


But he told not his father.



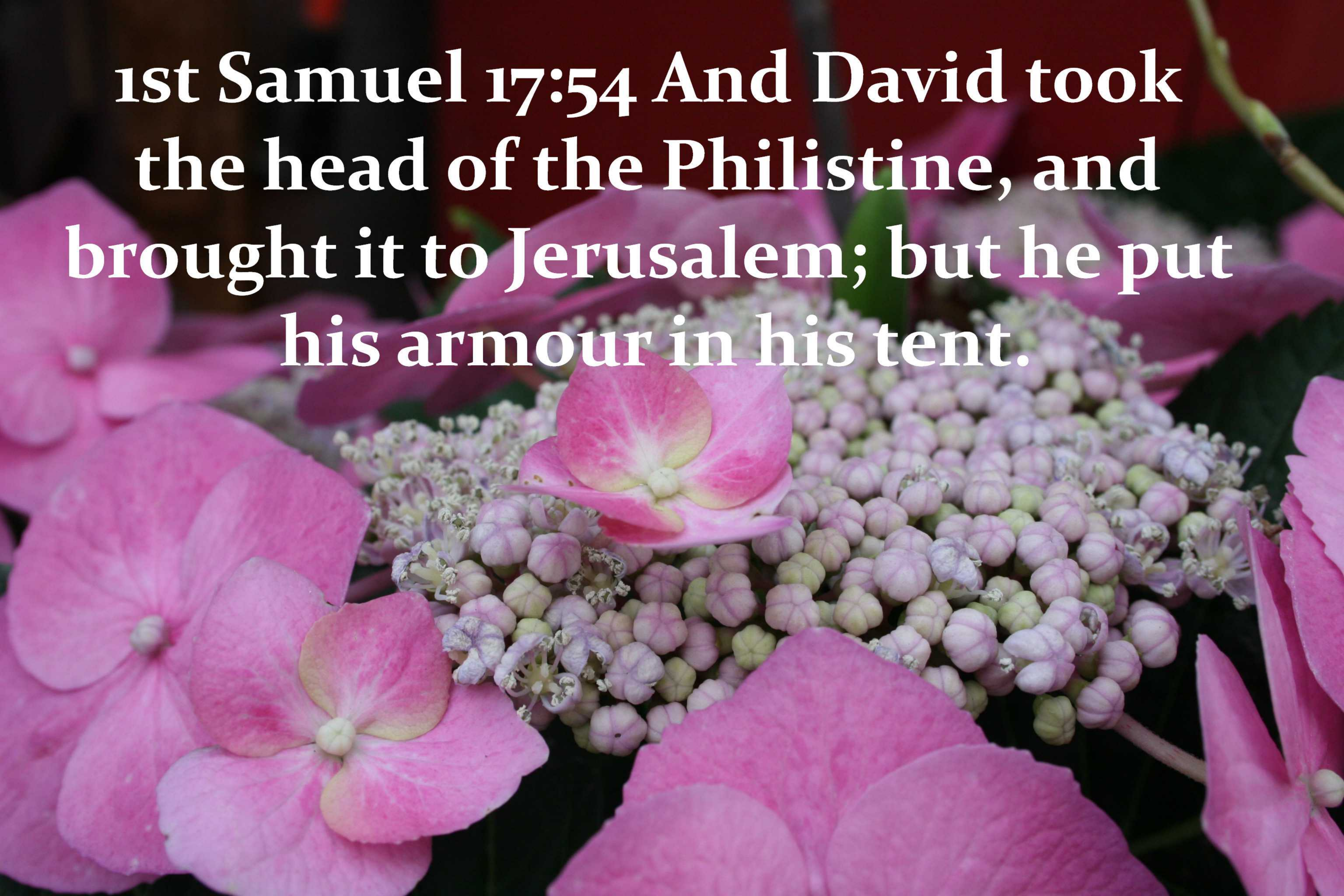
1st Samuel 14:06 And Jonathan said


