








Genesis 32:20 And say ye moreover,

will accept of me.






Leviticus 26:41 And that I also have



persons of the wicked? Selah.








Psalm 119:108 Accept, I beseech

judgment.









Jeremiah 14:10 Thus saith the


Jeremiah 14:12 When they fast, I

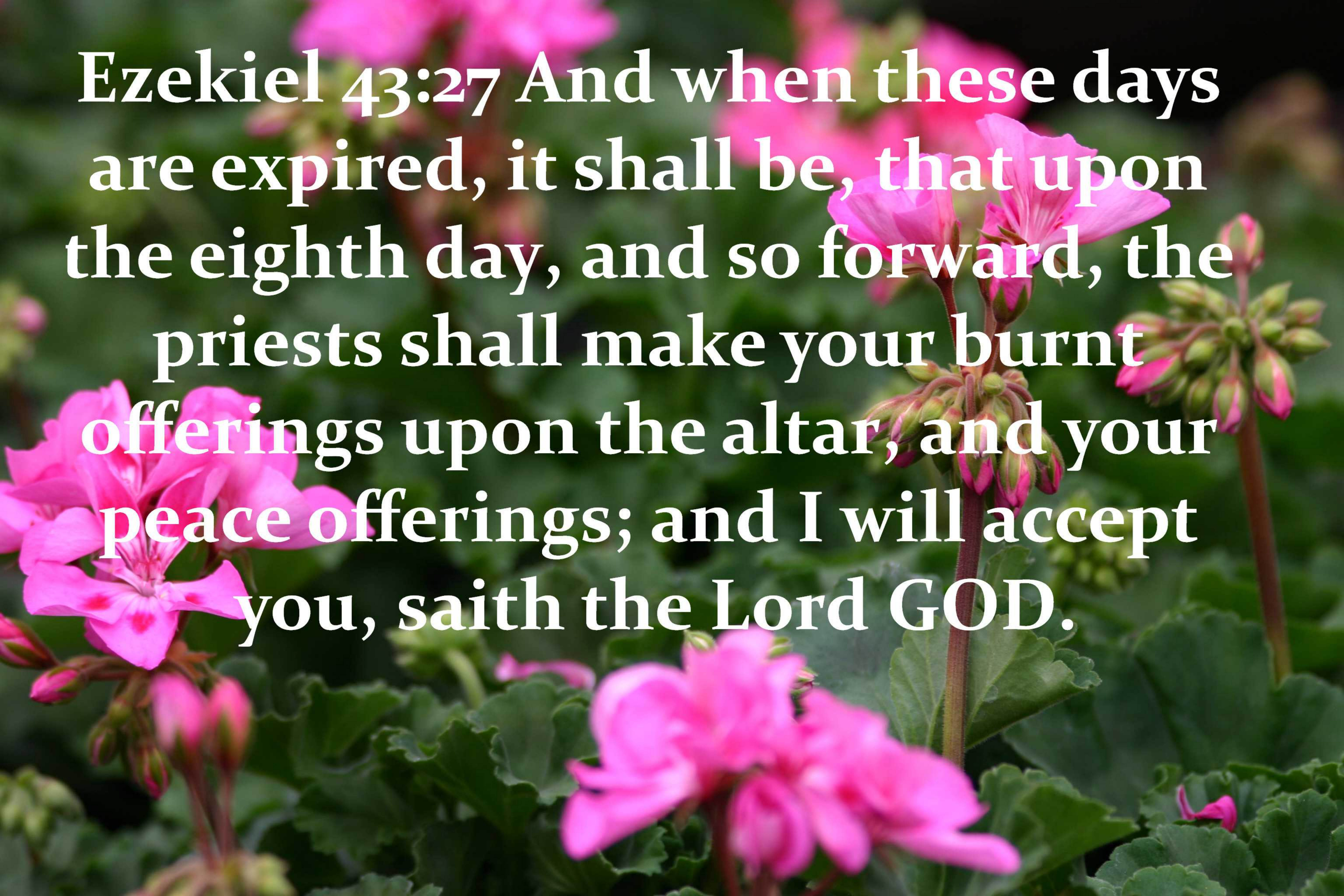

before the heathen.






Ezekiel 43:27 And when these days

offerings of your fat beasts.

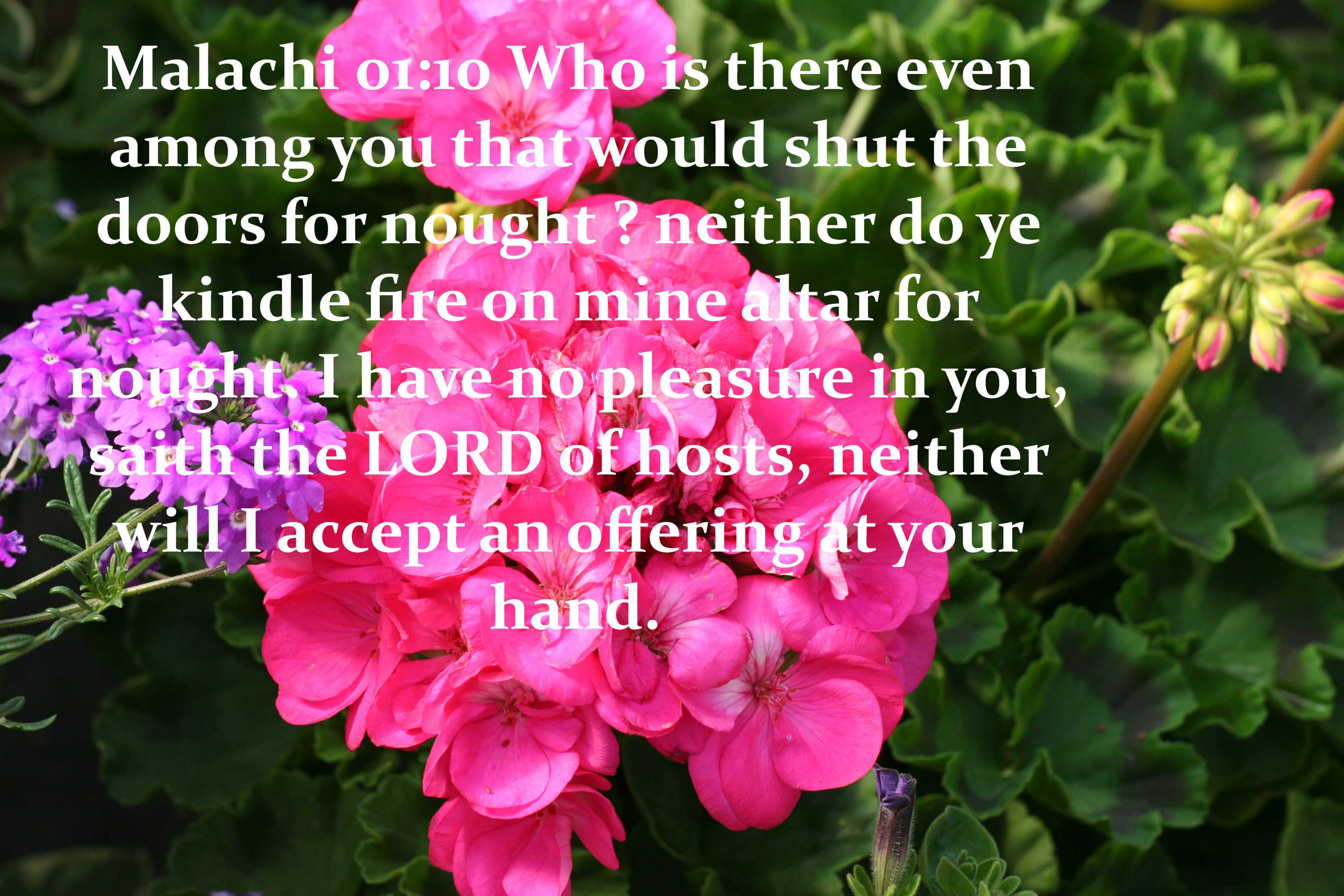


Malachi 01:08 And if ye offer the
