





is his.


Deuteronomy 33:29 Who said unto

thy covenant.






Isaiah 33:13 Hear, ye that are far off,

near, acknowledge my might.






Isaiah 61:09 And their seed shall be

blessed.




Isaiah 63:16 Doubtless thou art our

voice, saith the LORD.





Jeremiah 14:20 We acknowledge, O


