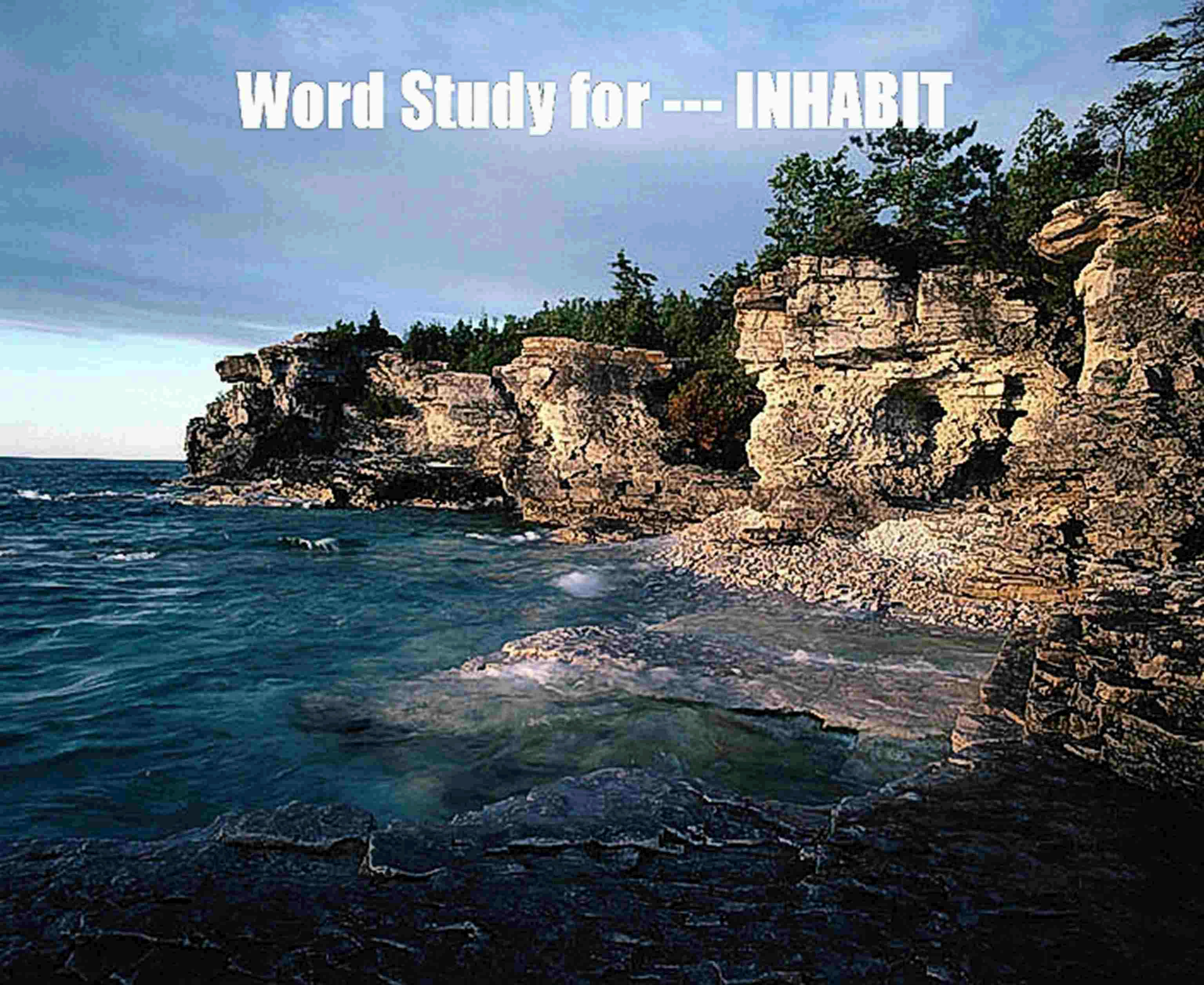
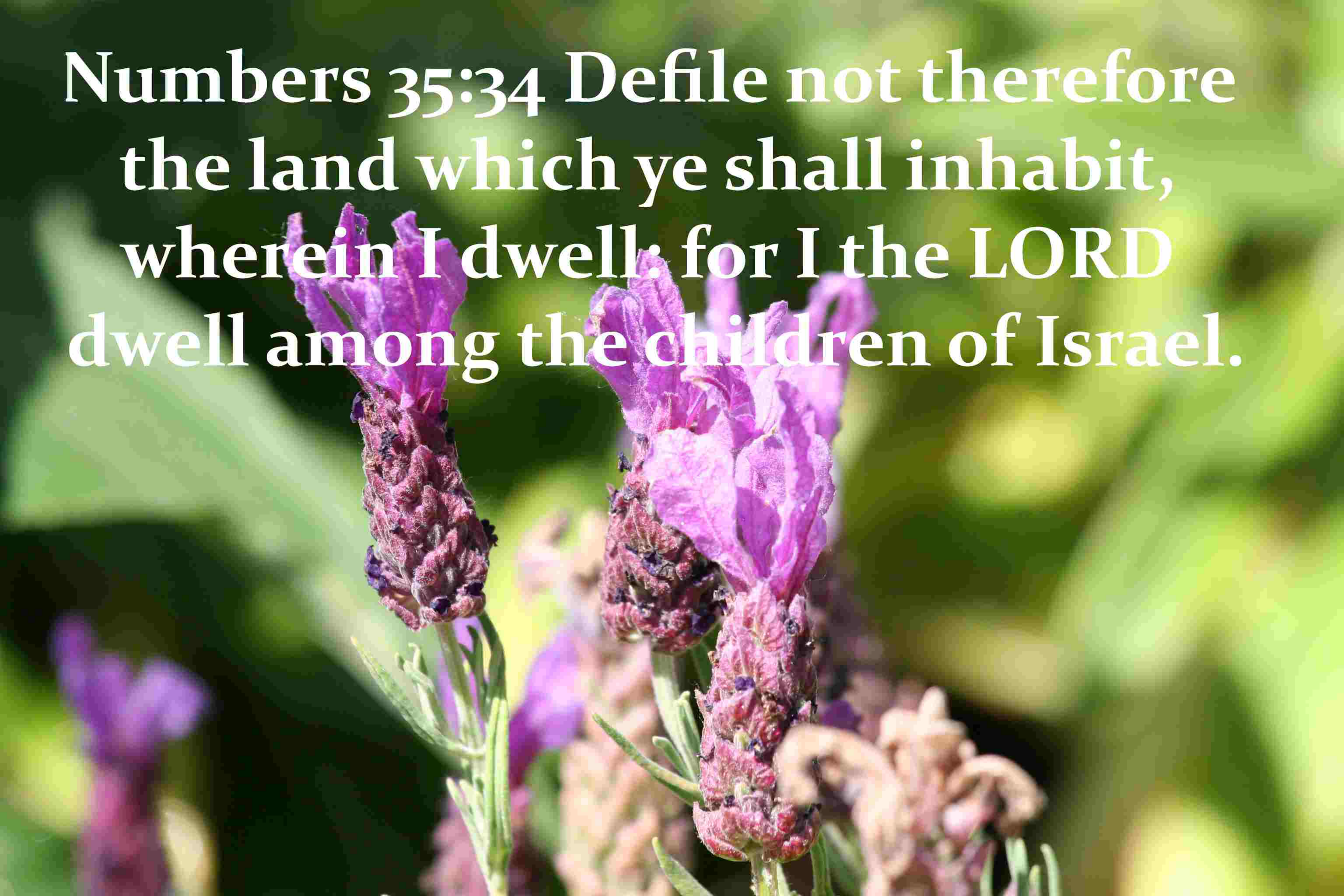

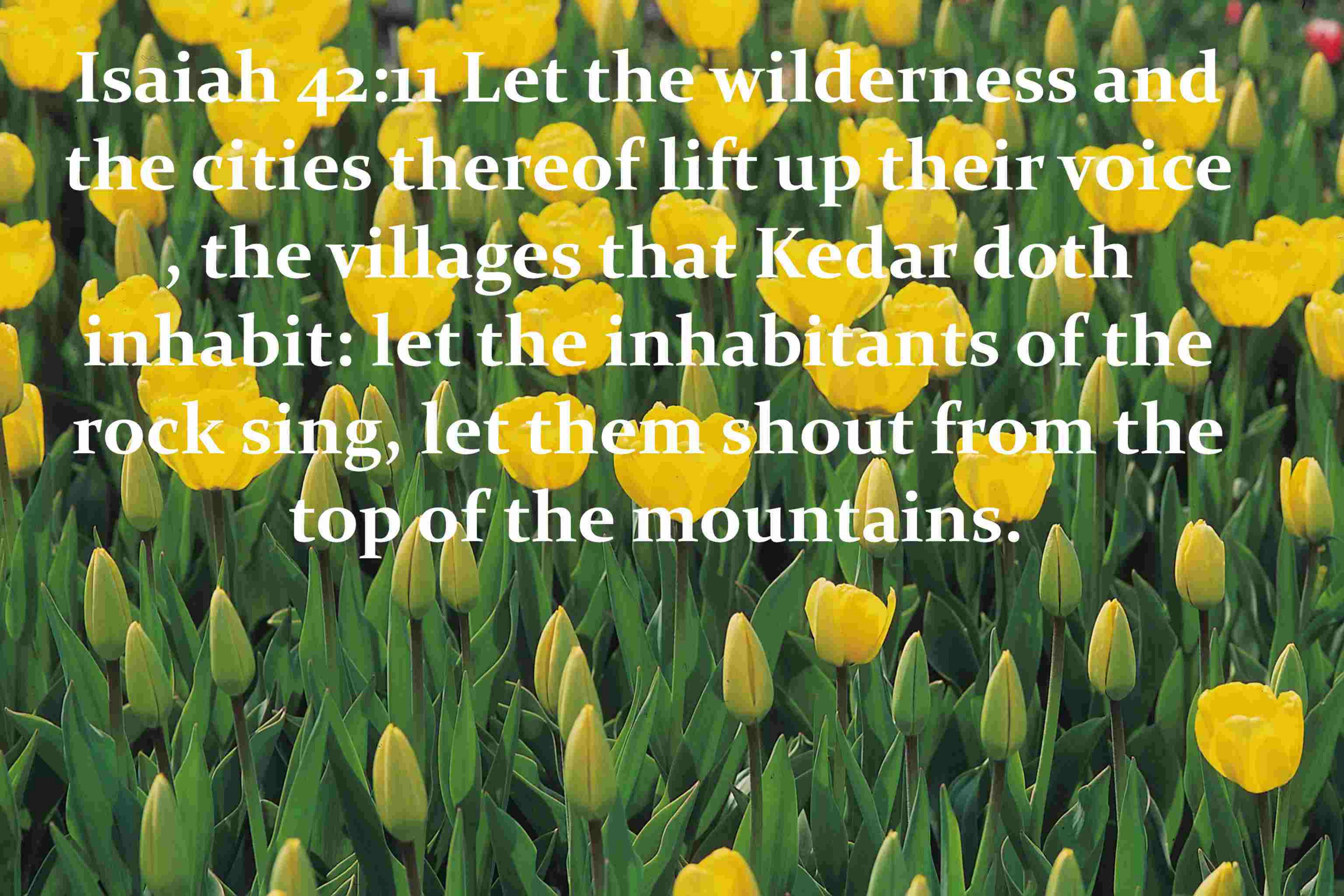


Numbers 35:34 Defile not therefore

dwell among the children of Israel.



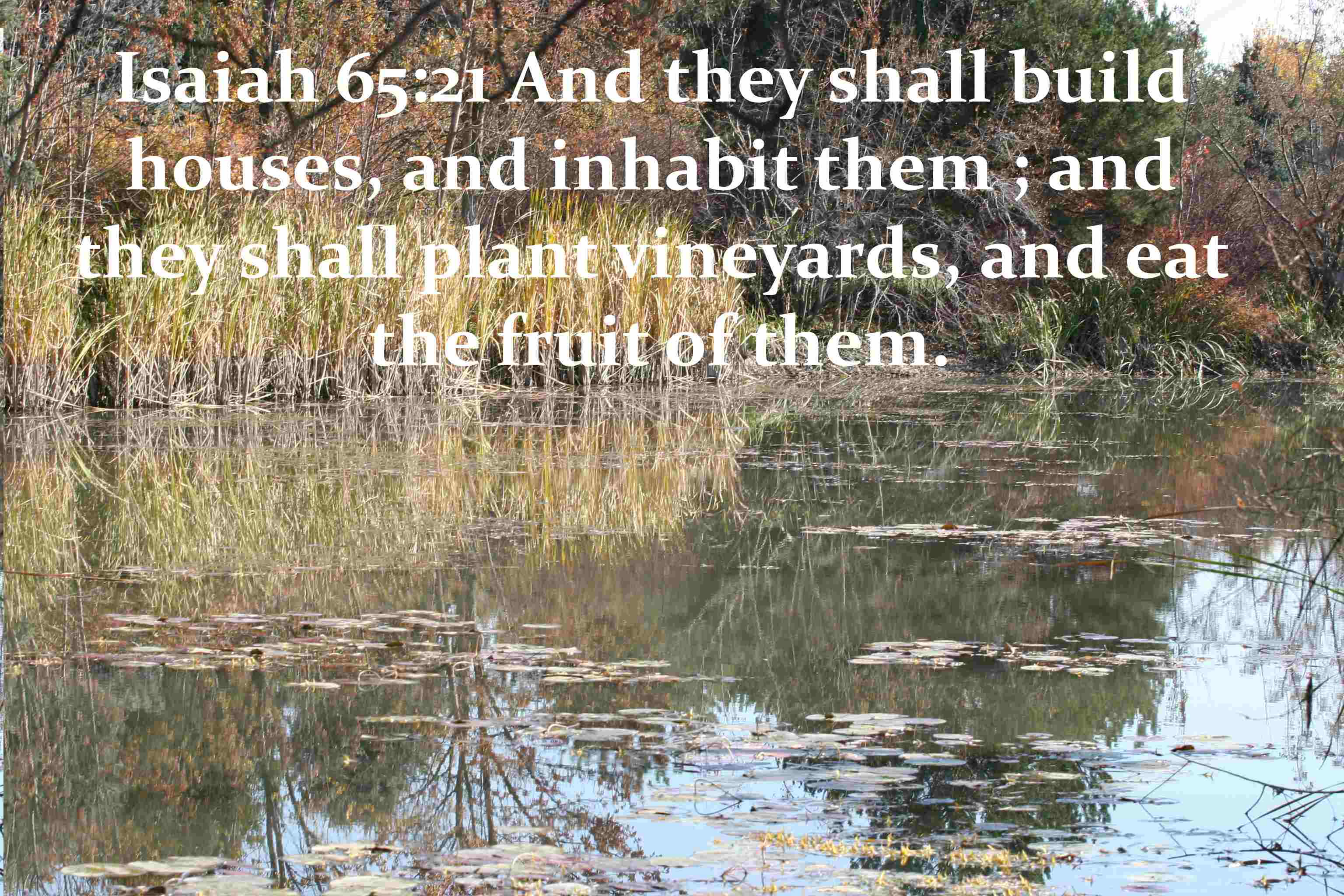







Isaiah 42:11 Let the wilderness and

the fruit of them.






Isaiah 65:22 They shall not build,

long enjoy the work of their hands.



not inhabited.


Jeremiah 48:18 Thou daughter that
