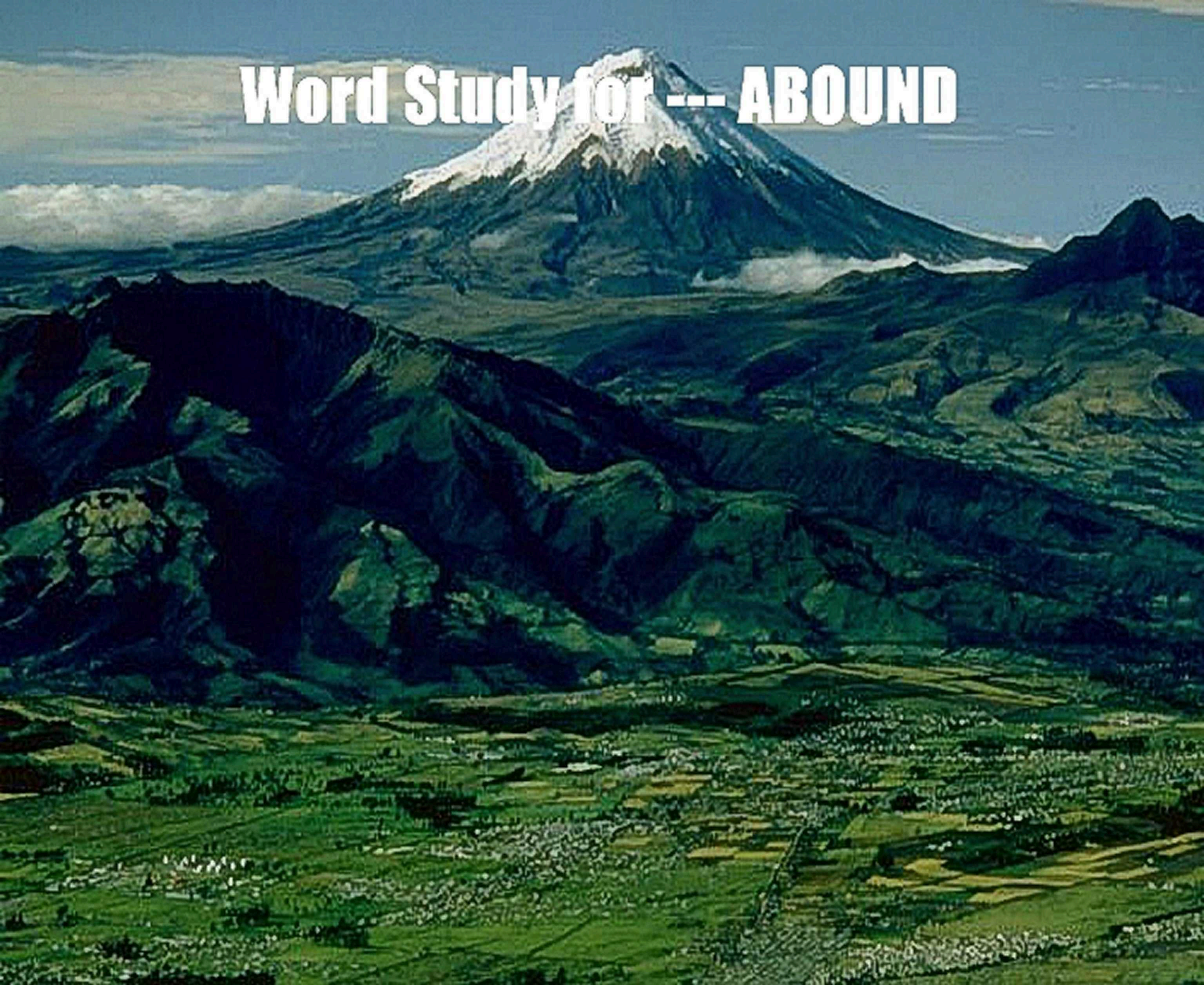


Word Study for --- ABOUND



Romans 05:20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:



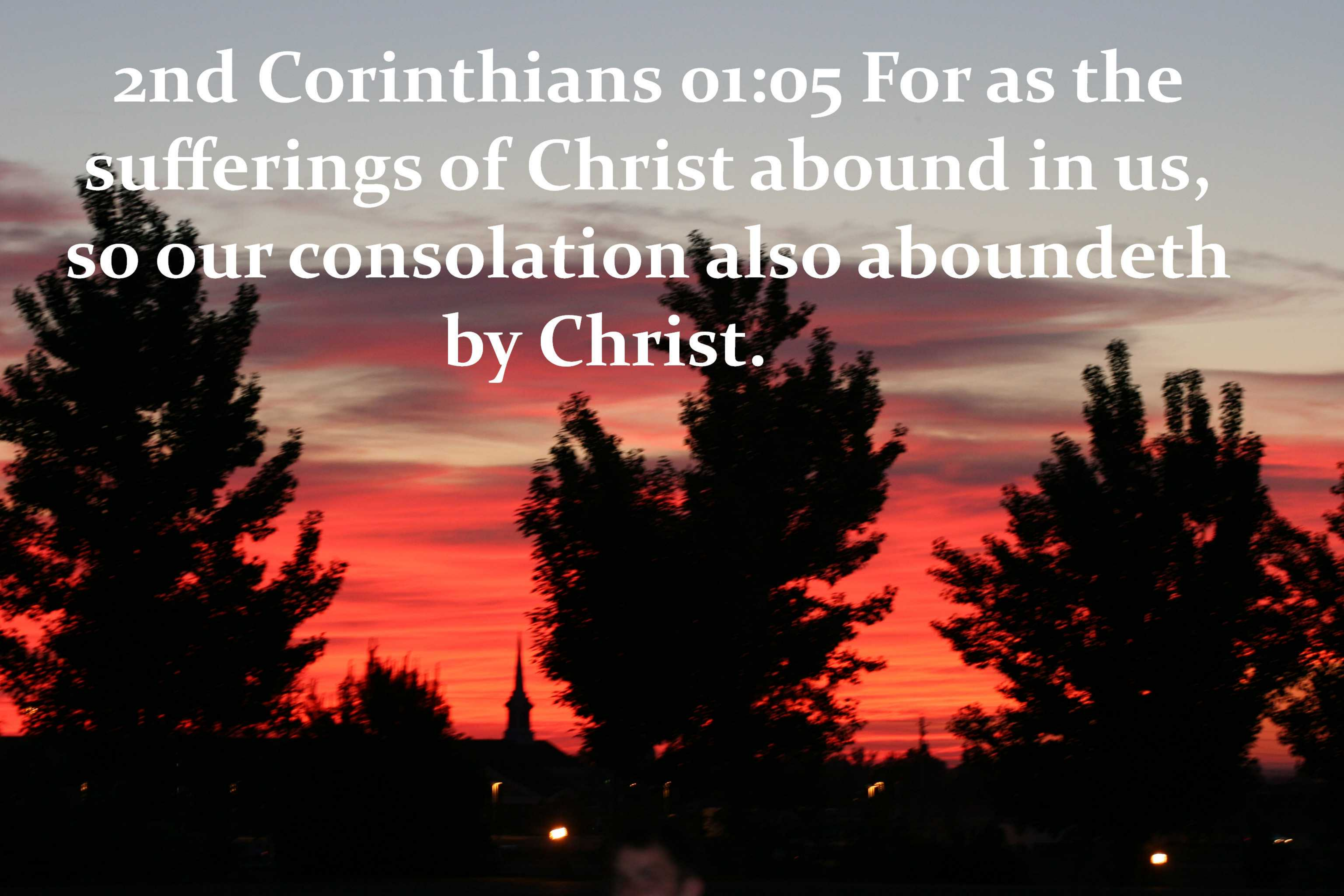

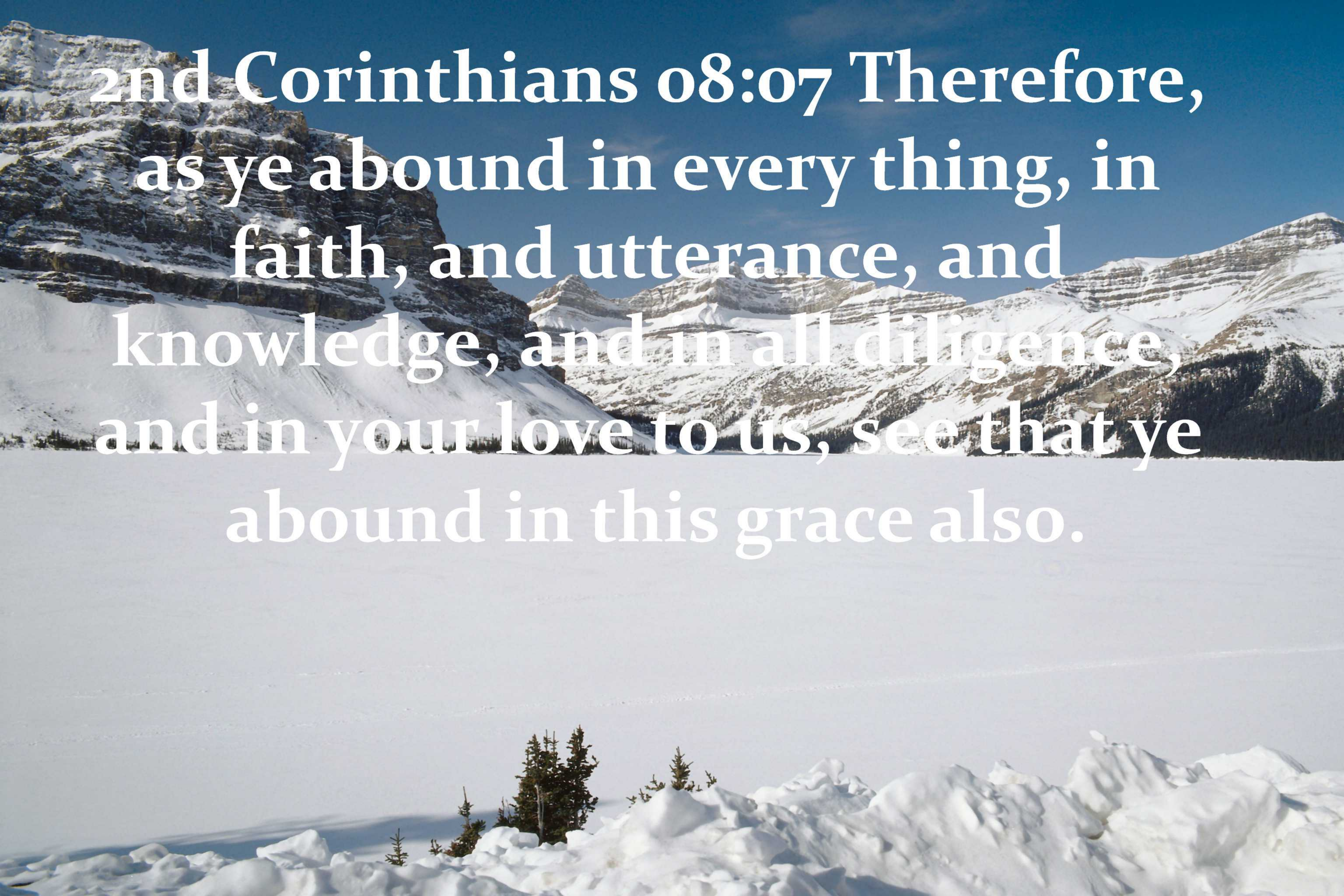

by Christ.











Phillipians 04:12 I know both how

wellpleasing to God.


