your souls, by a statute for ever.

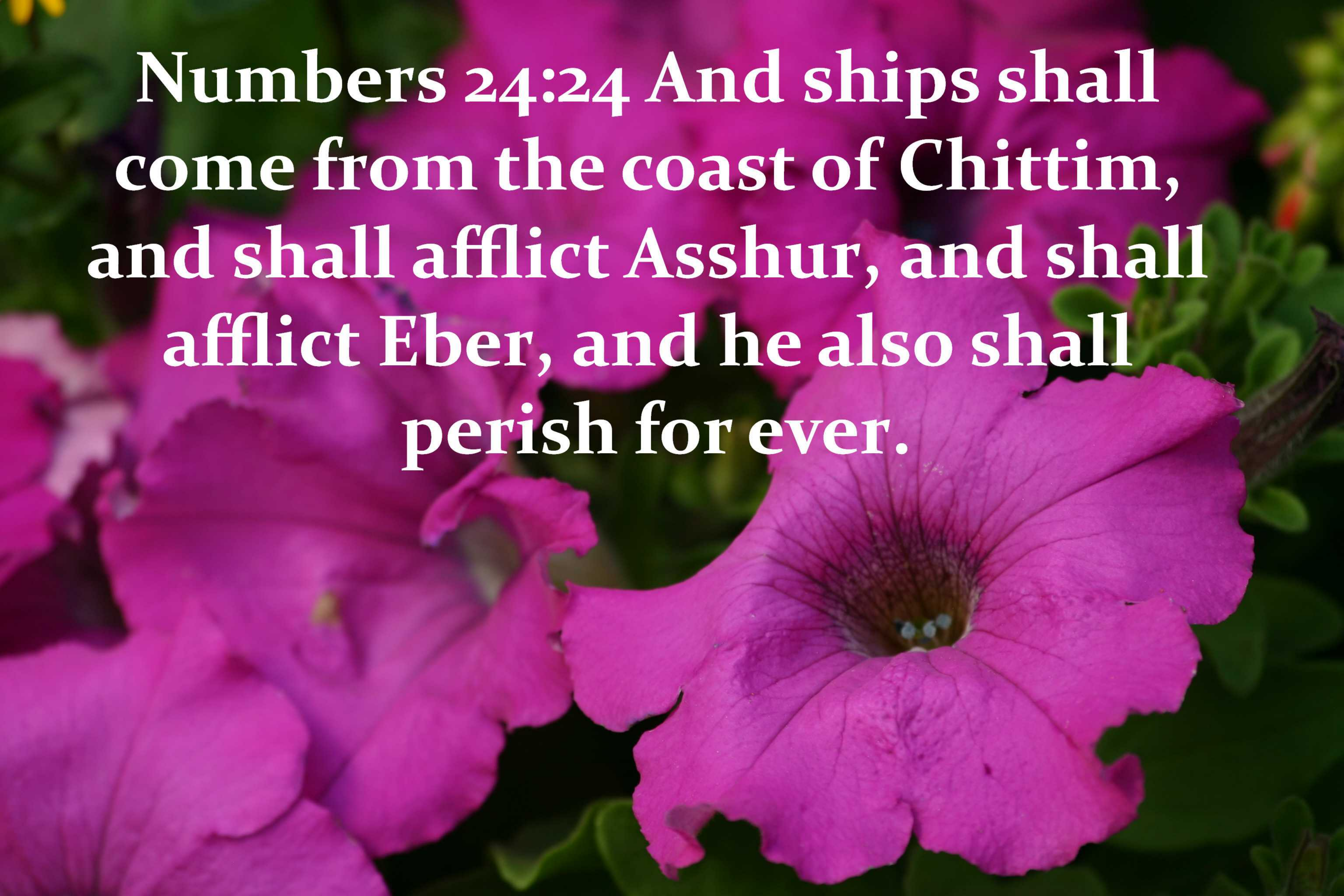




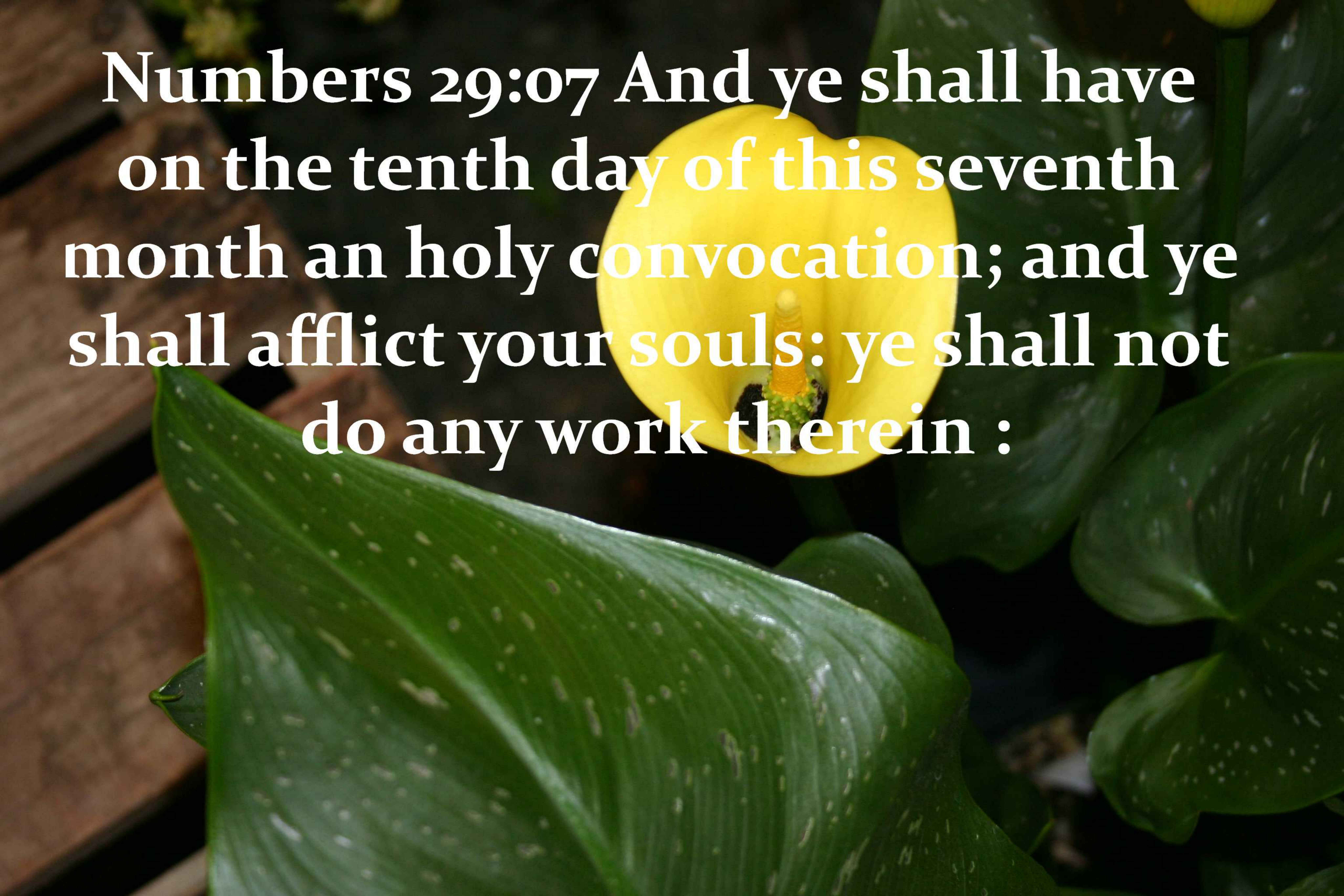
