
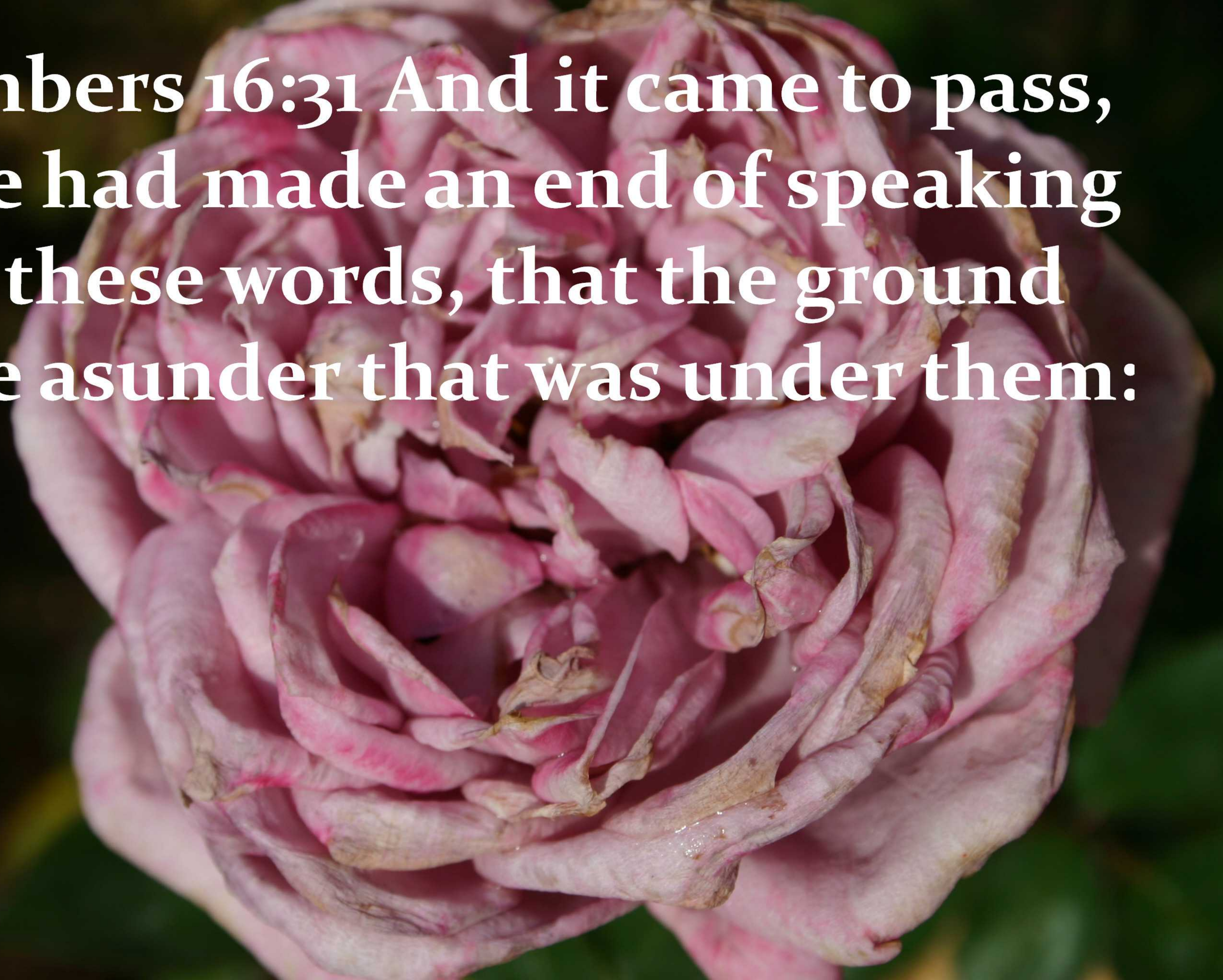



Leviticus 01:17 And he shall cleave

divide it asunder:








2nd Kings 02:11 And it came to pass,

mark.



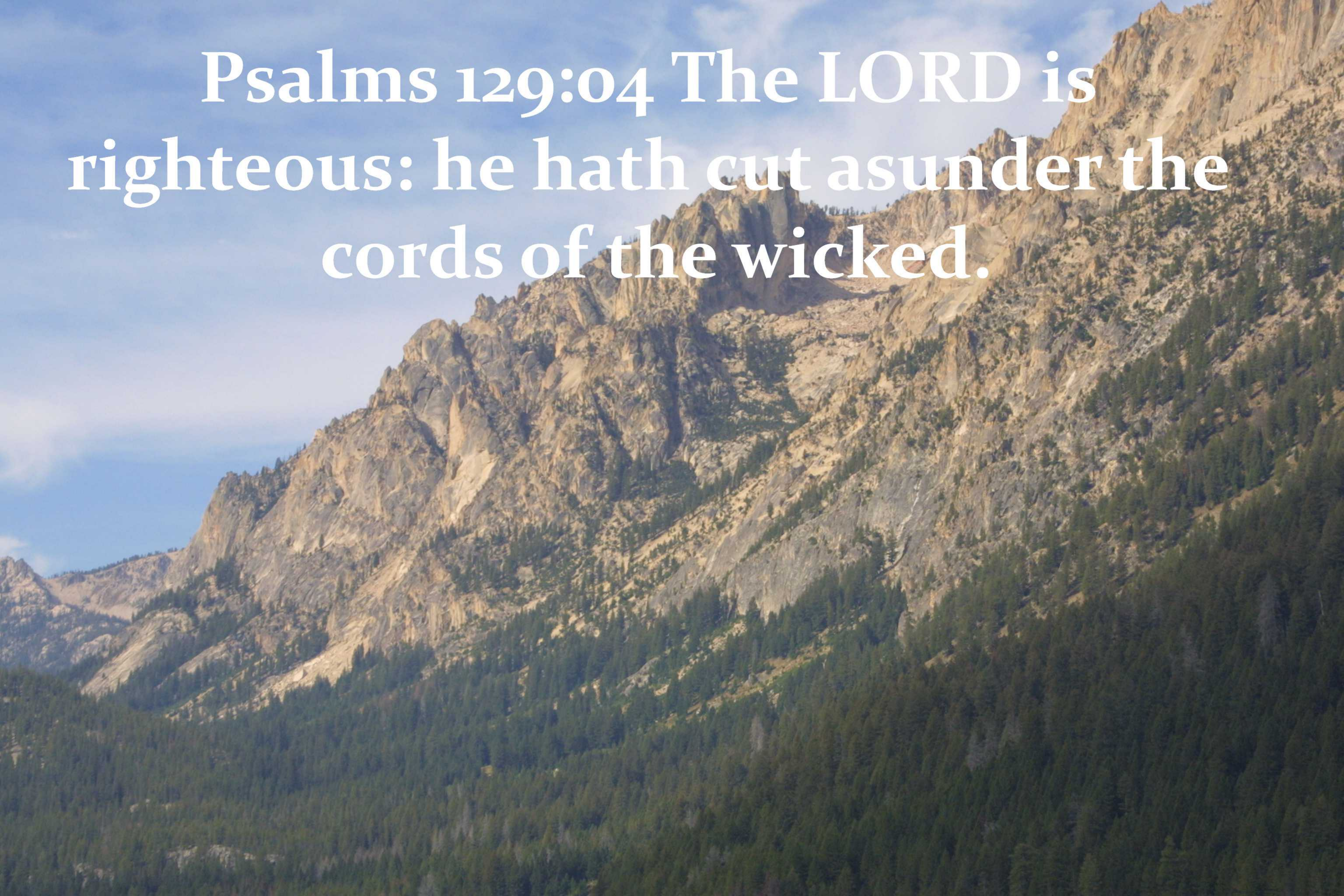

put asunder.



bowels gushed out.




Acts 15:39 And the contention was
