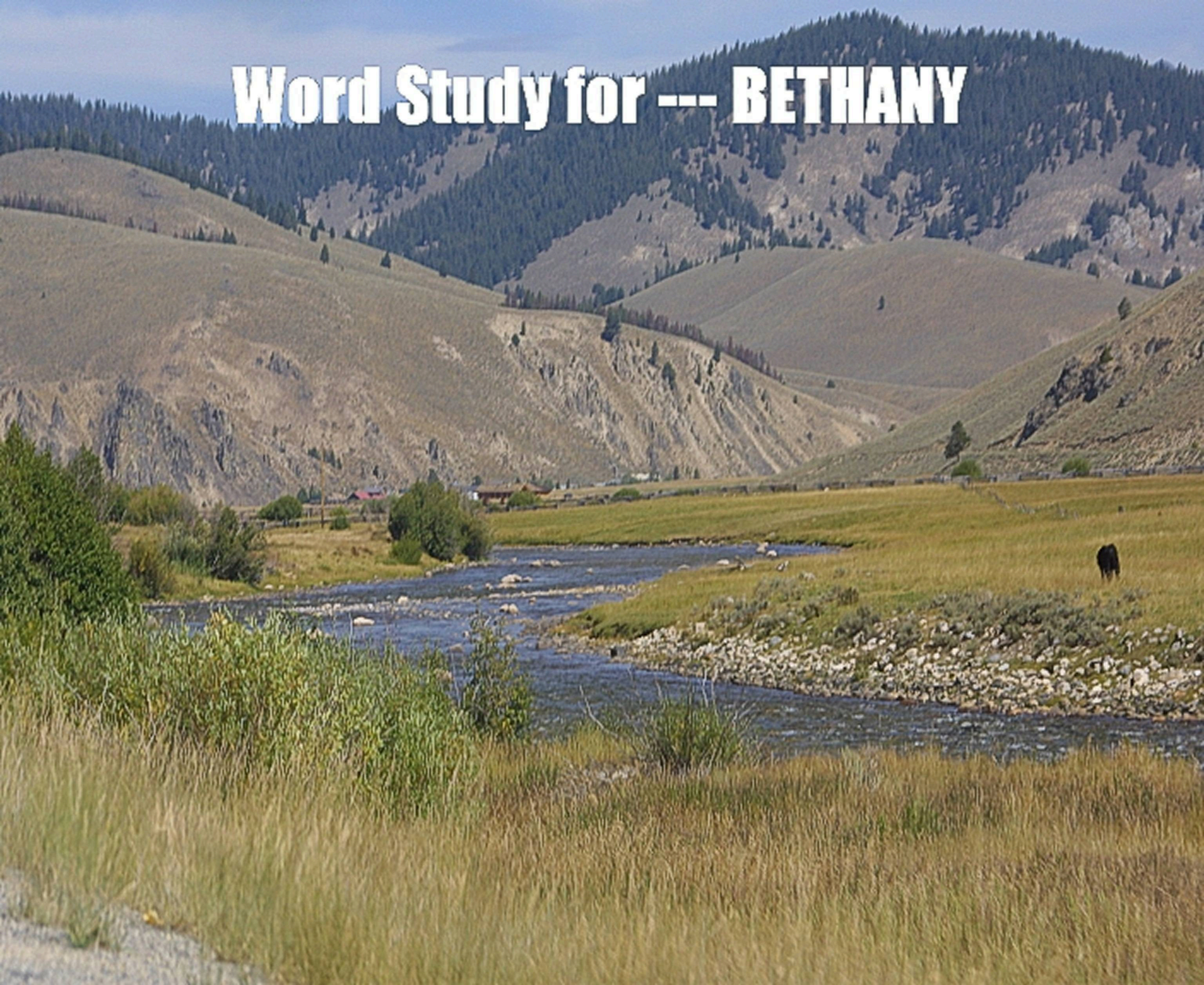


# Word Study for --- BETHANY

Bethany; and he lodged there.



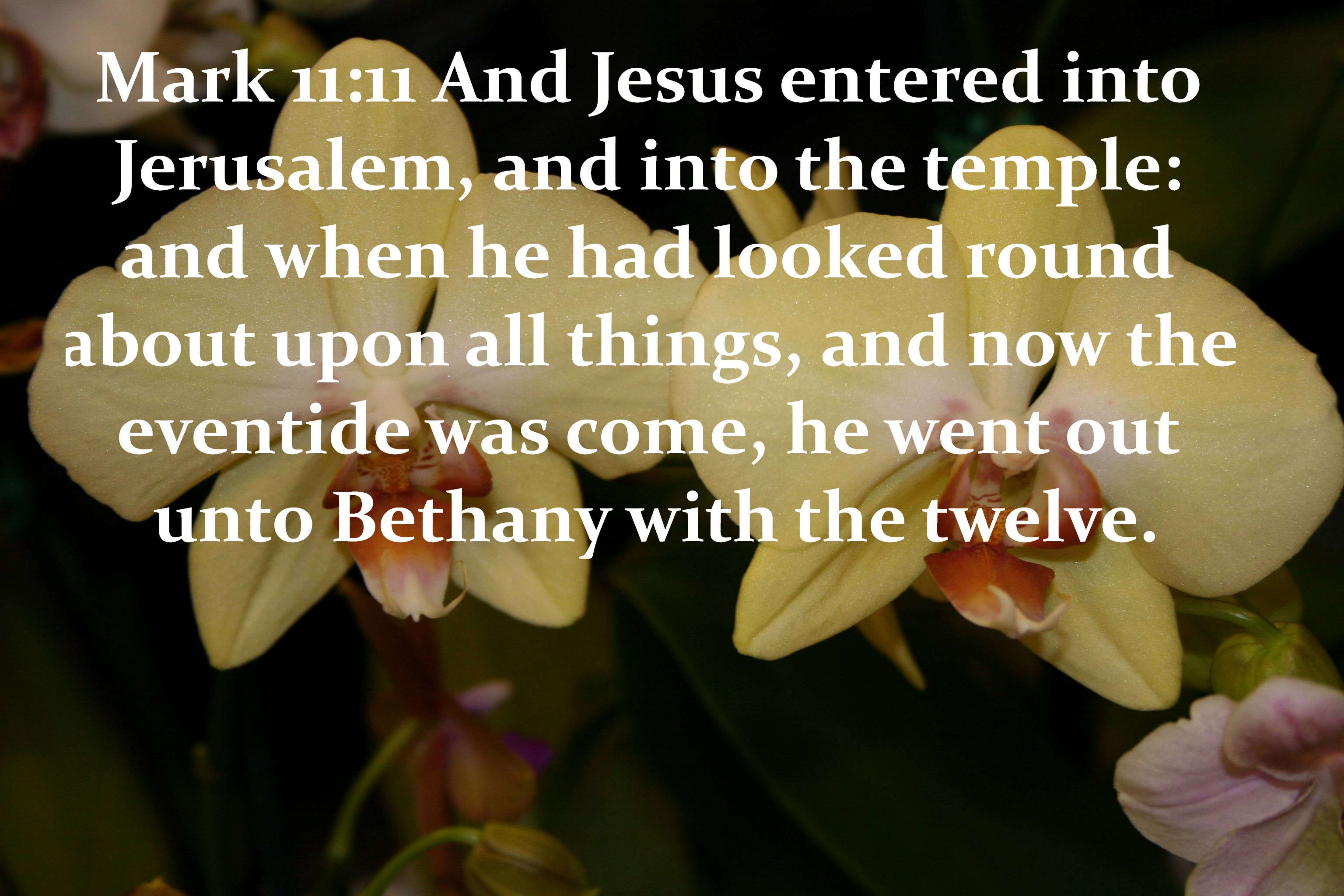
Matthew 26:06 Now when Jesus

disciples,





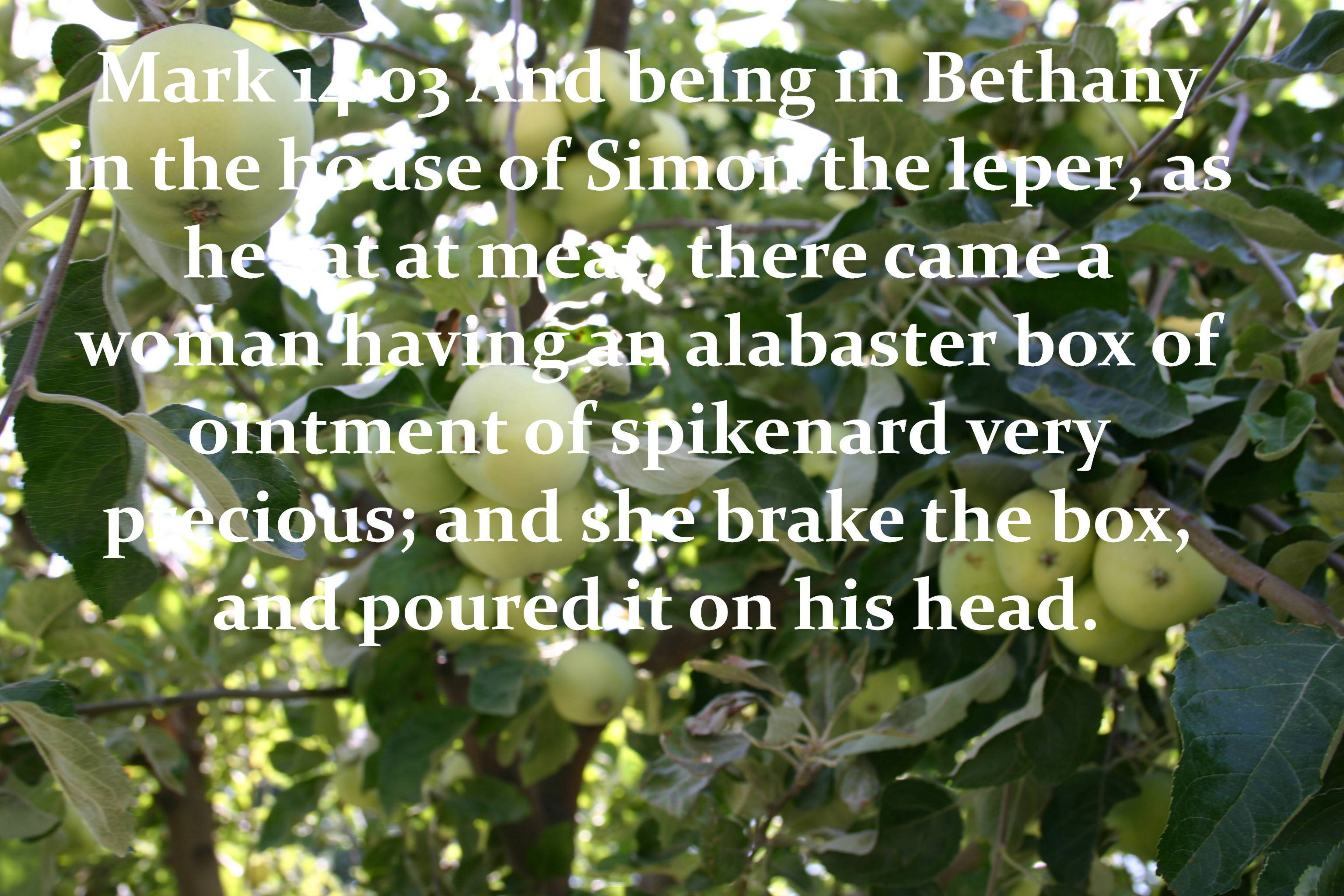
Mark 11:11 And Jesus entered into

Bethany, he was hungry:**

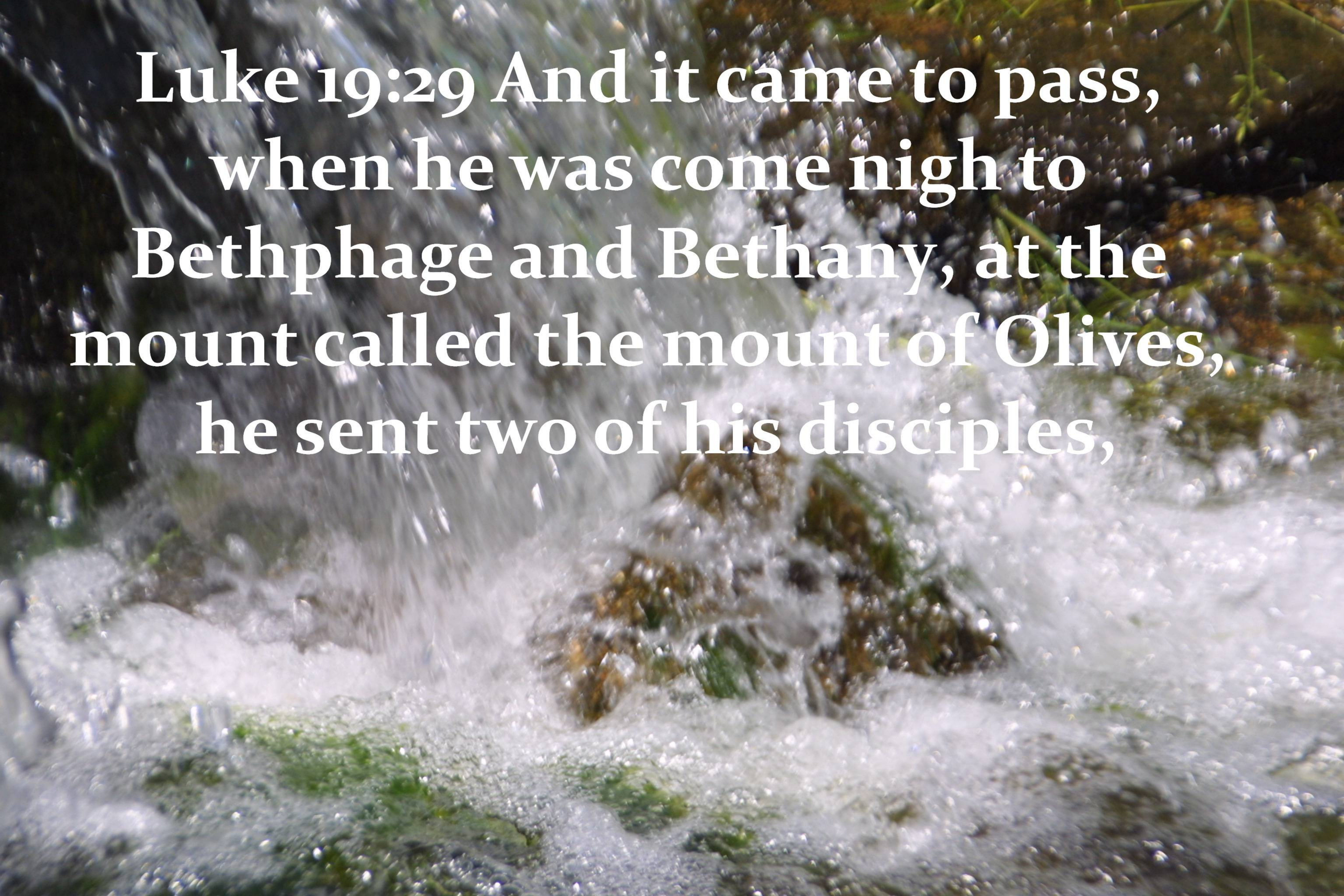






Mark 14:03 And being in Bethany

and poured it on his head.

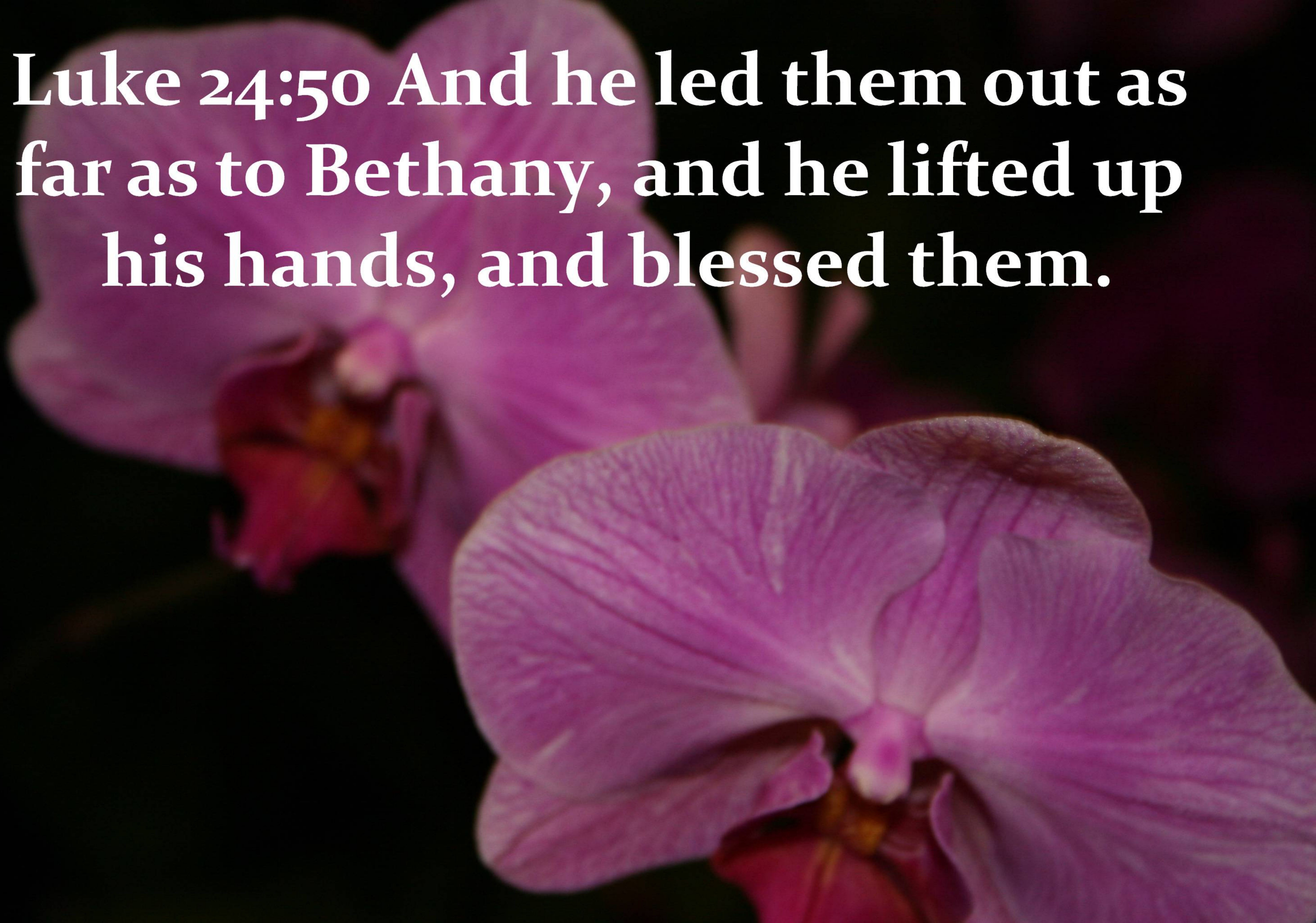




**Luke 19:29 And it came to pass,

Martha.**

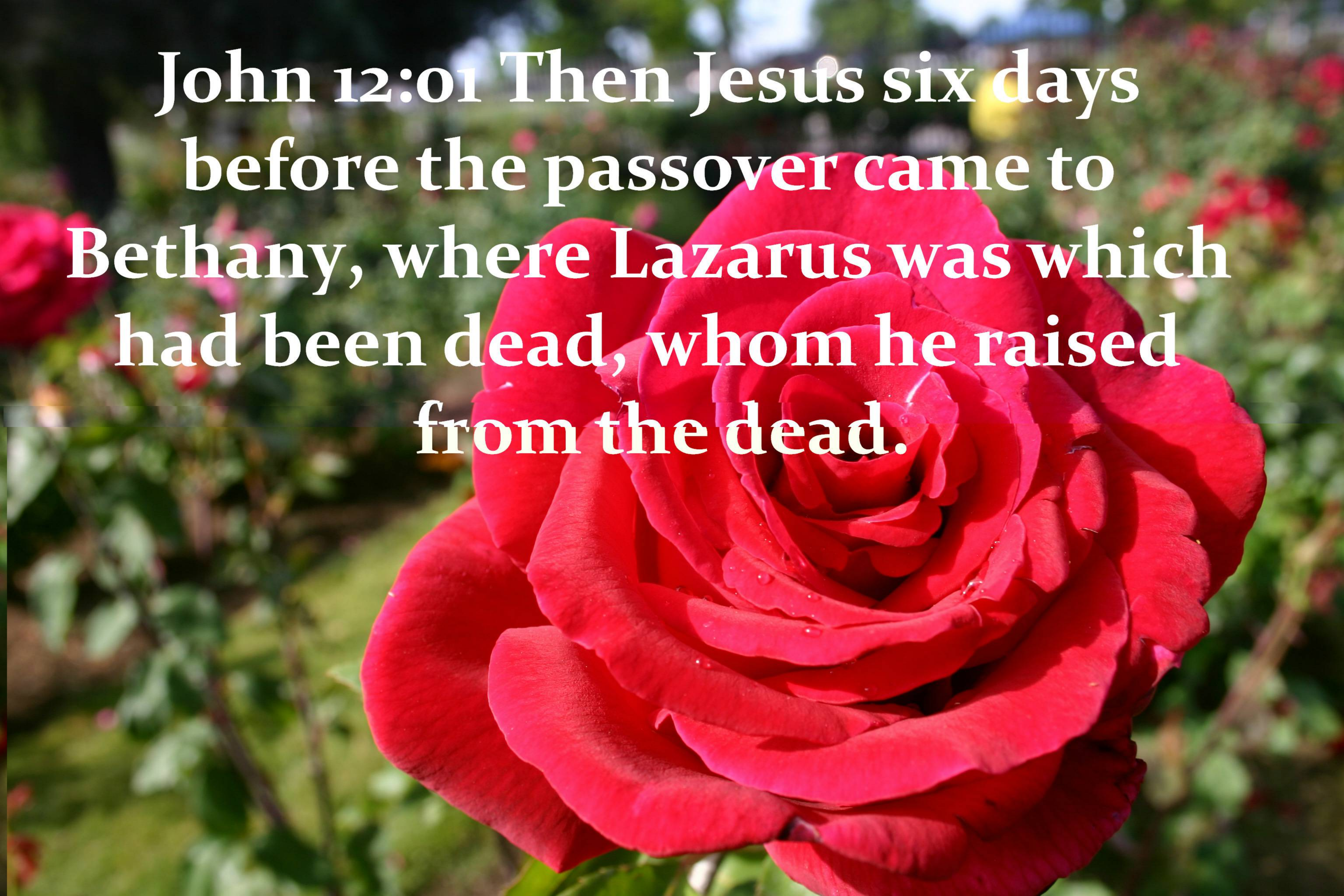




John 11:18 Now Bethany was nigh
