

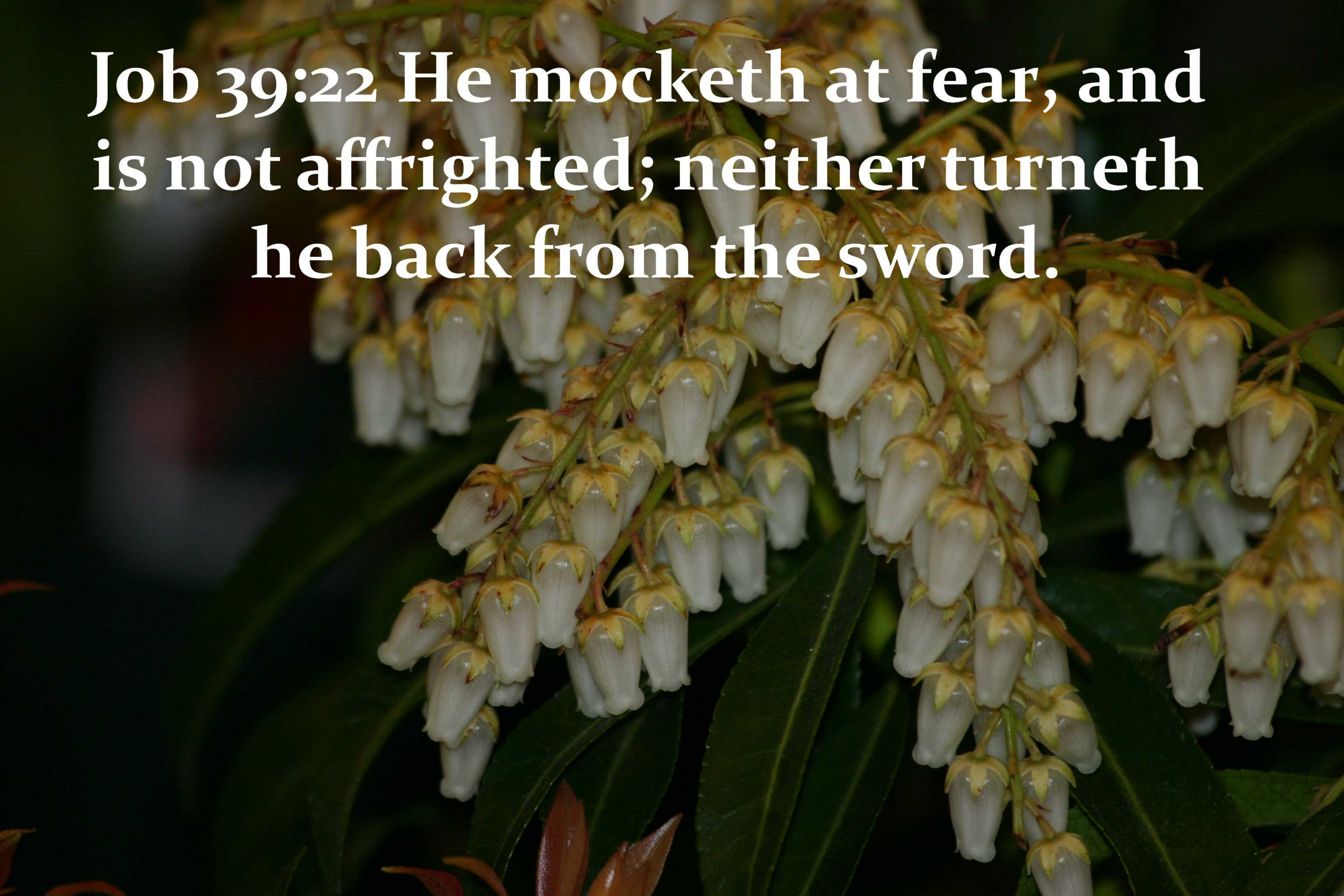

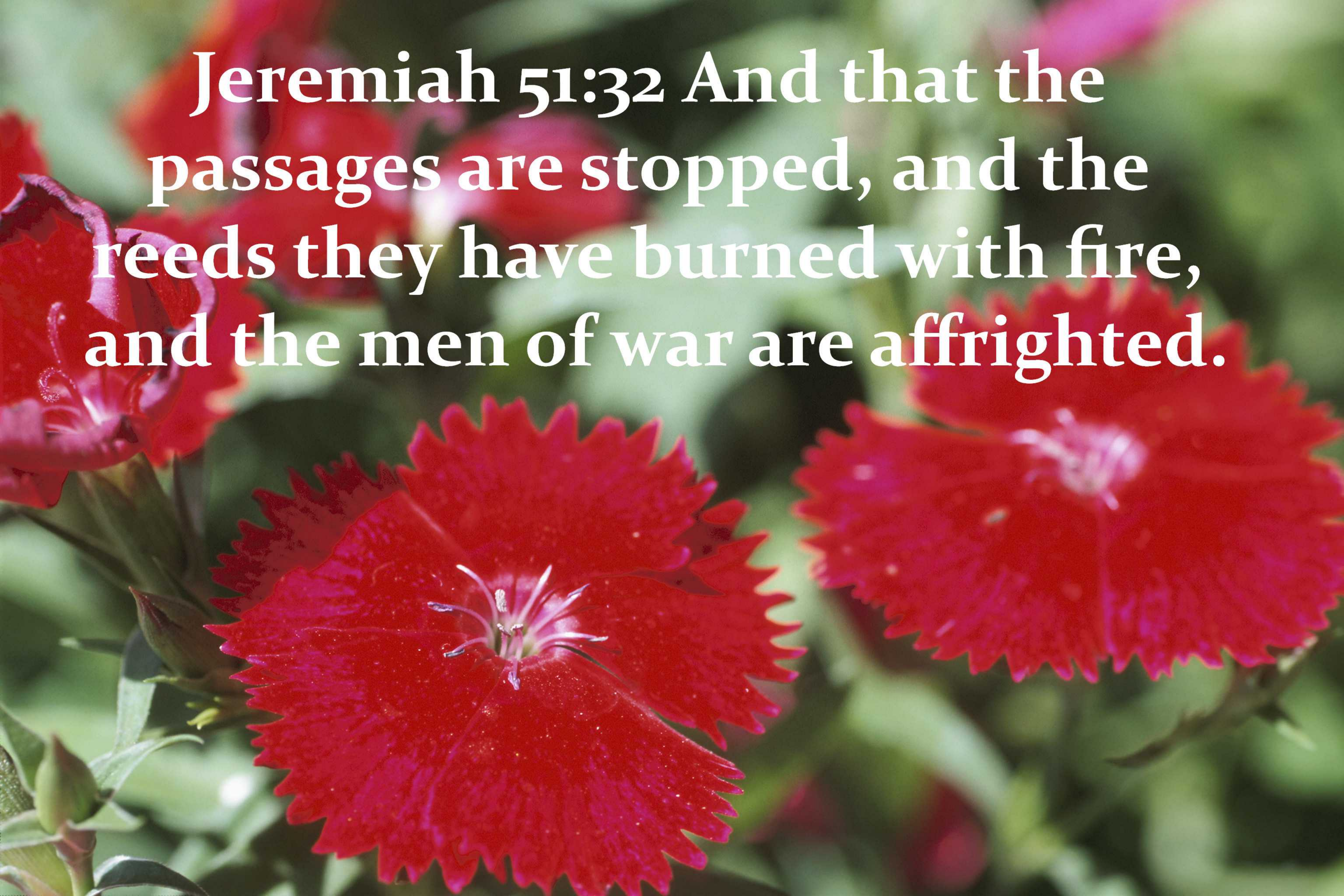
Job 39:22 He mocketh at fear, and

he back from the sword.



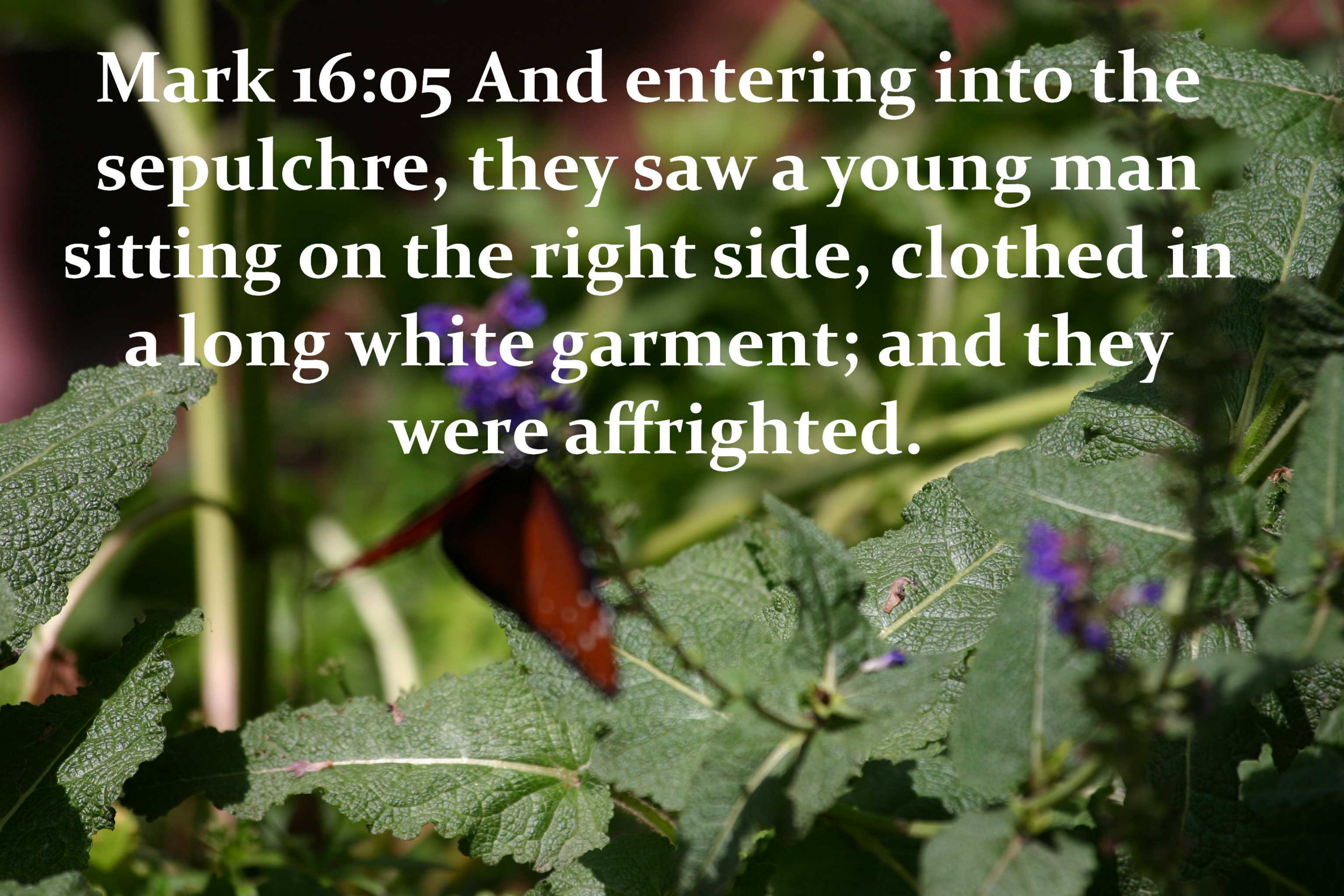
Isaiah 21:04 My heart panted,

turned into fear unto me.

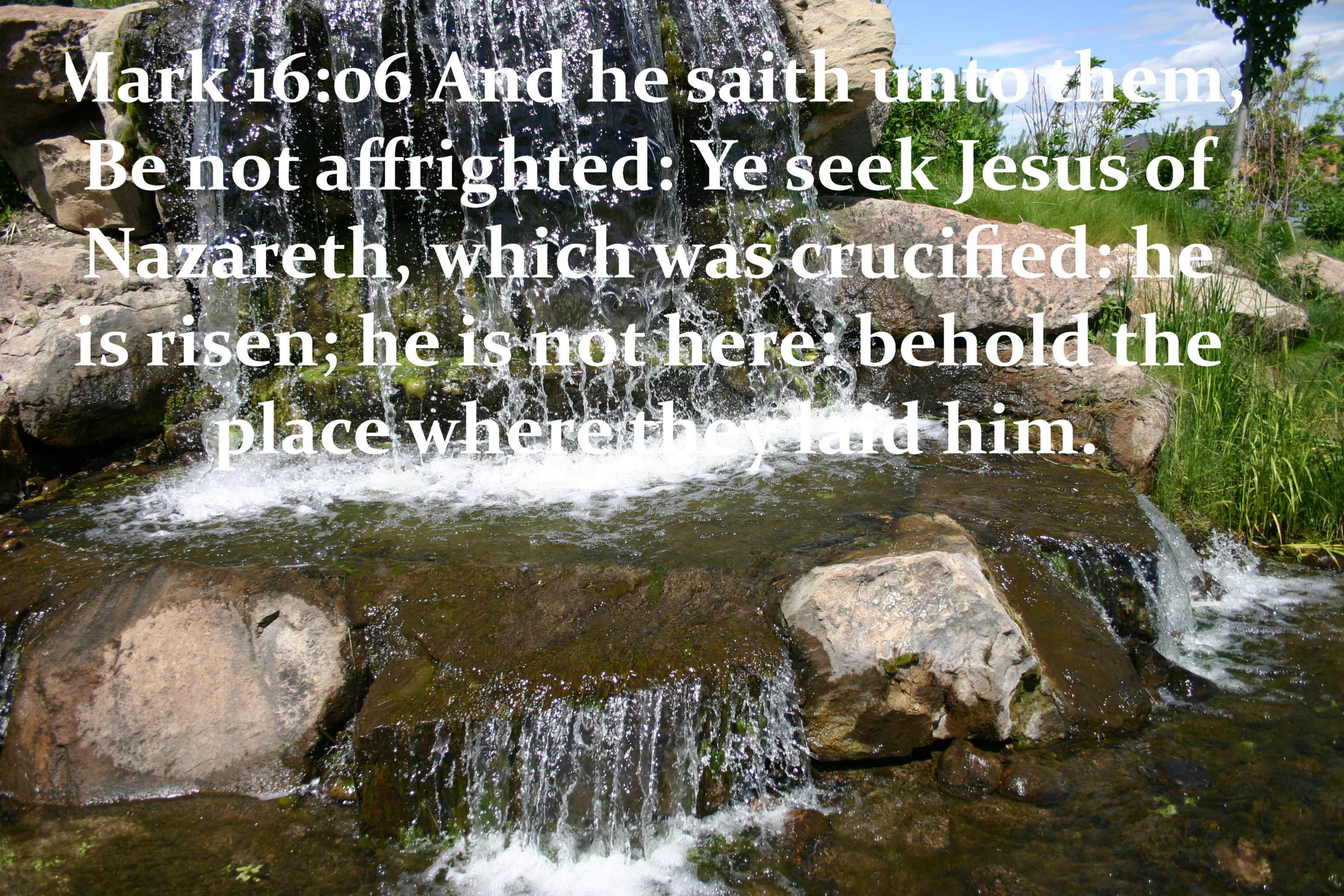


Jeremiah 51:32 And that the

were affrighted.**

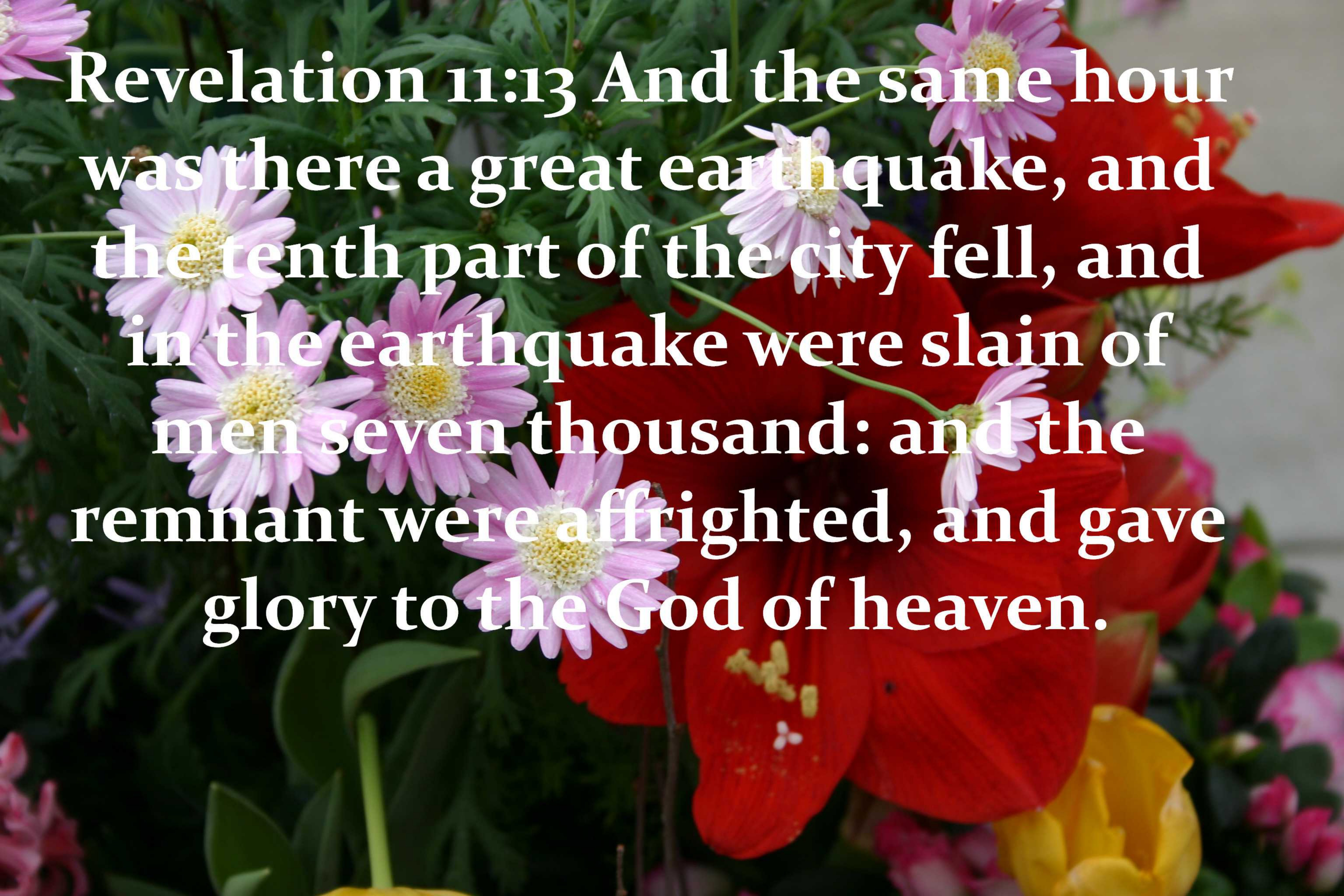
