


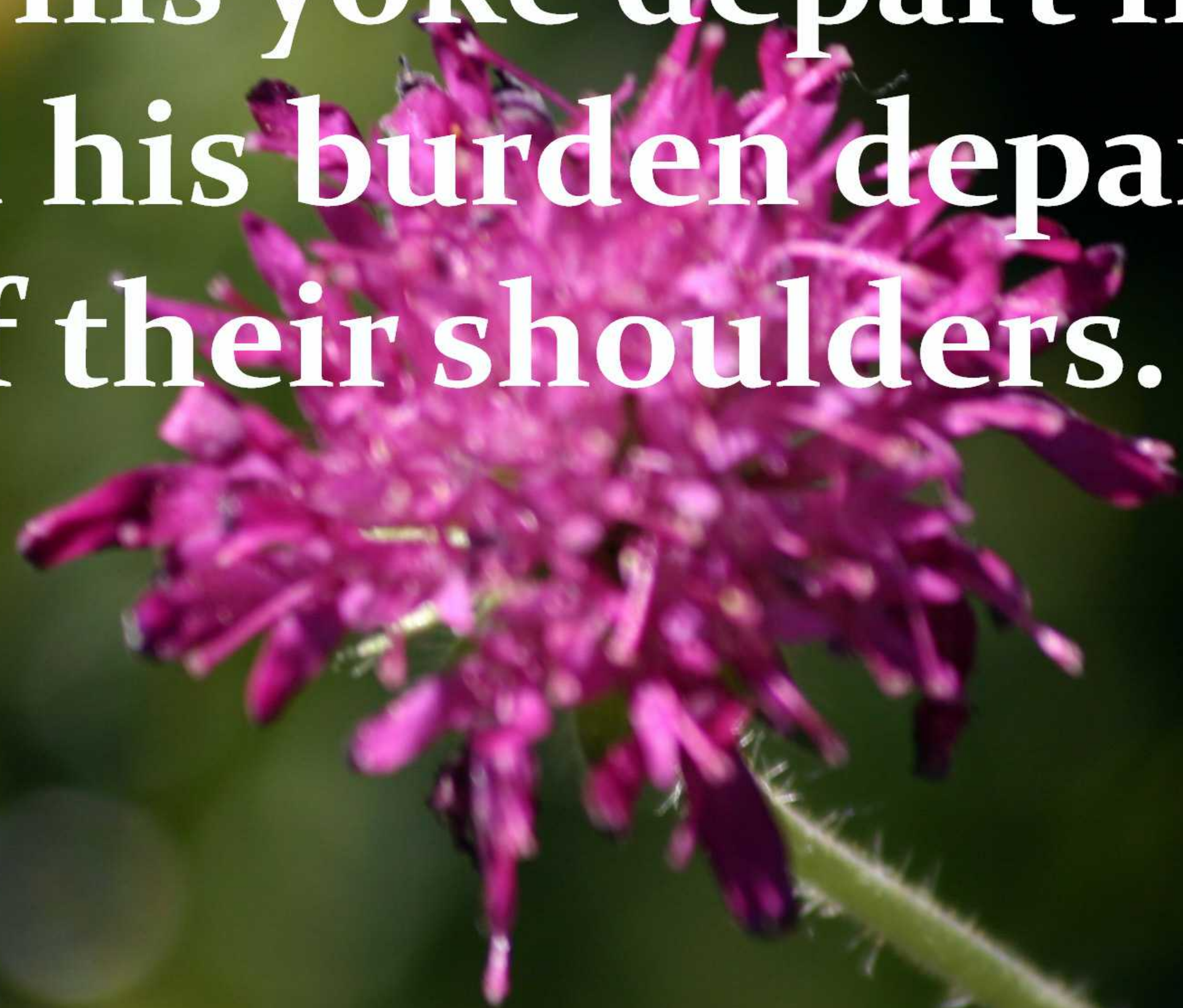
Isaiah 10:05 O Assyrian, the rod of

hand is mine indignation.




Isaiah 10:24 Therefore thus saith

off their shoulders.**



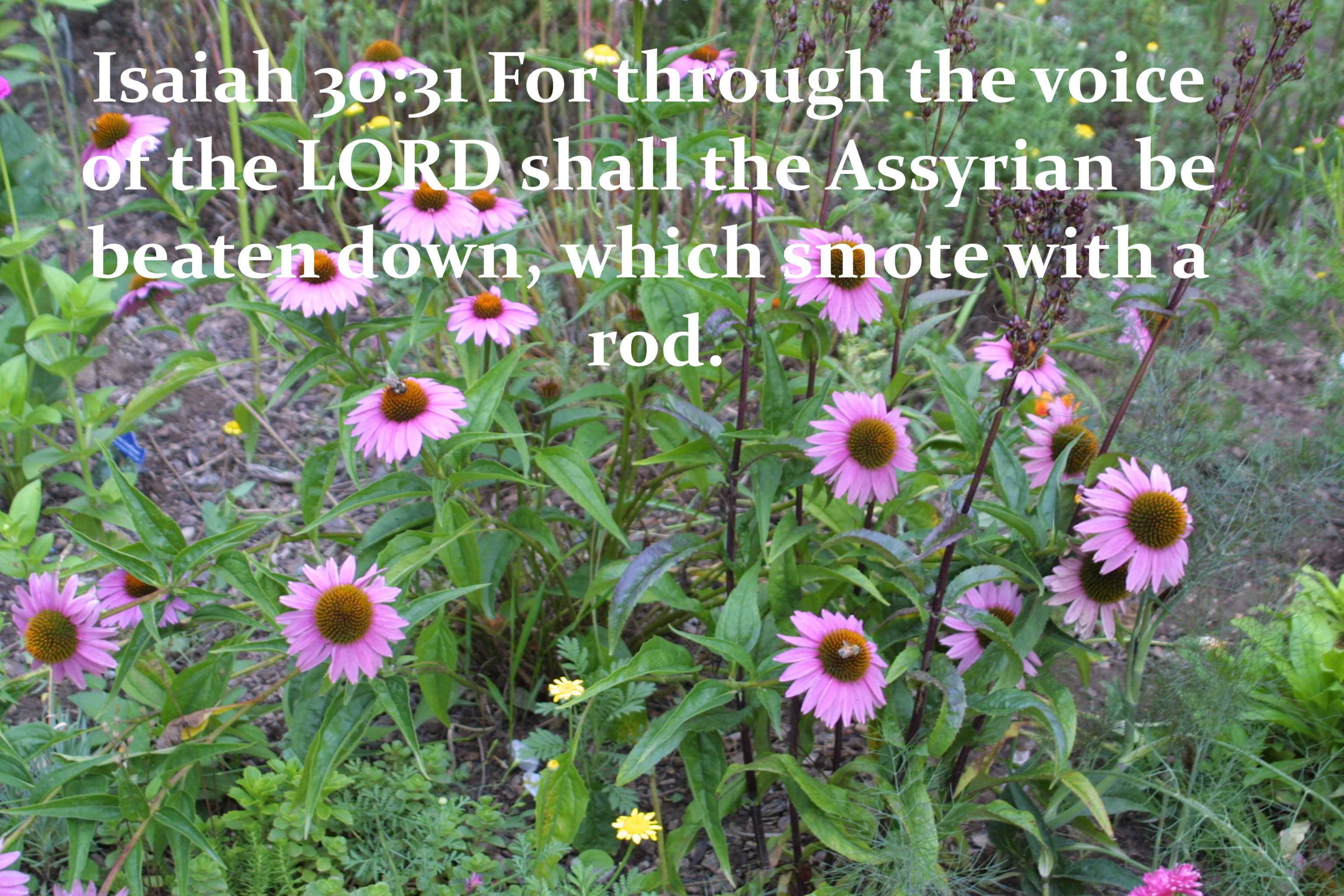



Isaiah 19:23 In that day shall there

shall serve with the Assyrians.




Isaiah 23:13 Behold the land of the

rod.






Isaiah 31:08 Then shall the

discomfited.




Isaiah 52:04 For thus saith the Lord

boughs.

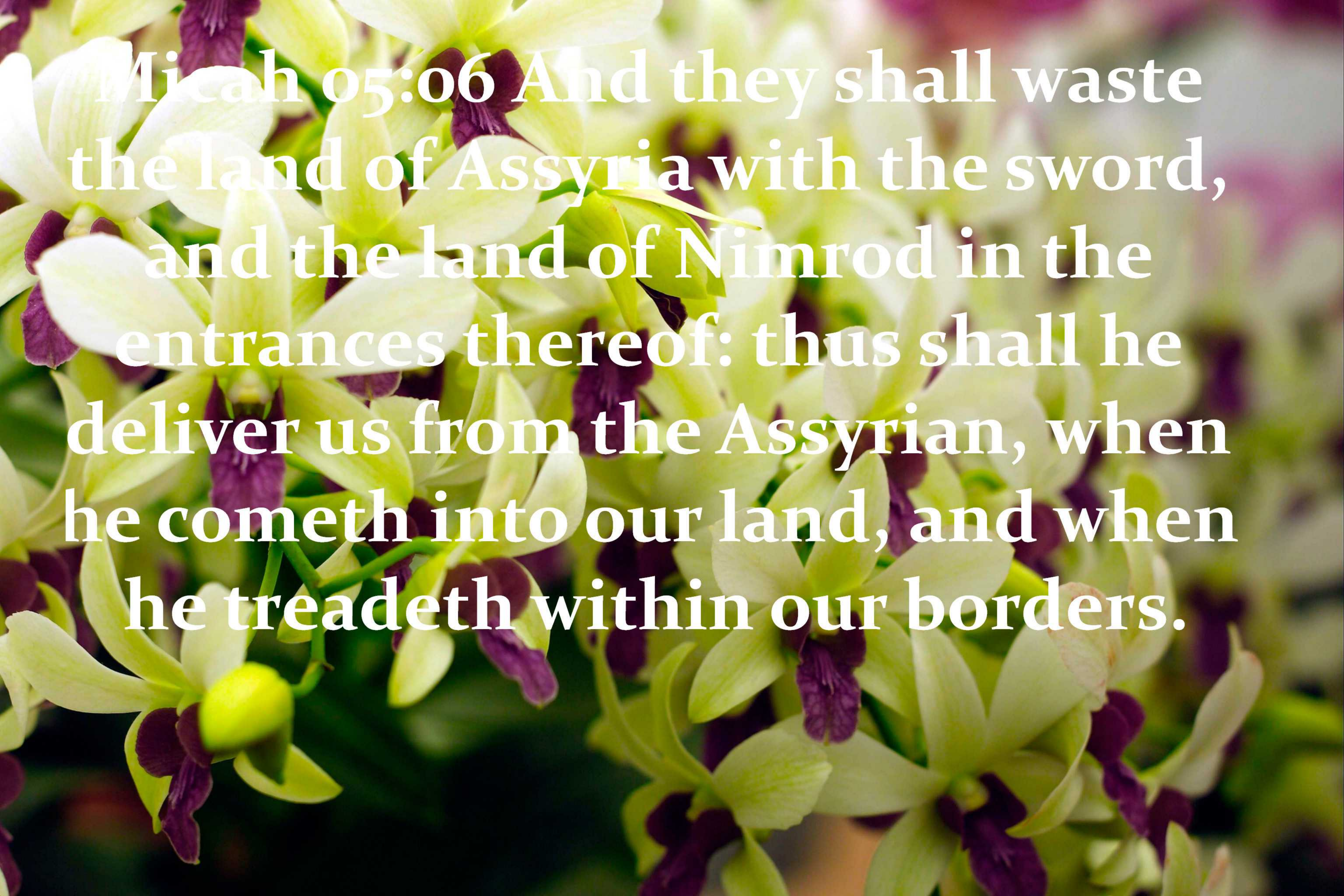
**Hosea 05:13 When Ephraim saw his
