


Psalms 55:17 Evening, and morning,

aloud: and he shall hear my voice.



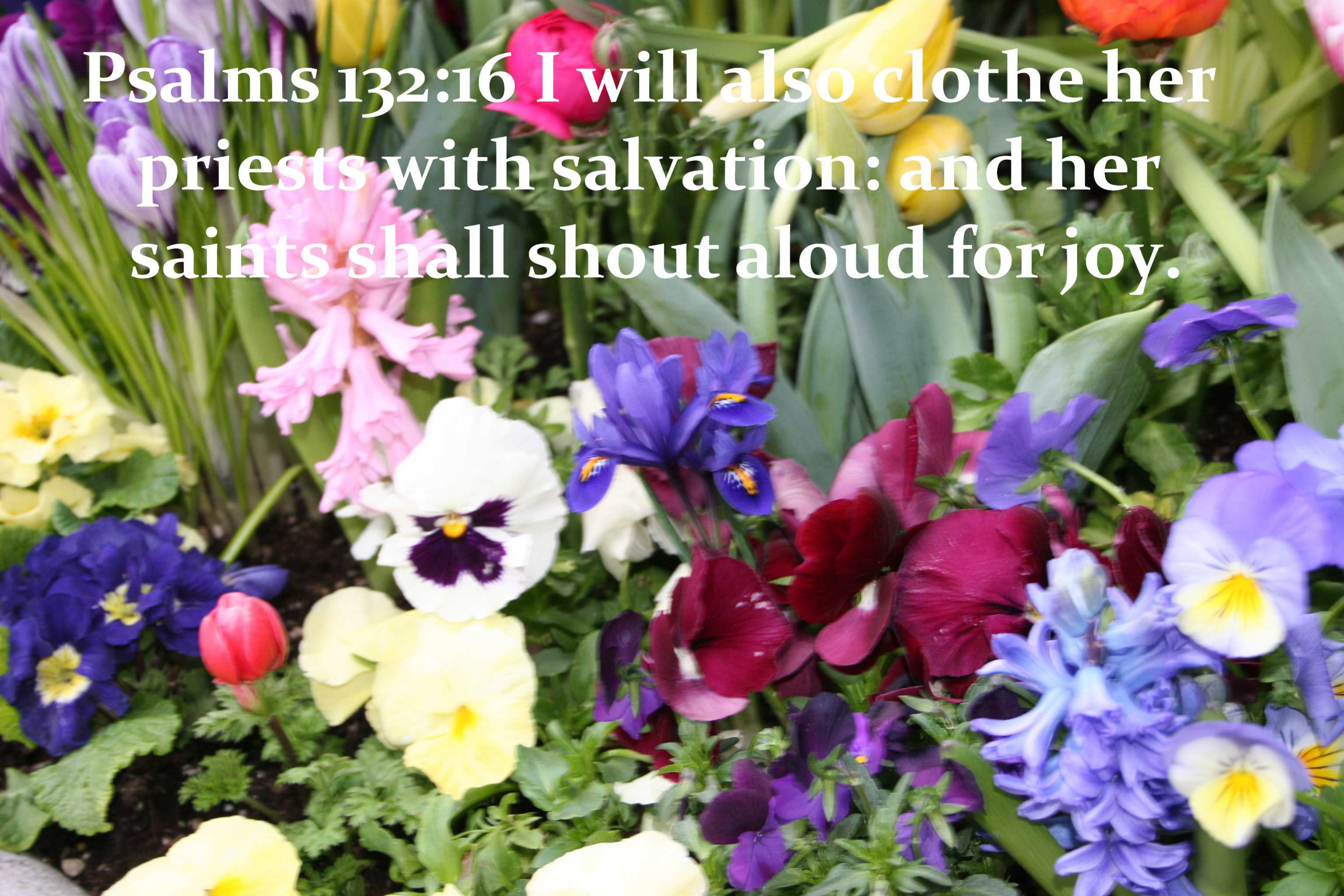

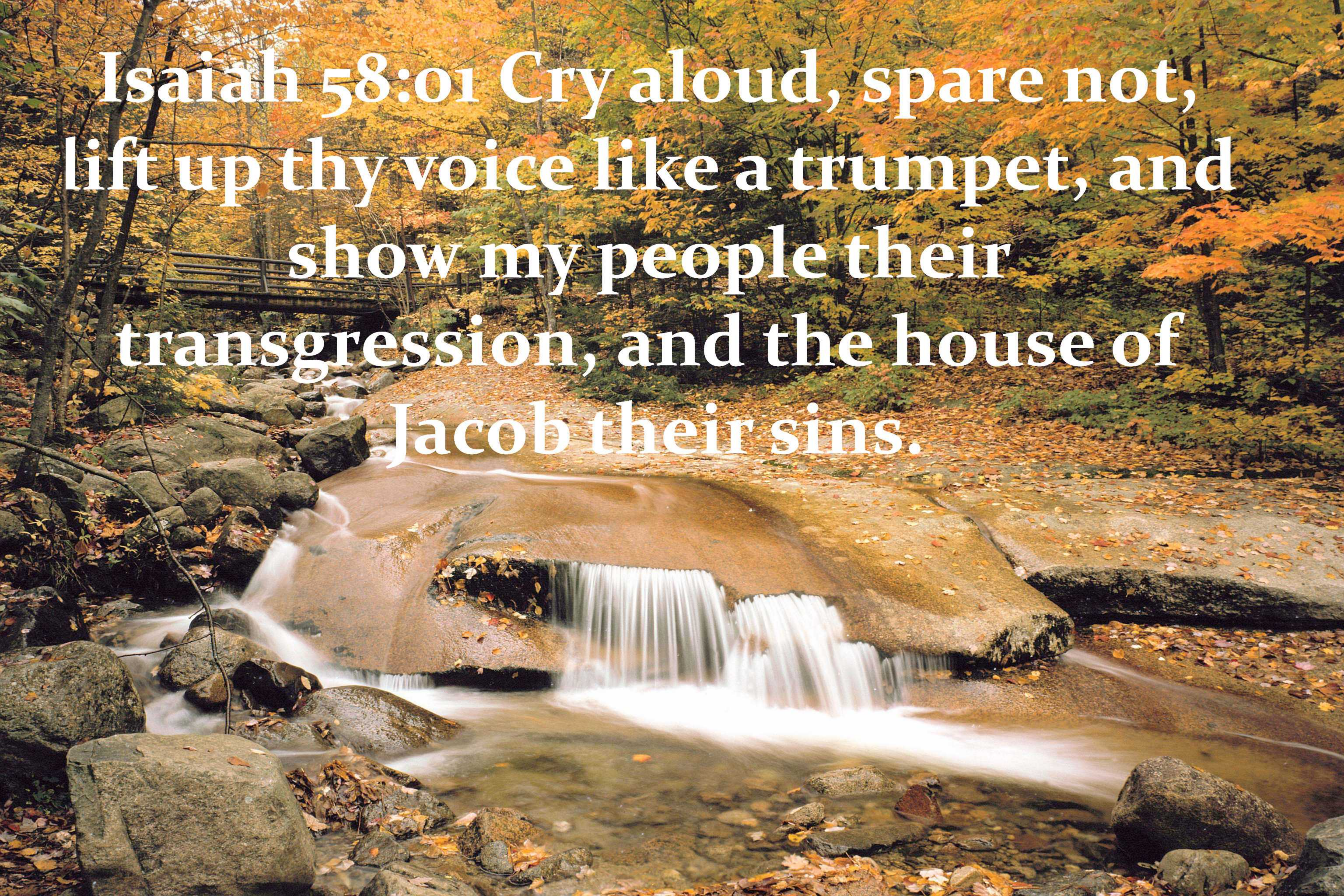

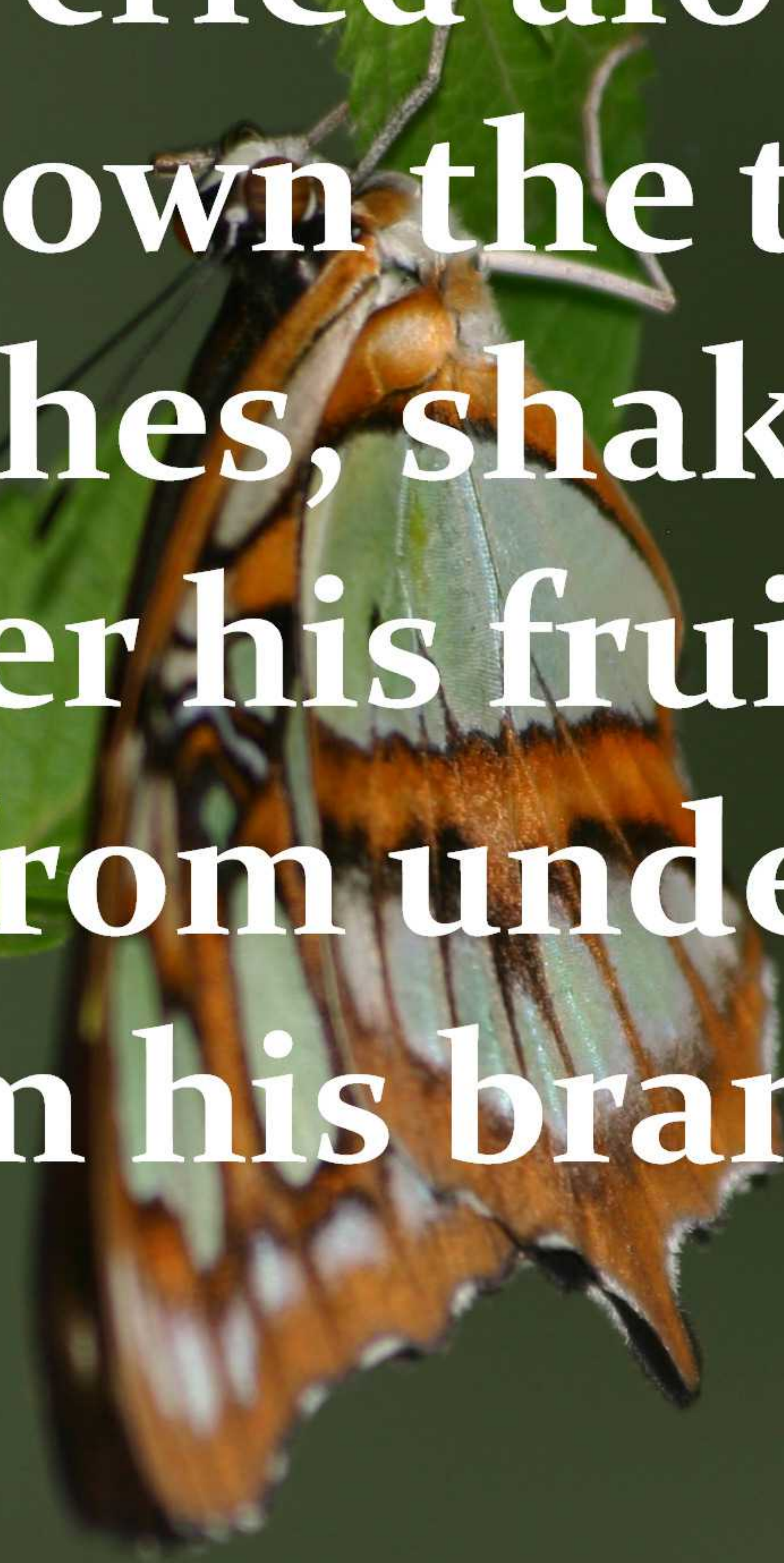


