



Genesis 49:24 But his bow abode in

stone of Israel:






Deutronomy 33:27 The eternal God

thee; and shall say, Destroy them .

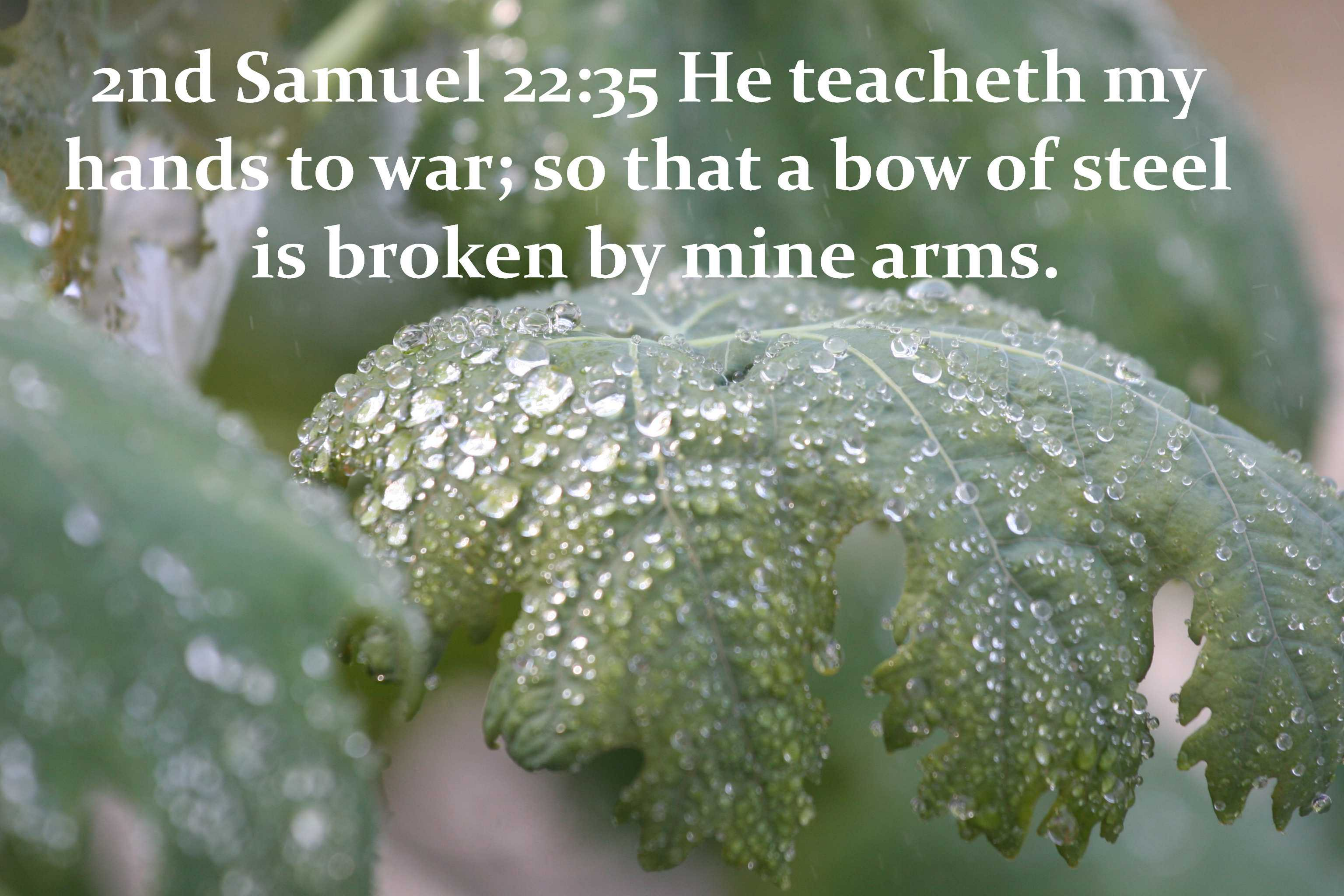

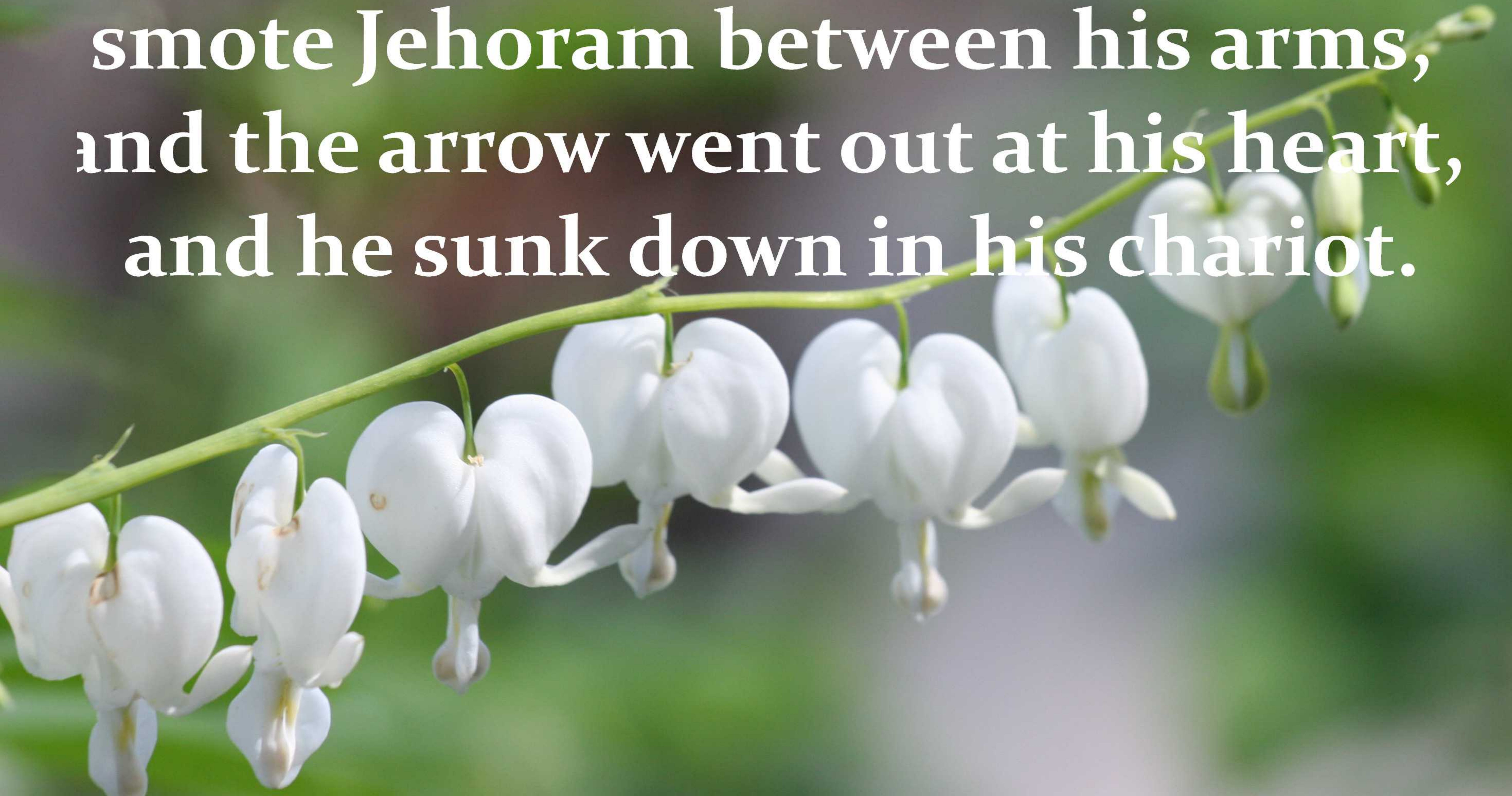

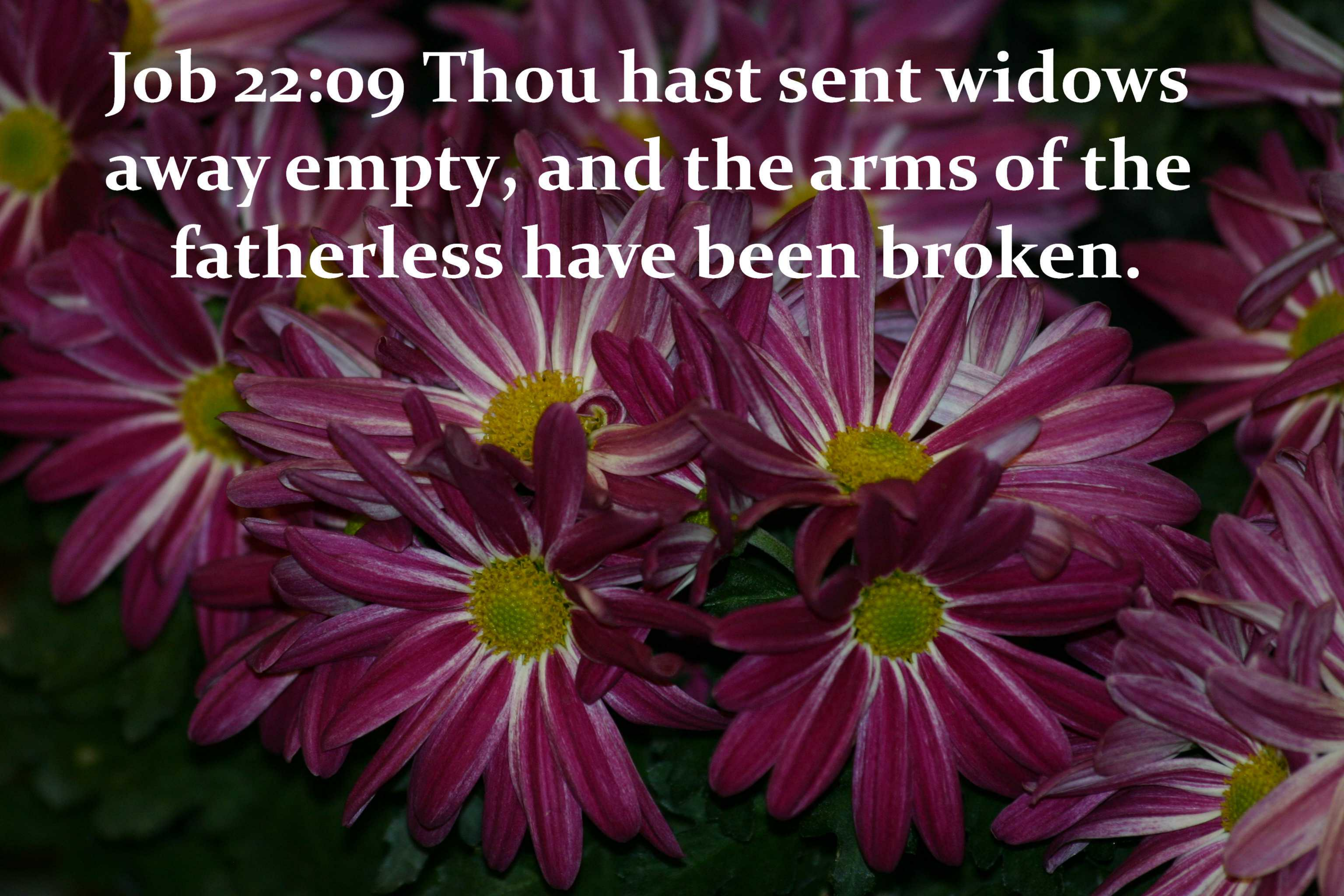

is broken by mine arms.



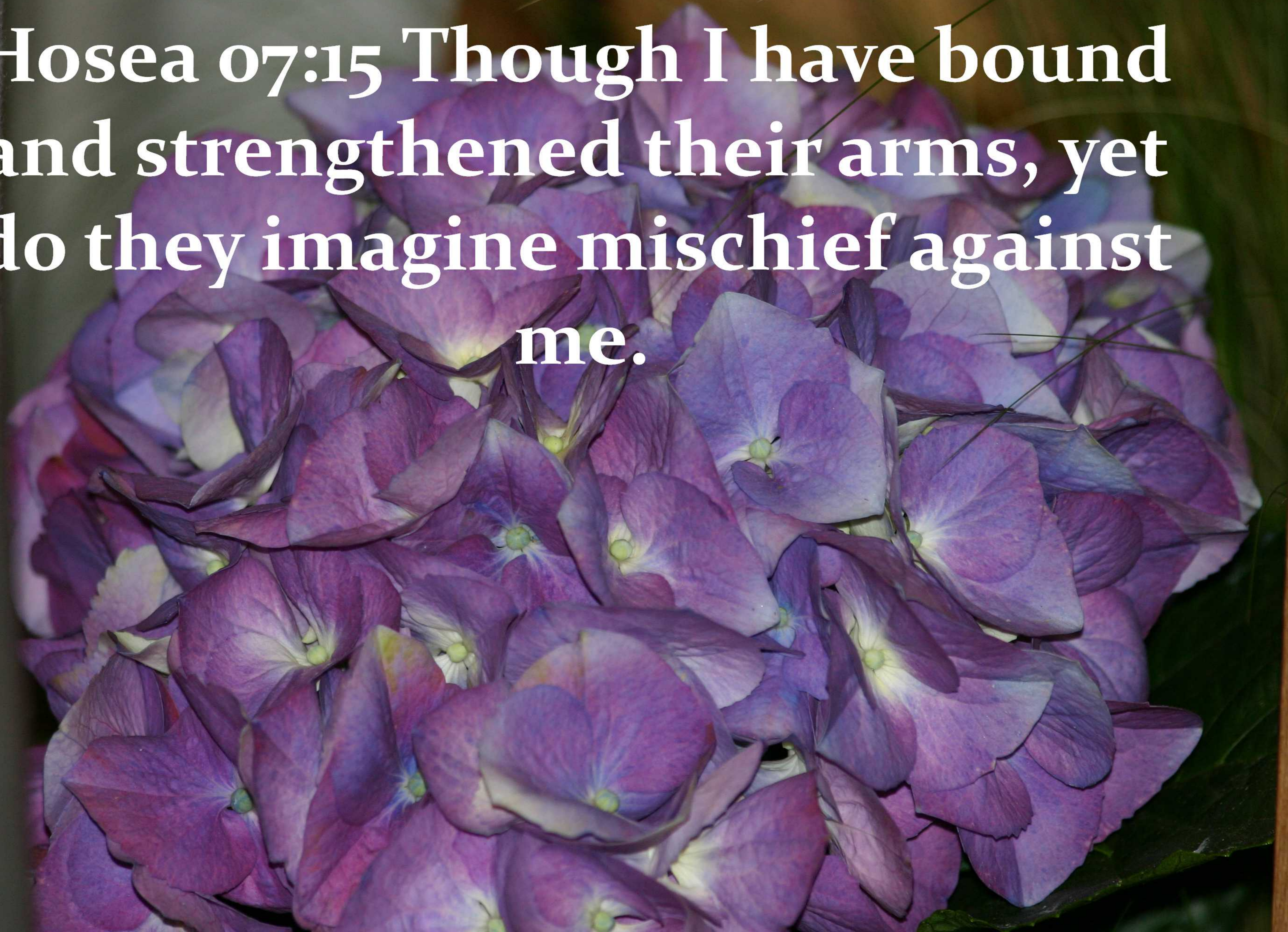
