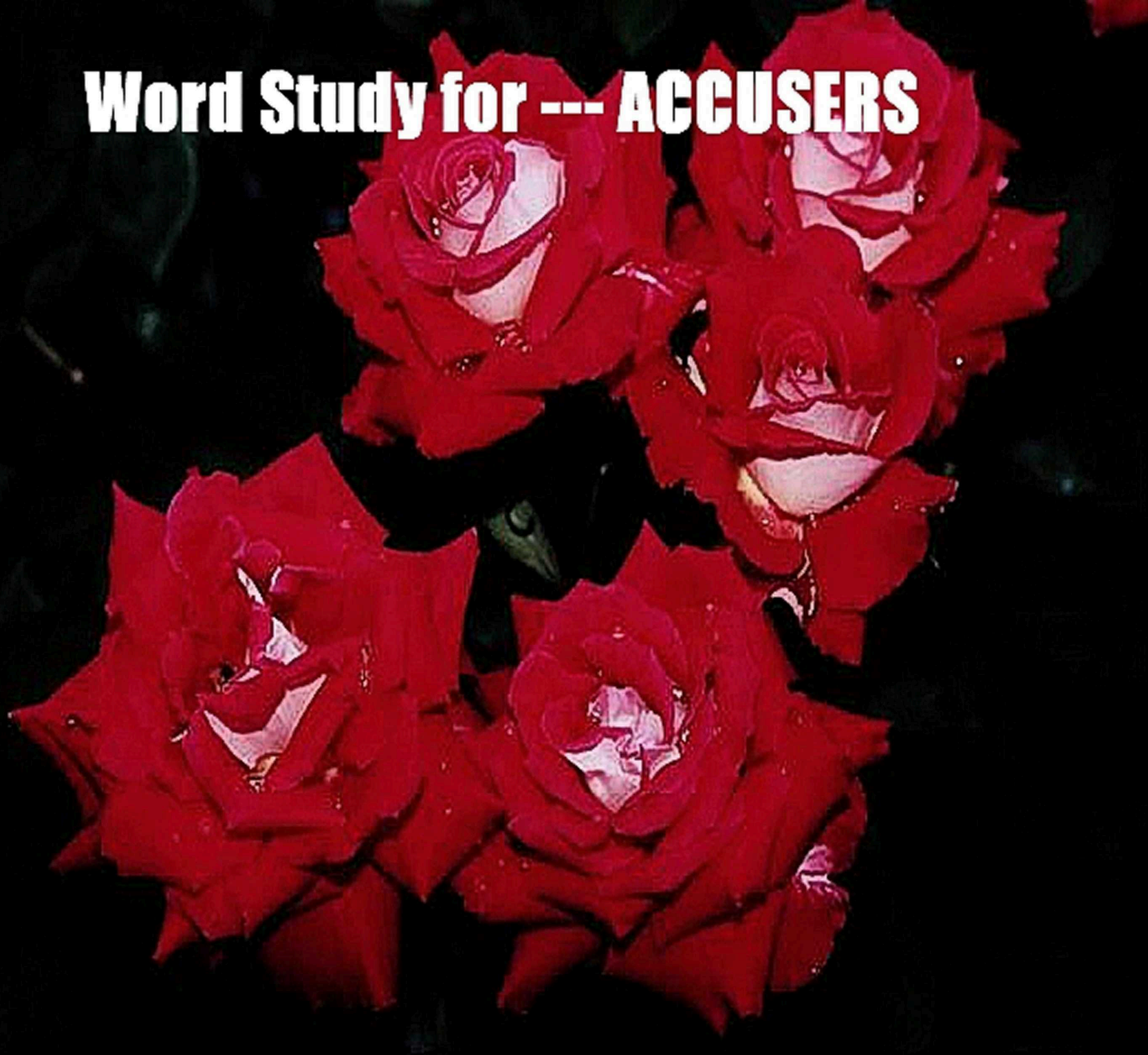
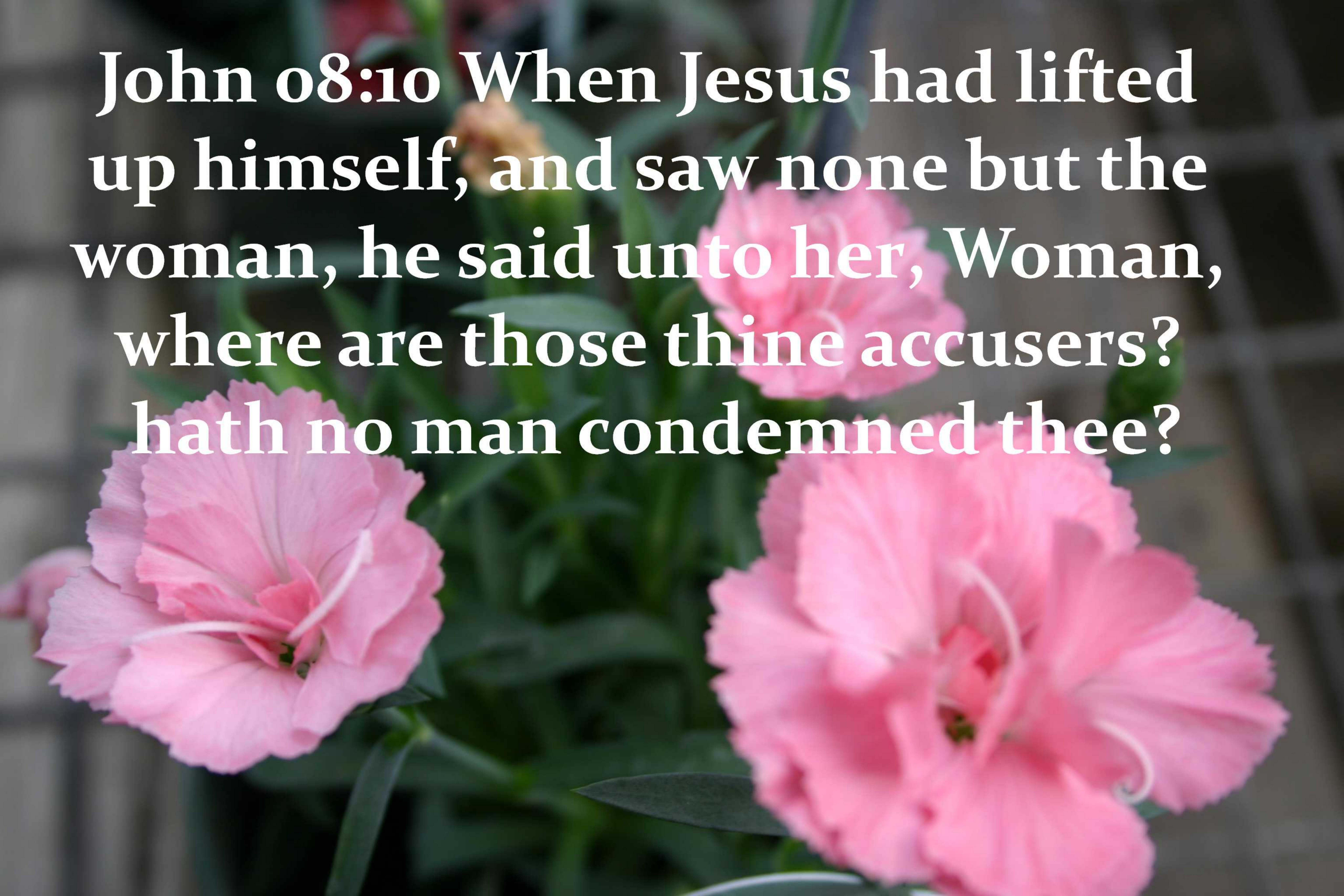


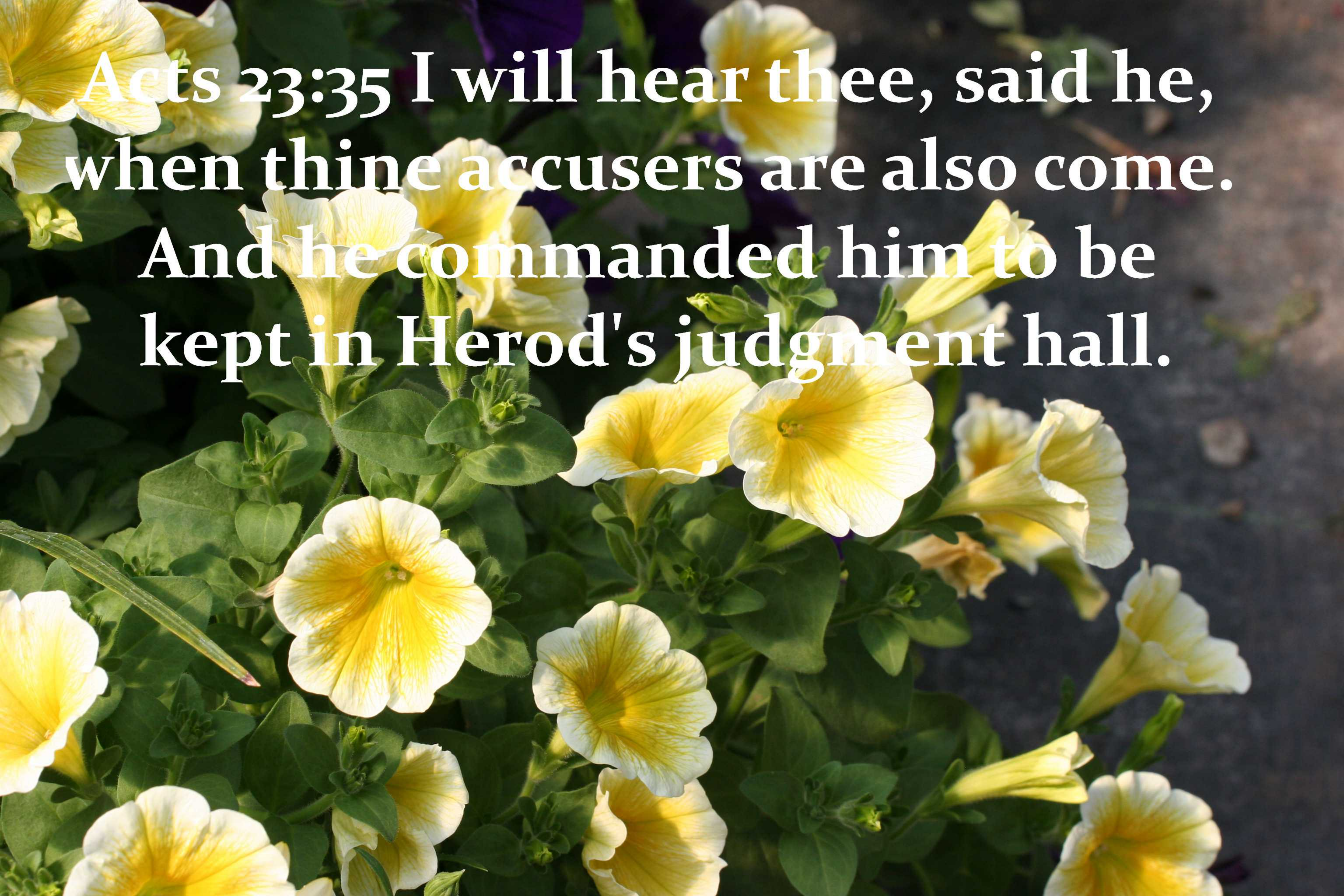

hath no man condemned thee?**




Acts 23:30 And when it was told me






