



Judges 05:12 Awake, awake,

thou hast commanded.




Psalms 17:15 As for me, I will

my cause, my God and my Lord.






Psalms 44:23 Awake, why sleepest thou, O Lord? arise, cast us not off for ever.

will awake early.




Psalms 59:04 They run and prepare

awake to help me, and behold.




Psalms 59:05 Thou therefore, O

wicked transgressors. Selah.




Psalms 108:02 Awake, psaltery and  
harp: I myself will awake early.




Psalms 139:18 If I should count

still with thee.




Proverbs 23:35 They have stricken

my love, till he please.



them?


Habakkuk 02:19 Woe unto him

hand upon the little ones.**


Mark 04:38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?




John 11:11 These things said he: and after that he saith unto them, Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.




Romans 13:11 And that, knowing
