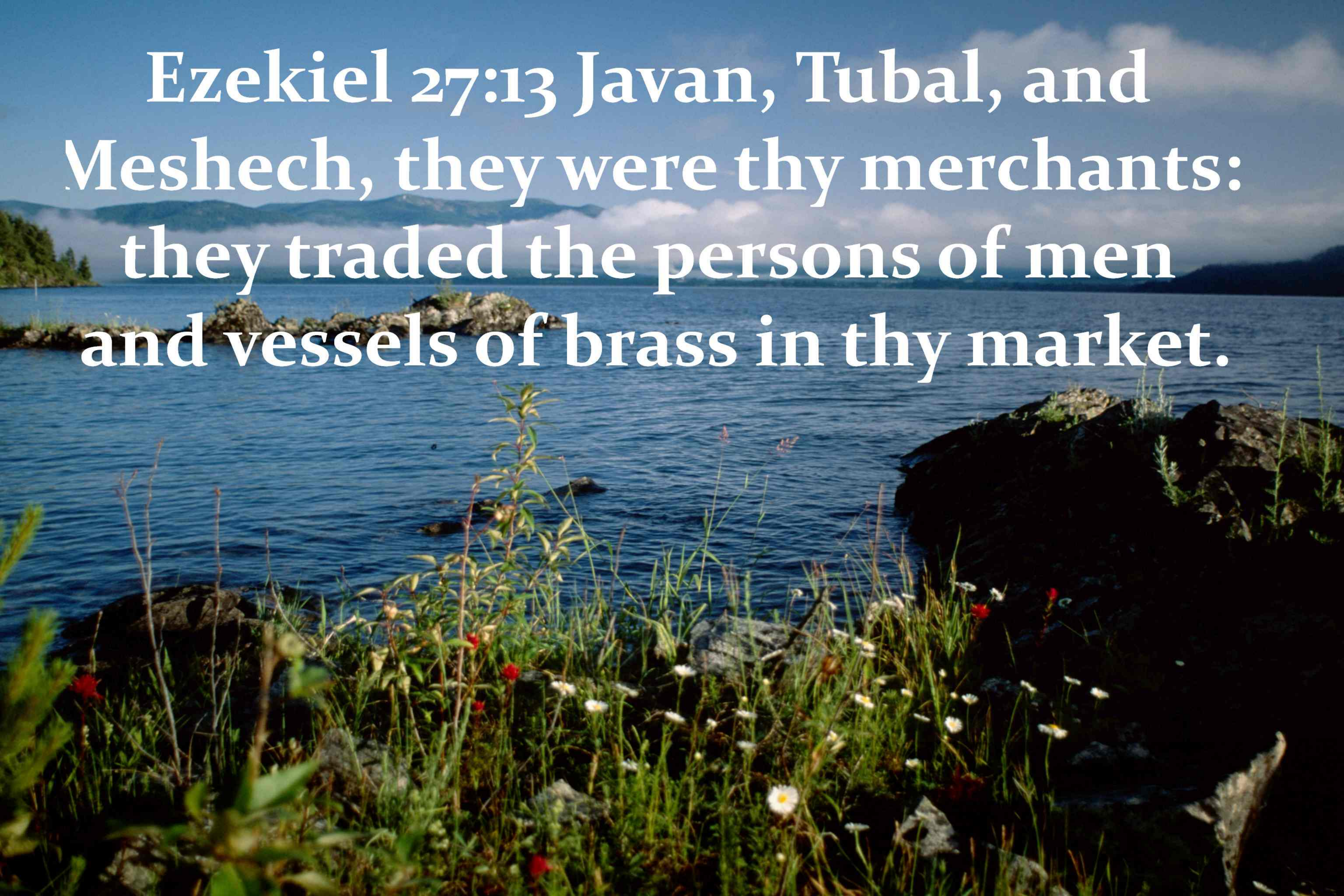


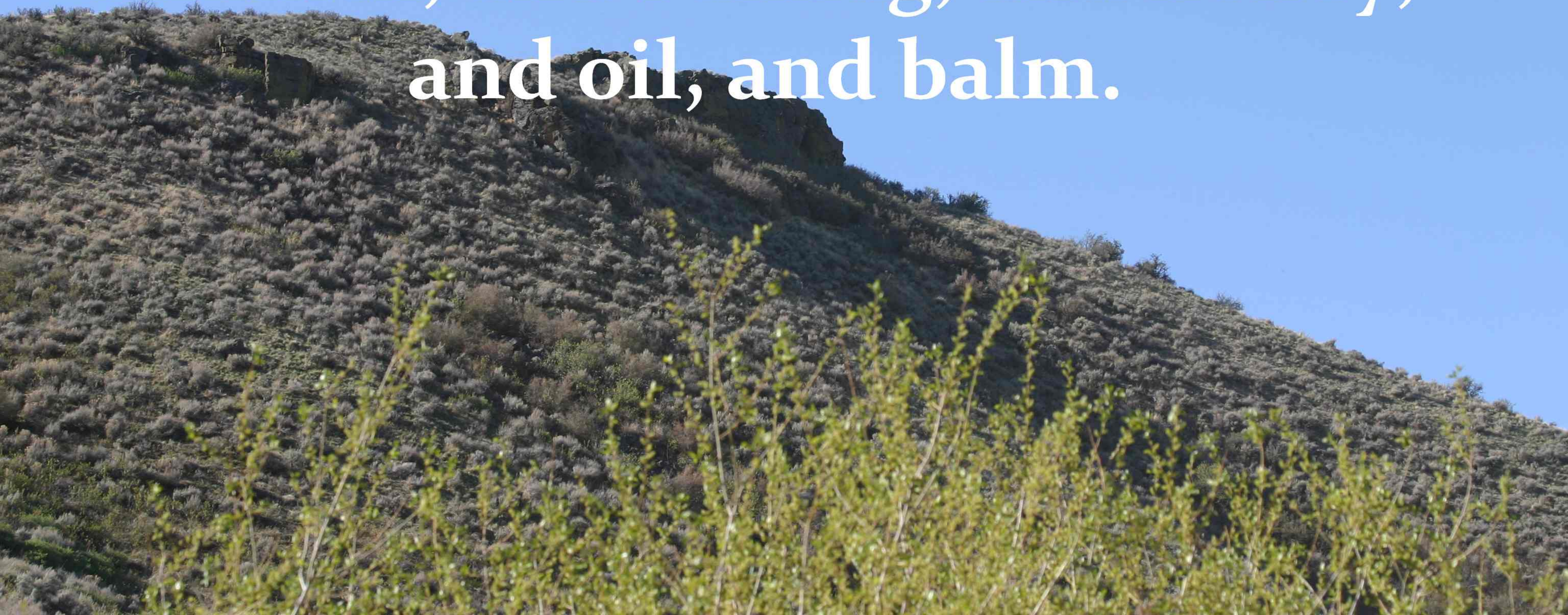


Ezekiel 27:13 Javan, Tubal, and

and vessels of brass in thy market.




Ezekiel 27:17 Judah, and the land

and oil, and balm.




Ezekiel 27:19 Dan also and Javan
