

with him.

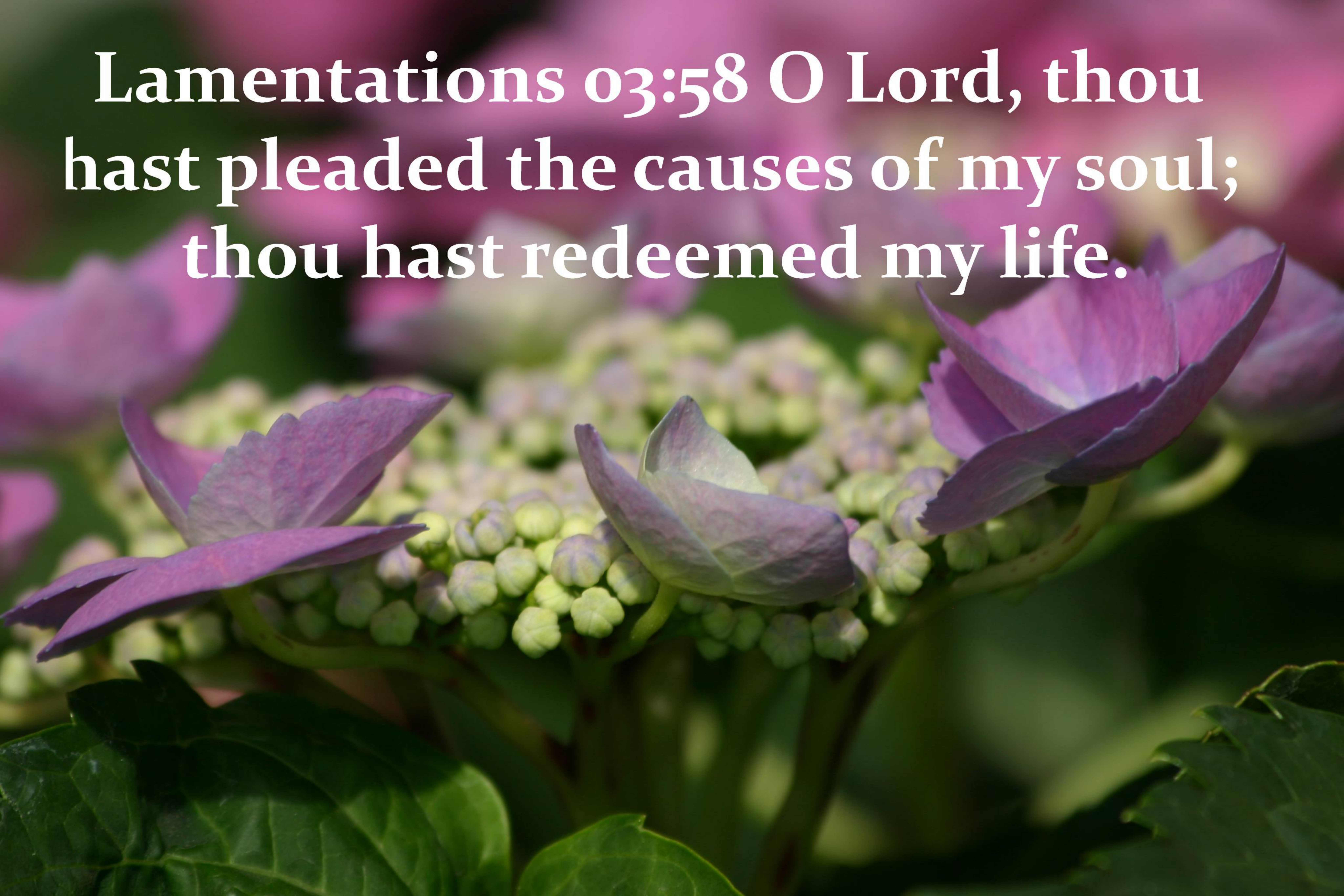


Jeremiah 03:08 And I saw, when for
