







**Acts 06:09 Then there arose


**Acts 16:06 Now when they had

and Greeks.






Acts 19:22 So he sent into




Acts 19:27 So that not only this our

into the theatre.







Acts 20:04 And there accompanied


Acts 21:27 And when the seven days were almost ended, the Jews which were of Asia, when they saw him in the temple, stirred up all the people, and laid hands on him,






Acts 24:18 Whereupon certain Jews

being with us.

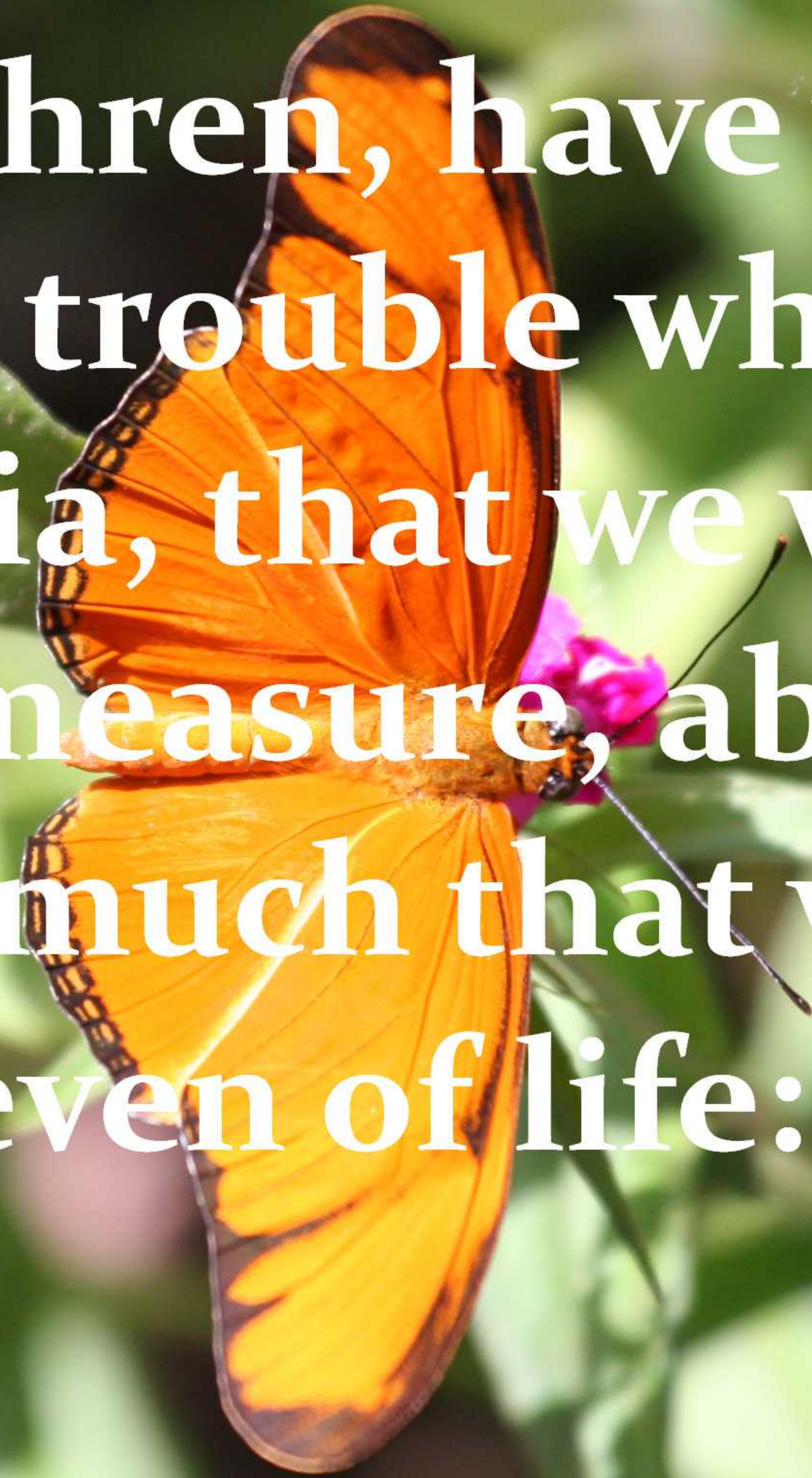





**1st Corinthians 16:19 The churches




1st Peter 01:01 Peter, an apostle of
