



Genesis 04:07 If thou doest well,




**Exodus 28:38 And it shall be upon

Leviticus 01:04 And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.








Leviticus 19:07 And if it be eaten at

accepted.








**Leviticus 22:25 Neither from a

die there.





