

own house.**











Judges 09:02 Speak, I pray you, in

that I am your bone and your flesh.








Judges 09:16 Now therefore, if ye



his brethren.**

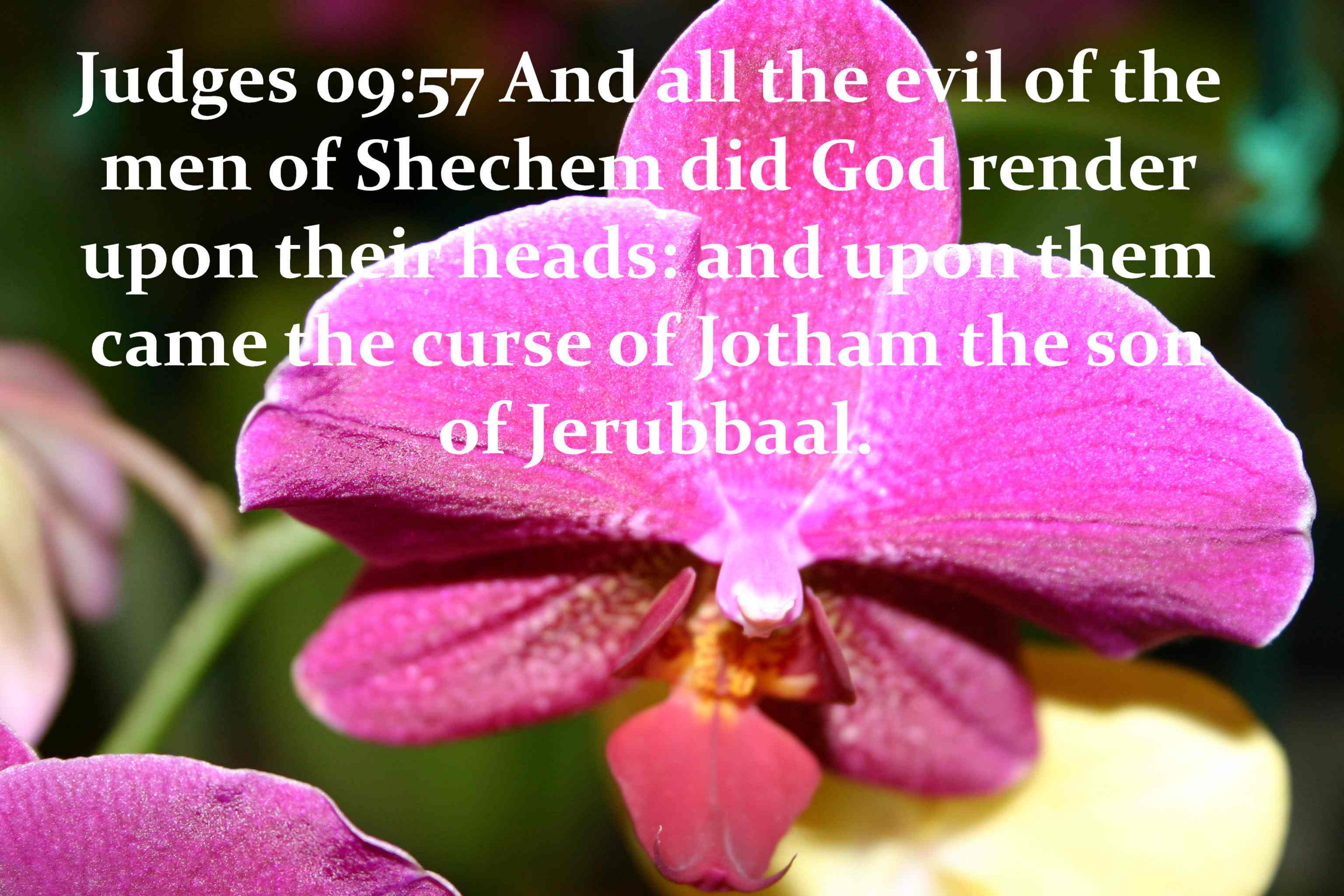


Judges 09:28 And Gaal the son of
