thy brother Nahor;

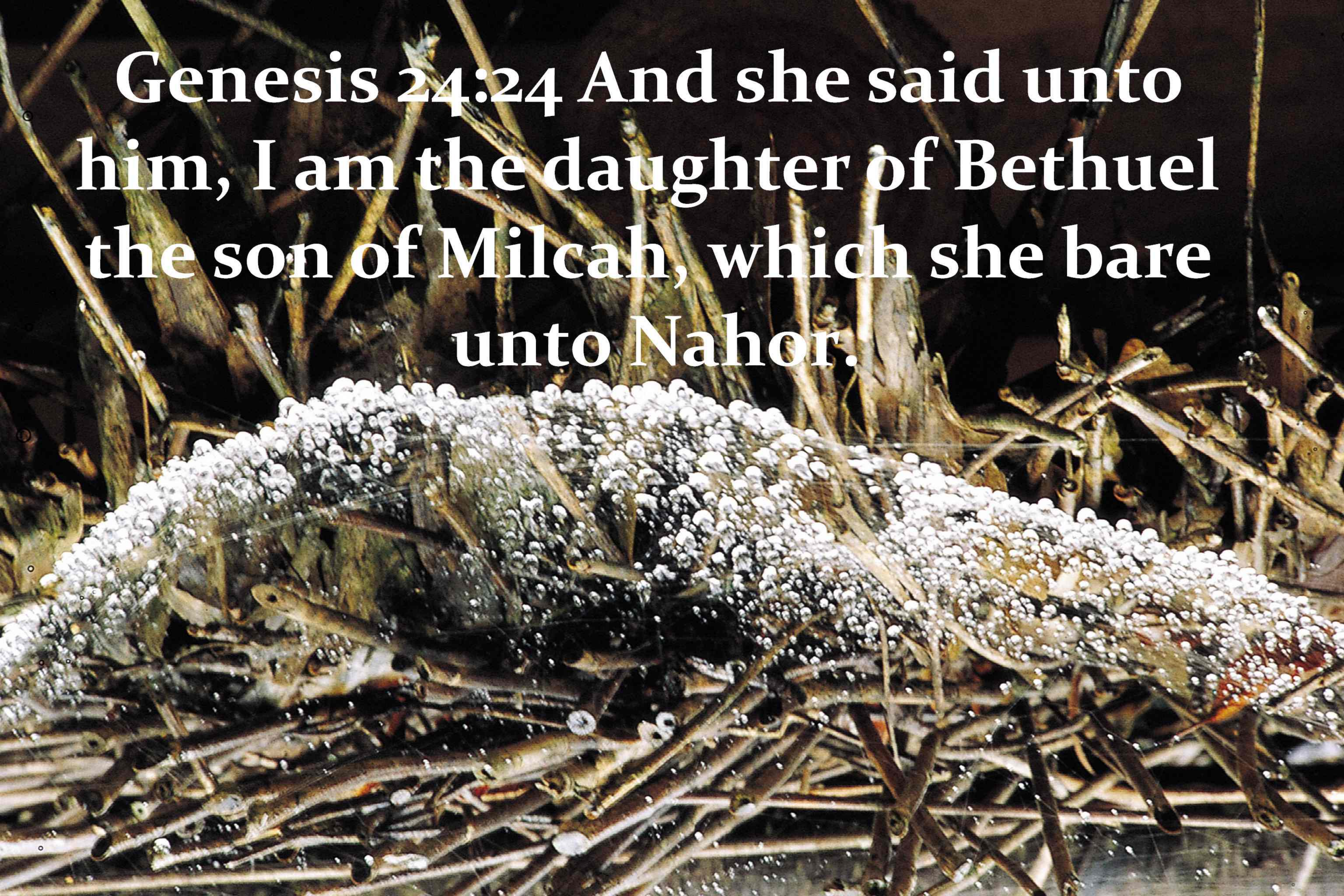


Genesis 22:23 And Bethuel begat

bear to Nahor, Abraham's brother.

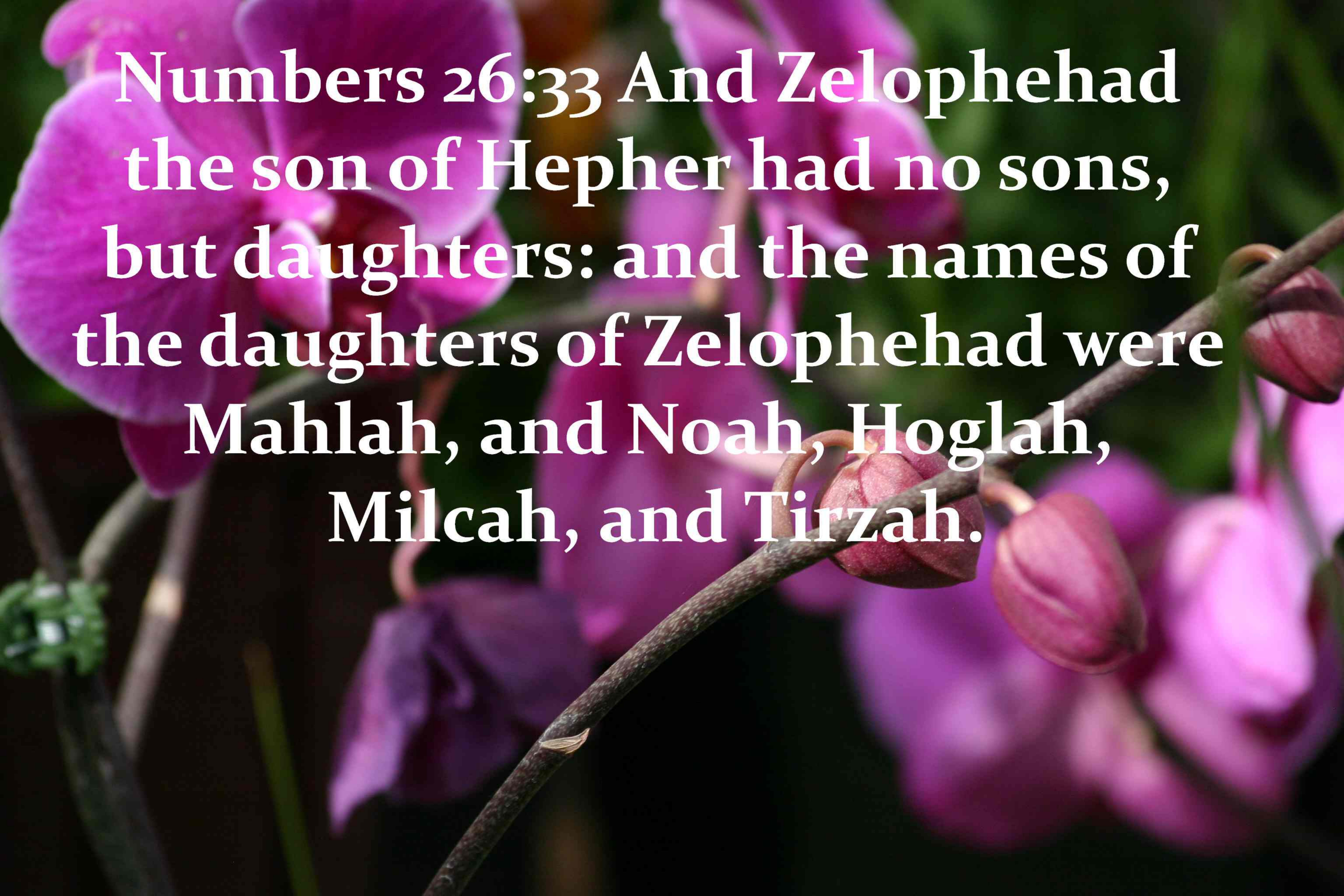


Genesis 24:15 And it came to pass,

shoulder.

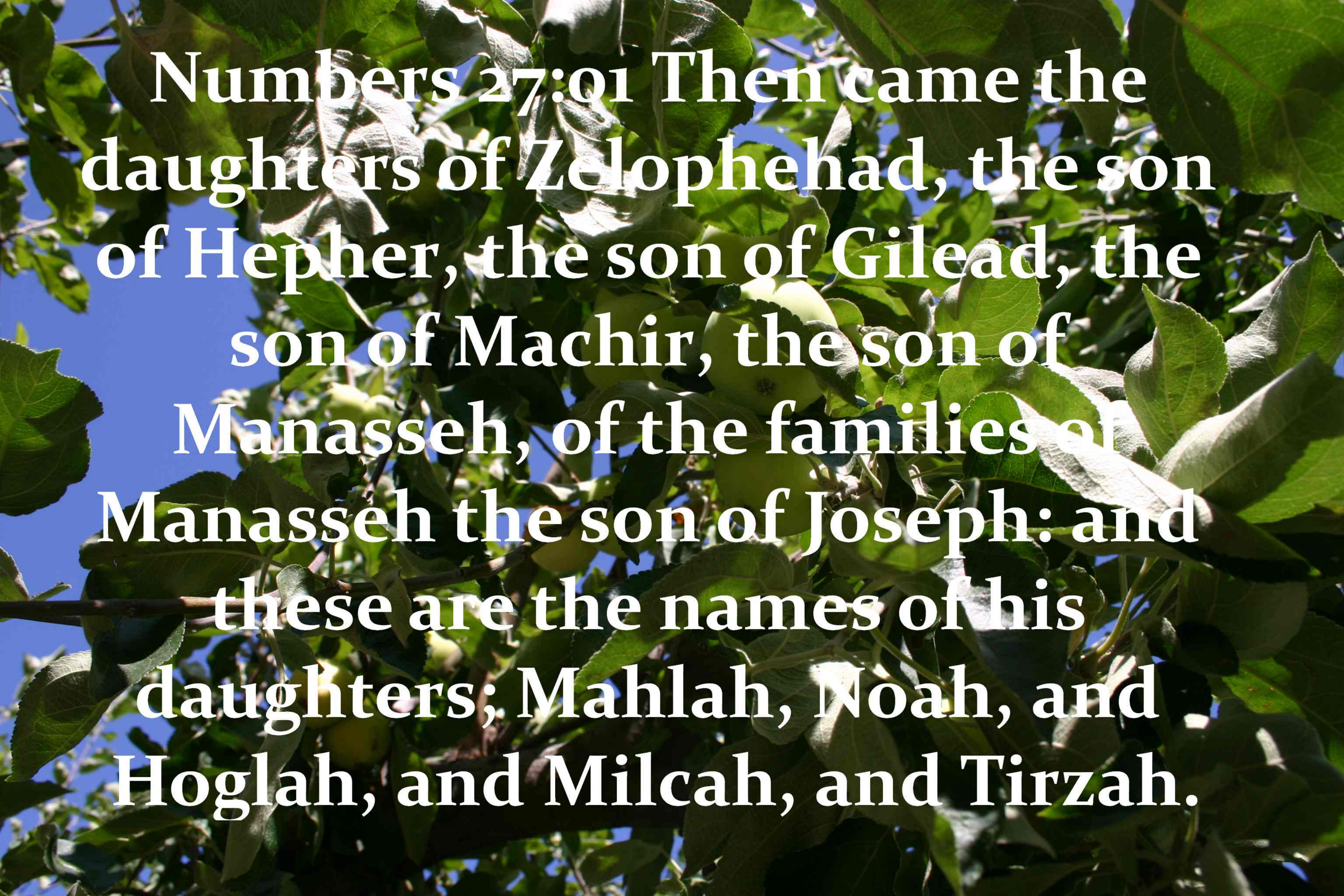
Genesis 24:24 And she said unto him, I am the daughter of Bethuel the son of Milcah, which she bare unto Nahor.



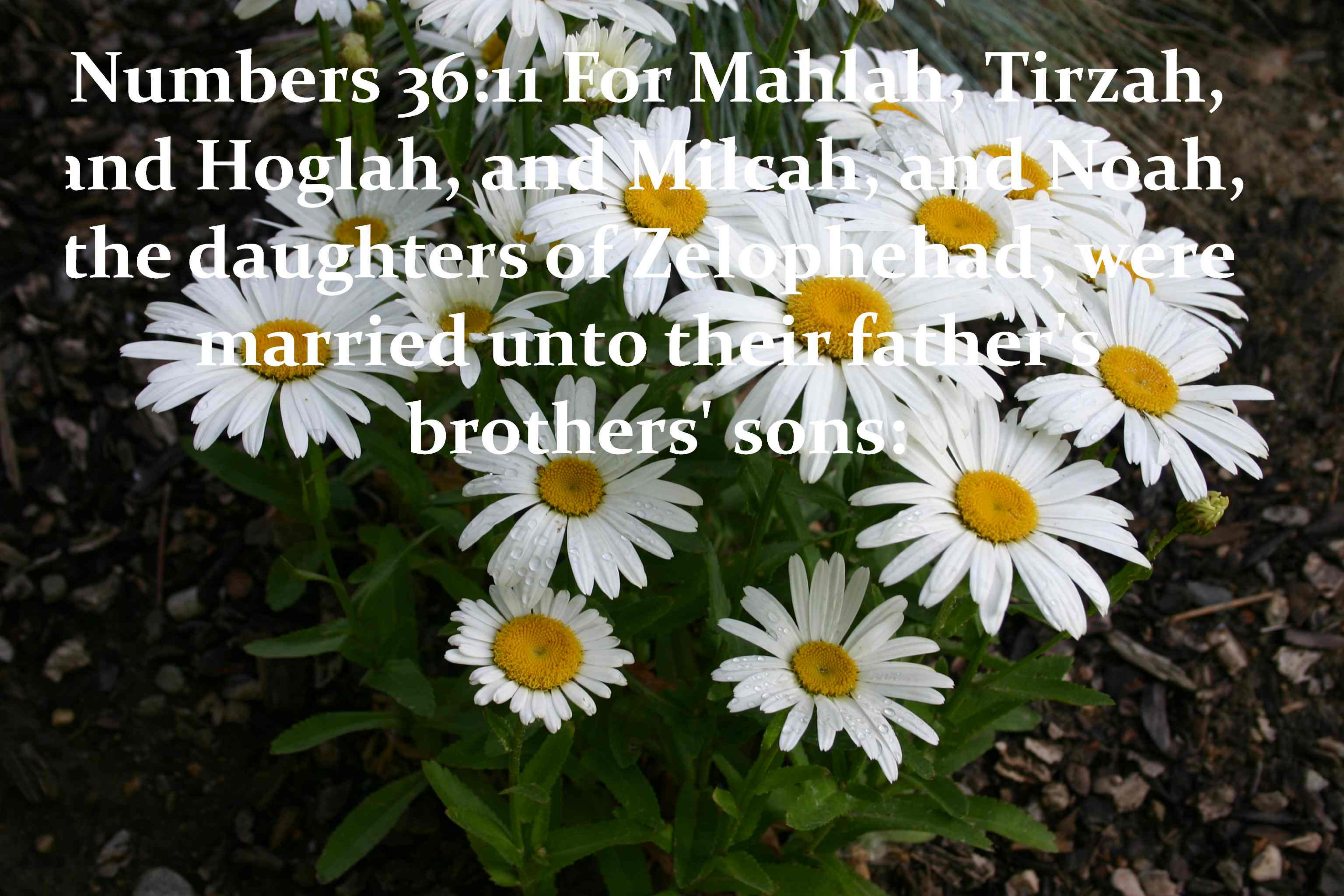
Genesis 24:47 And I asked her, and

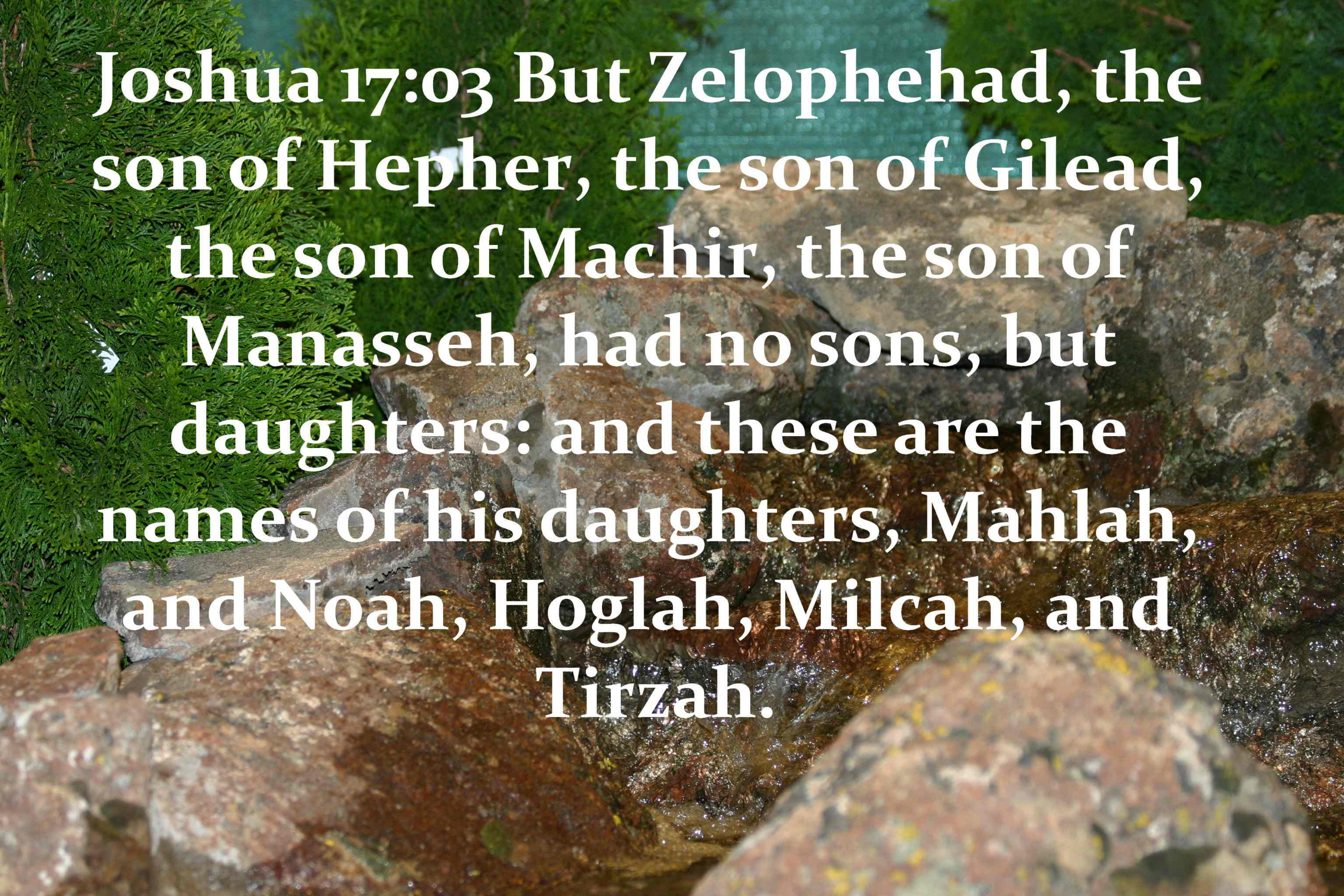
