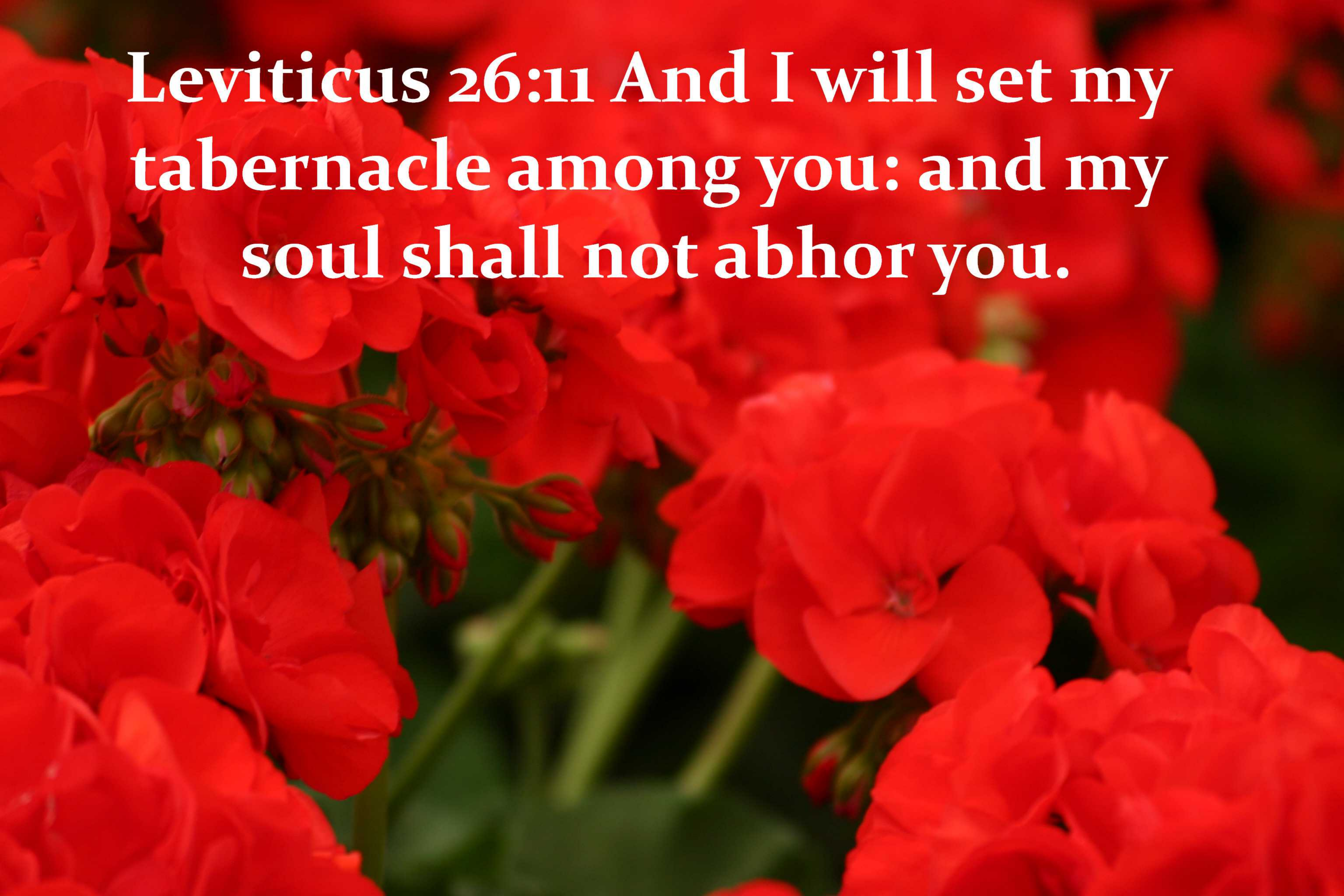
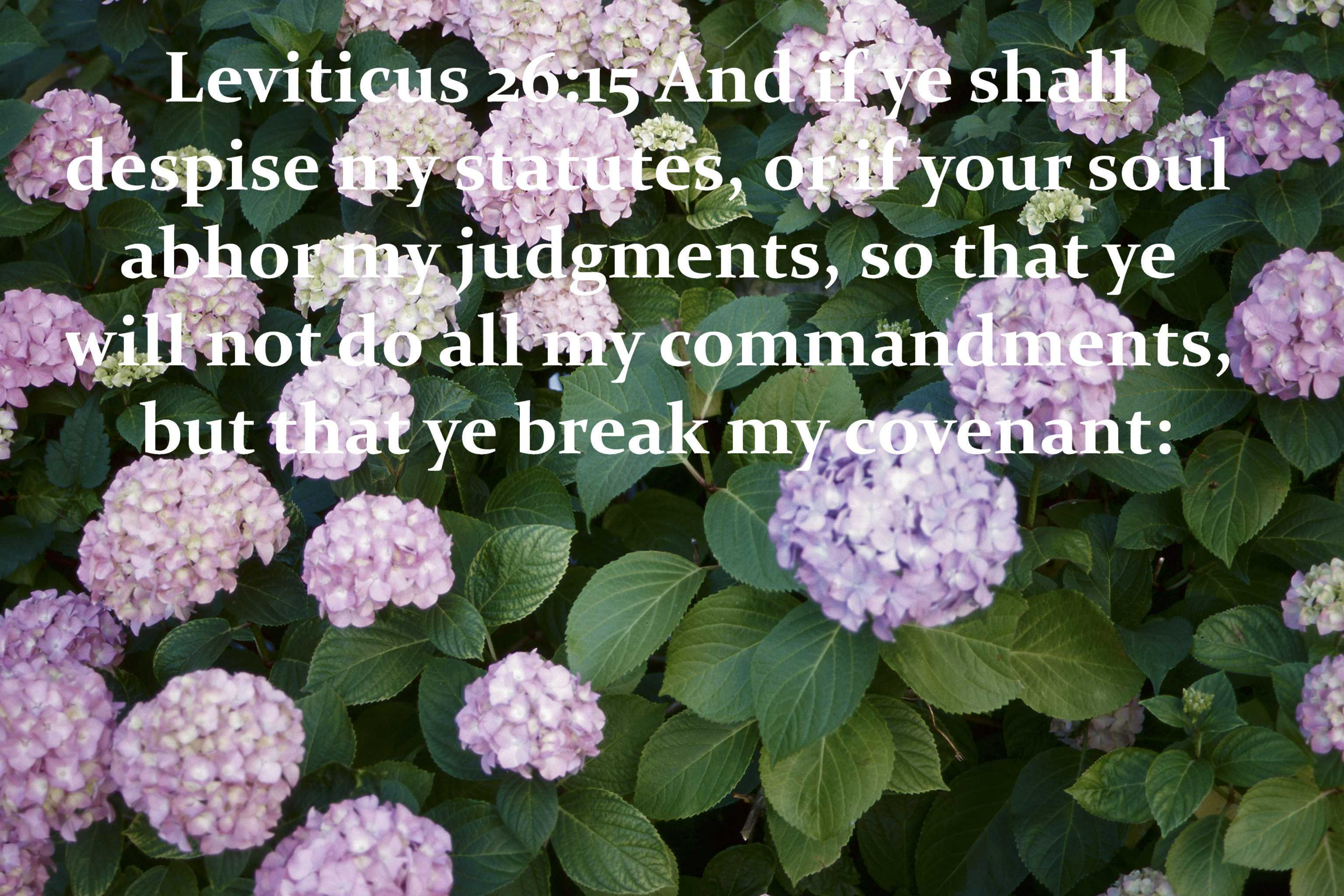


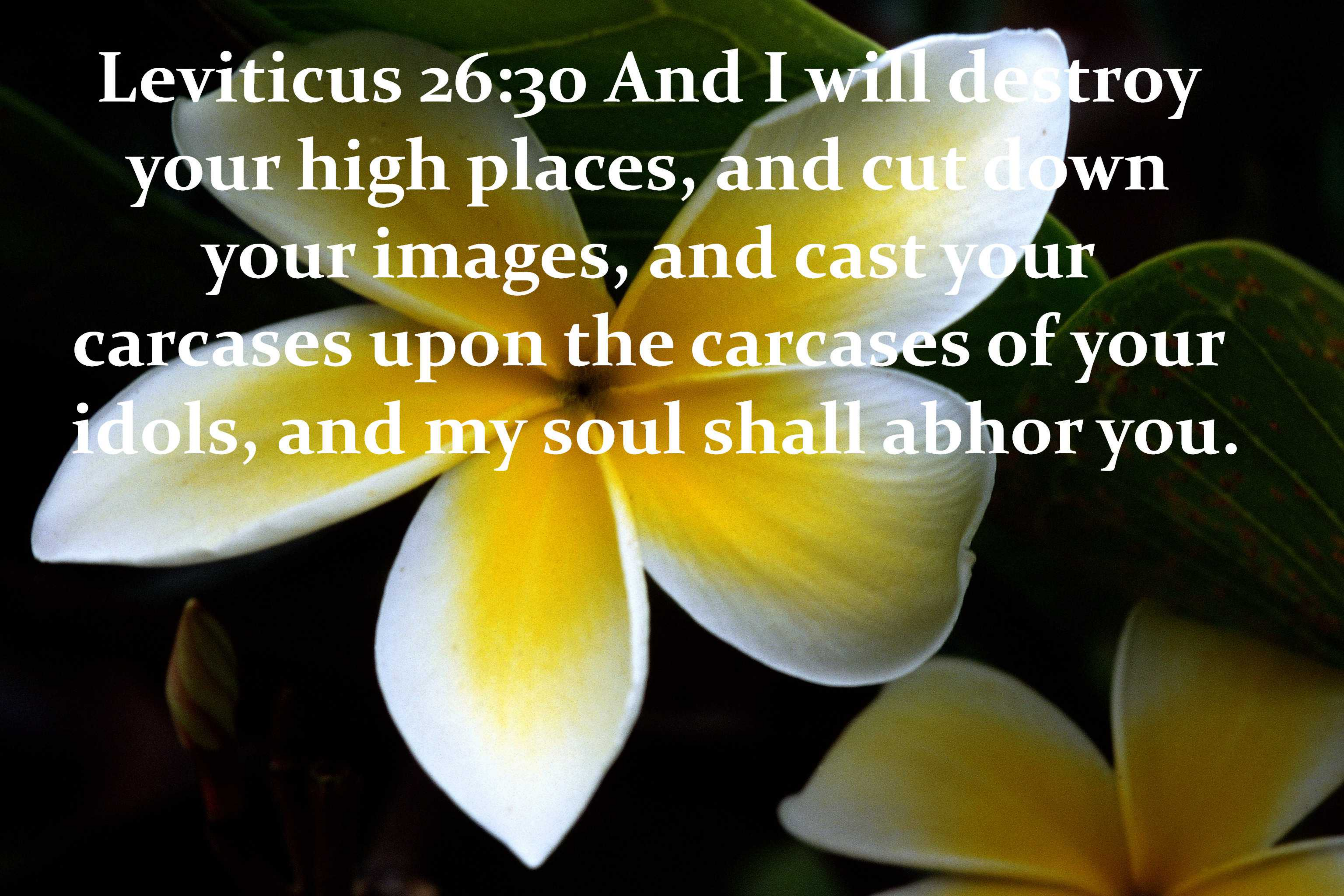

soul shall not abhor you.



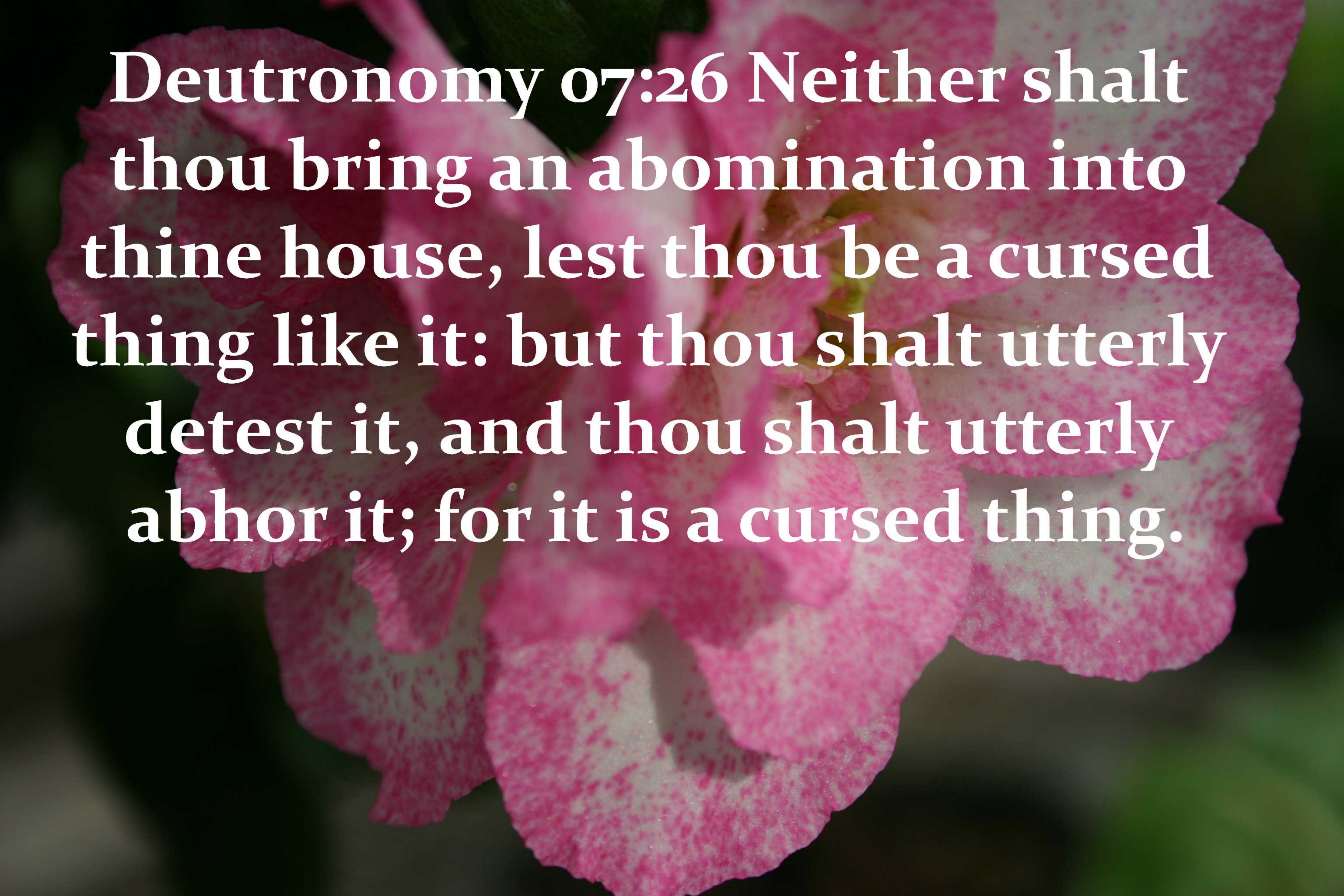
Leviticus 26:15 And if ye shall

idols, and my soul shall abhor you.



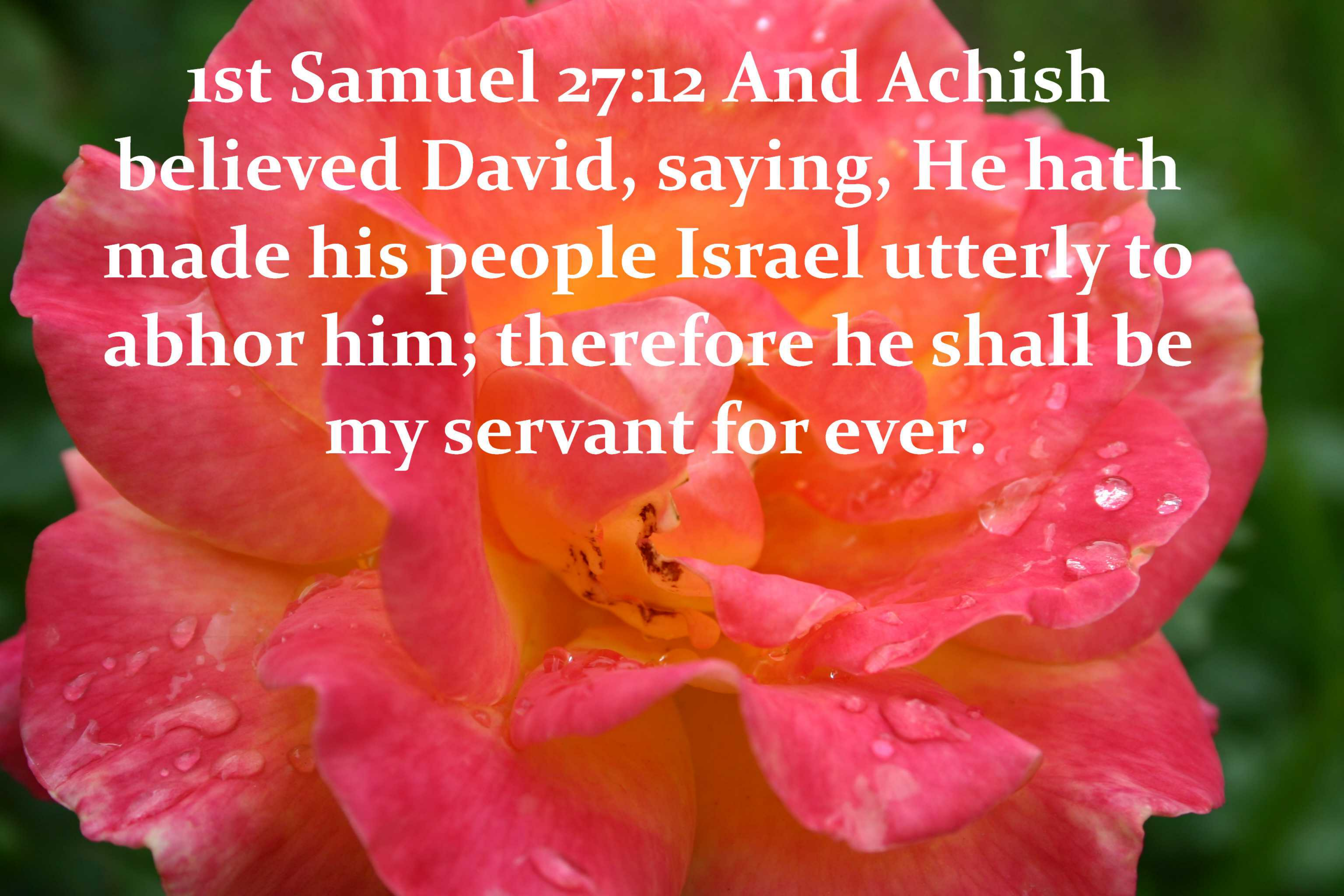
Leviticus 26:44 And yet for all that,
