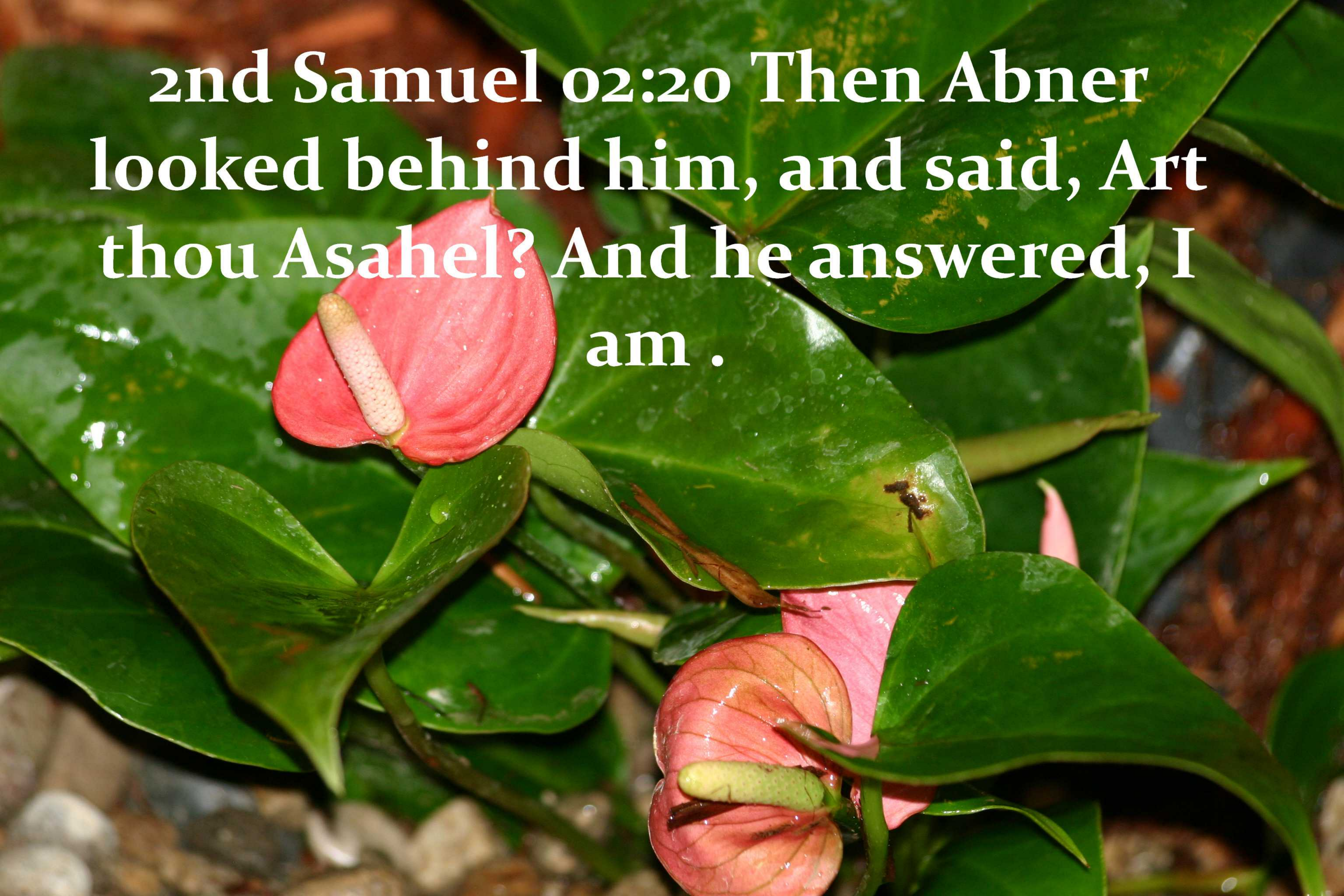







2nd Samuel 02:32 And they took up
