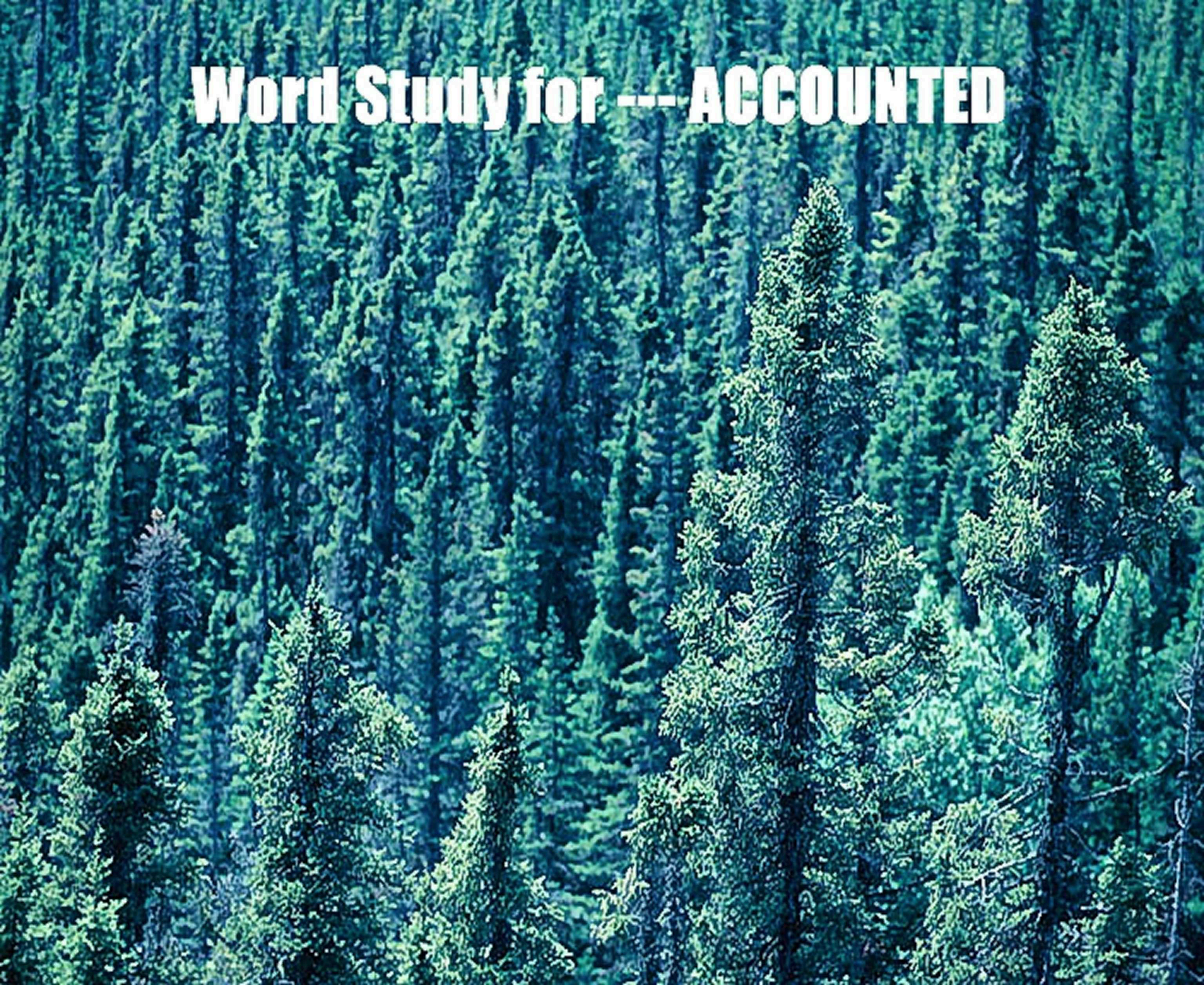






Deutronomy 02:11 Which also were

but the Moabites call them Emims.








