
1st Kings 05:04 But now the LORD

adversary nor evil occurrent.




1st Kings 11:14 And the LORD

was of the king's seed in Edom.




1st Kings 11:23 And God stirred him up another adversary, Rezon the son of Eliadah, which fled from his lord Hadadezer king of Zobah:



Esther 07:06 And Esther said, The adversary and enemy is this wicked Haman. Then Haman was afraid before the king and the queen.




Job 31:35 Oh that one would hear me! behold, my desire is, that the Almighty would answer me, and that mine adversary had written a book.

enter into thy congregation.




Lamentations 02:04 He hath bent

his fury like fire.



palaces shall be spoiled.


