





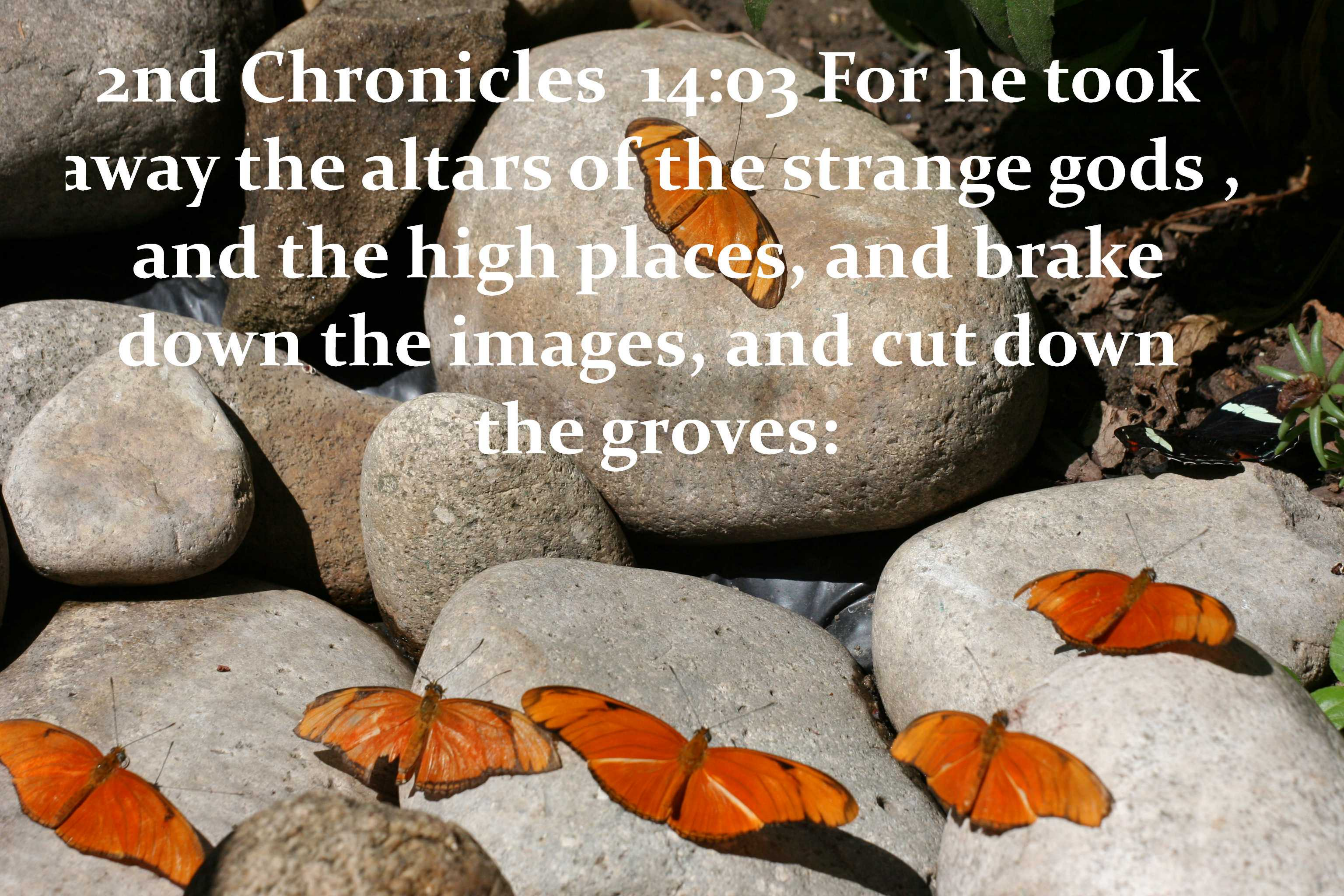


2nd Kings 23:20 And he slew all the












Kidron.

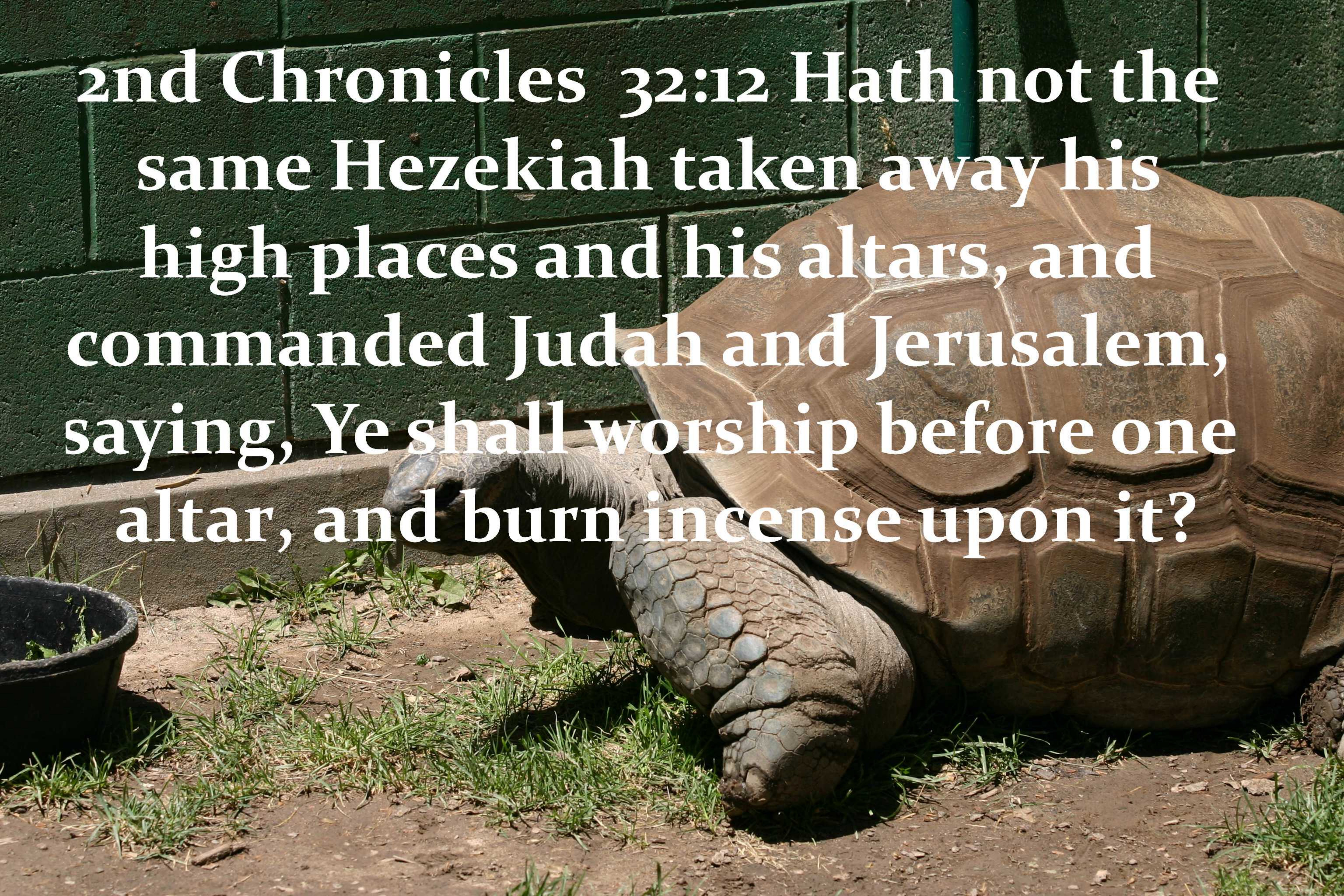


2nd Chronicles 31:01 Now when all

altar, and burn incense upon it?








2nd Chronicles 33:03 For he built

groves, or the images.**












Ezekiel 06:13 Then shall ye know

shall be unto him to sin.








Hosea 10:01 Israel is an empty vine,

made goodly images.






Hosea 10:02 Their heart is divided;

shall spoil their images.





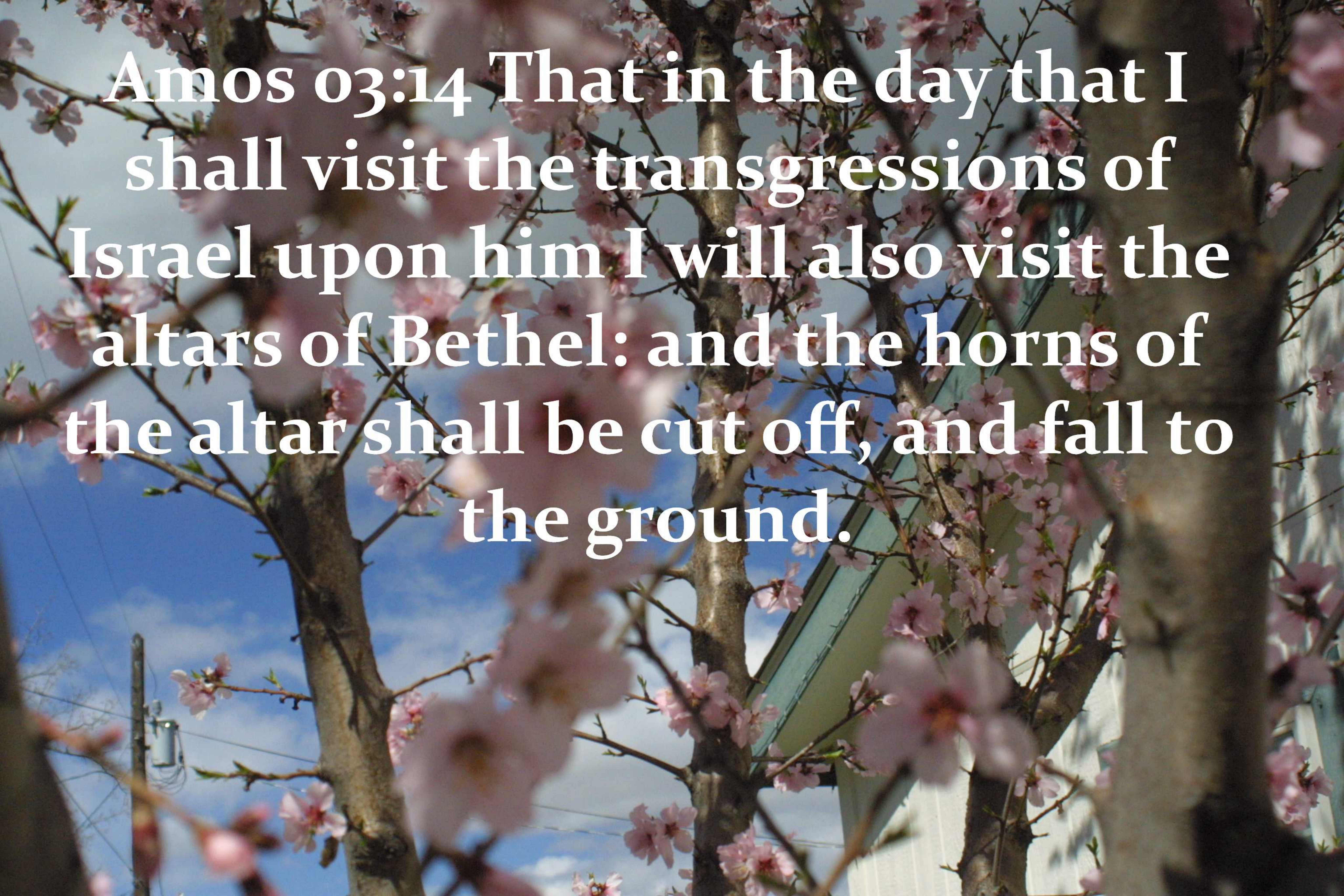
Hosea 10:08 The high places also of
