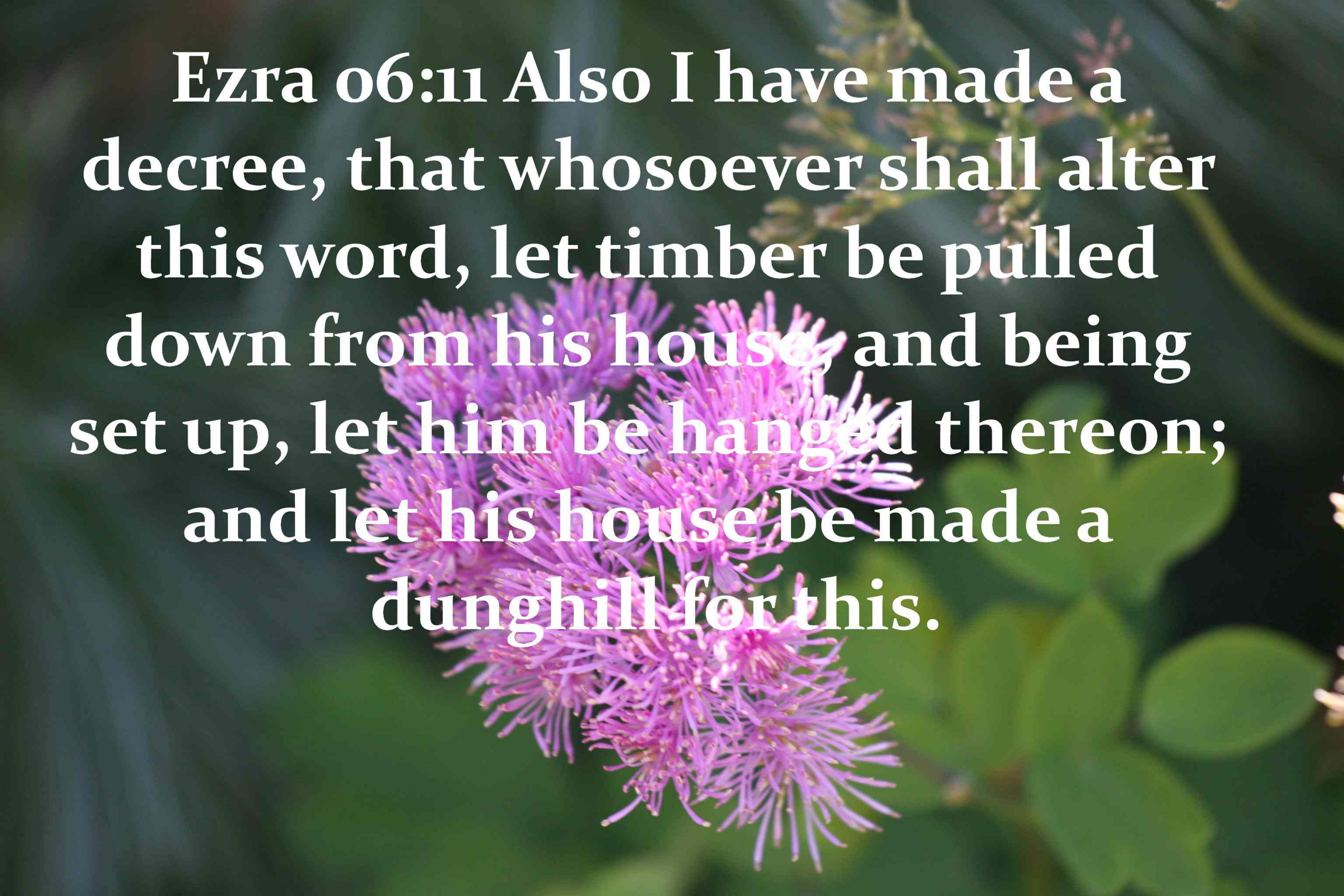
Genesis 08:09 But the dove found

her in unto him into the ark.

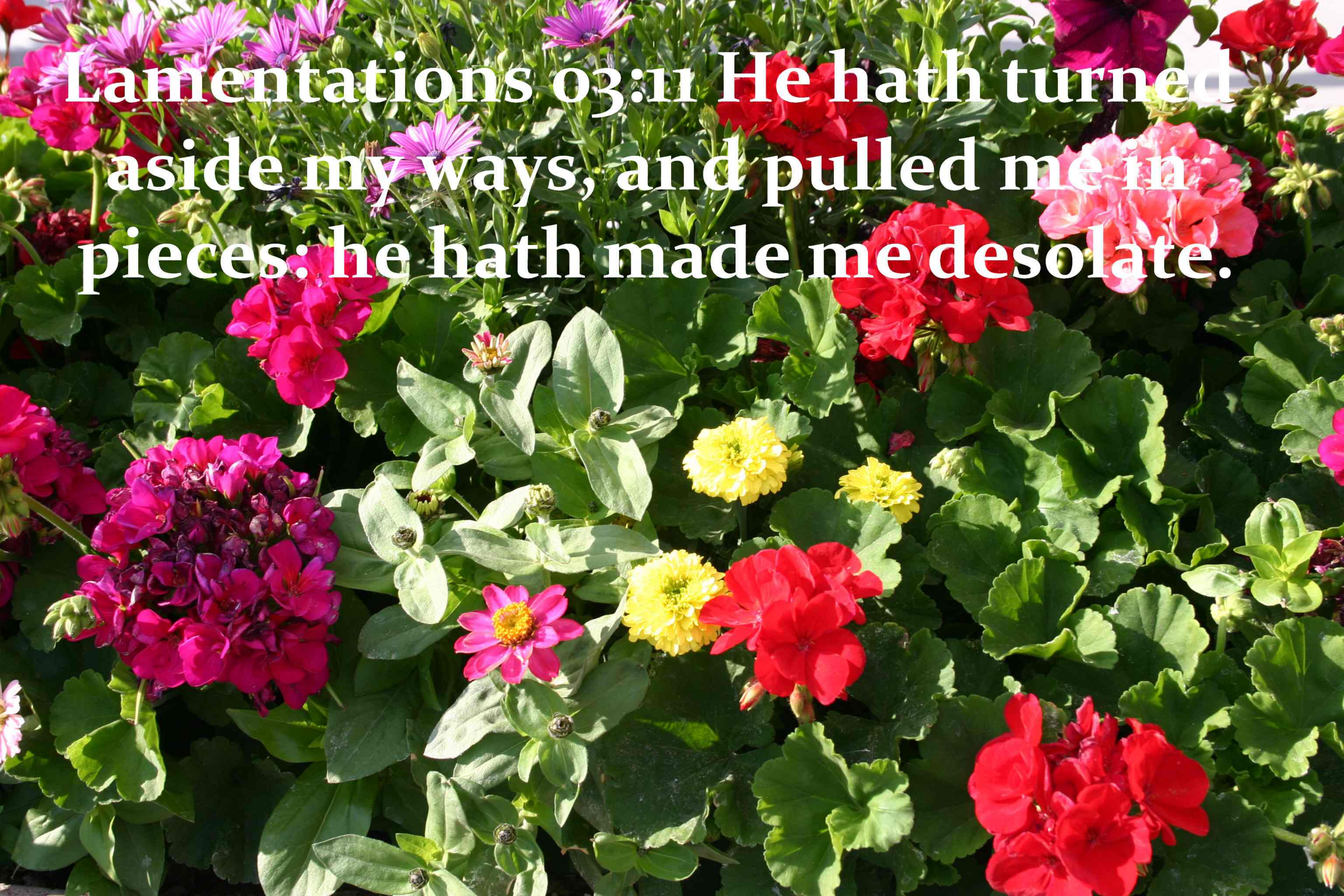

dunghill for this.

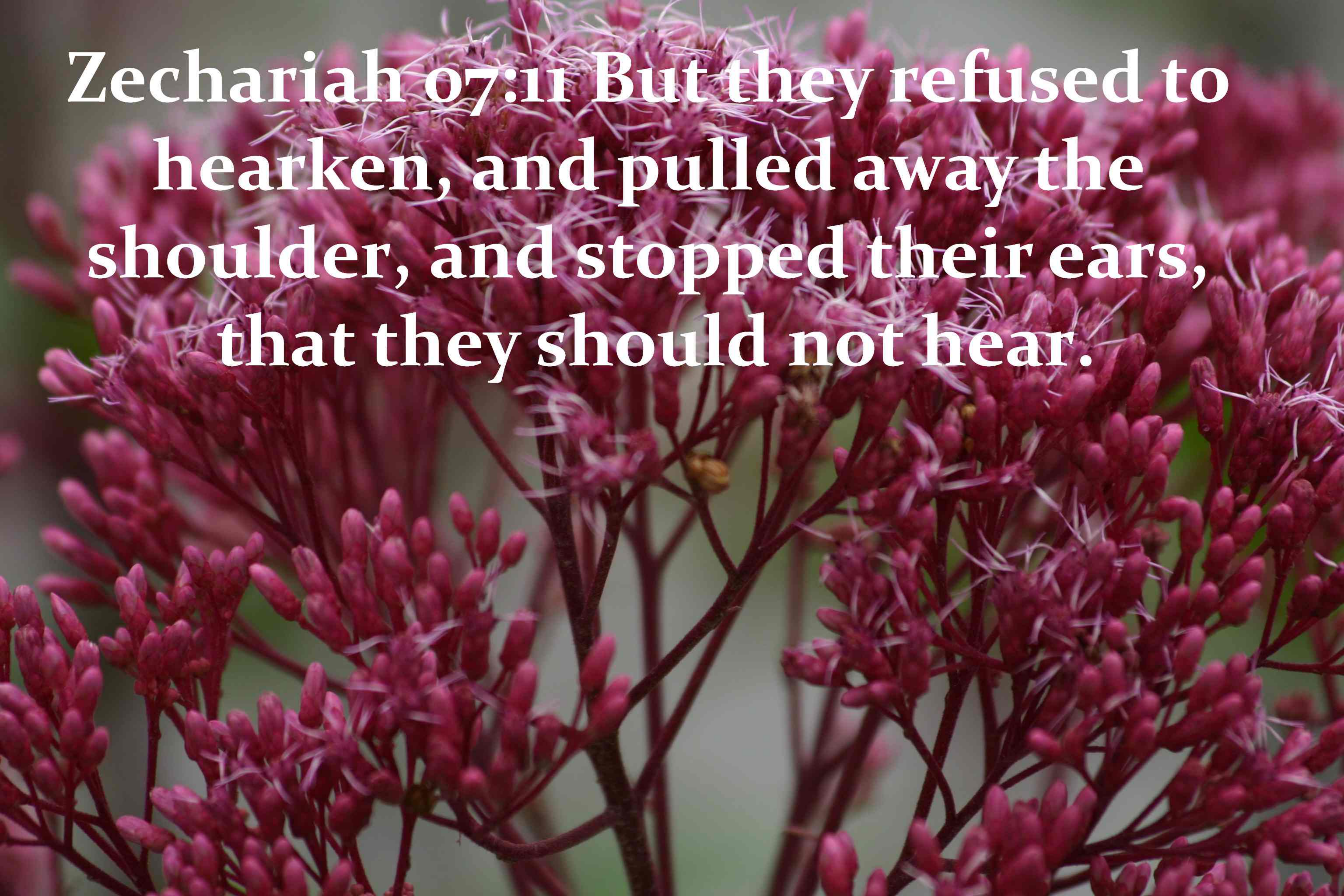




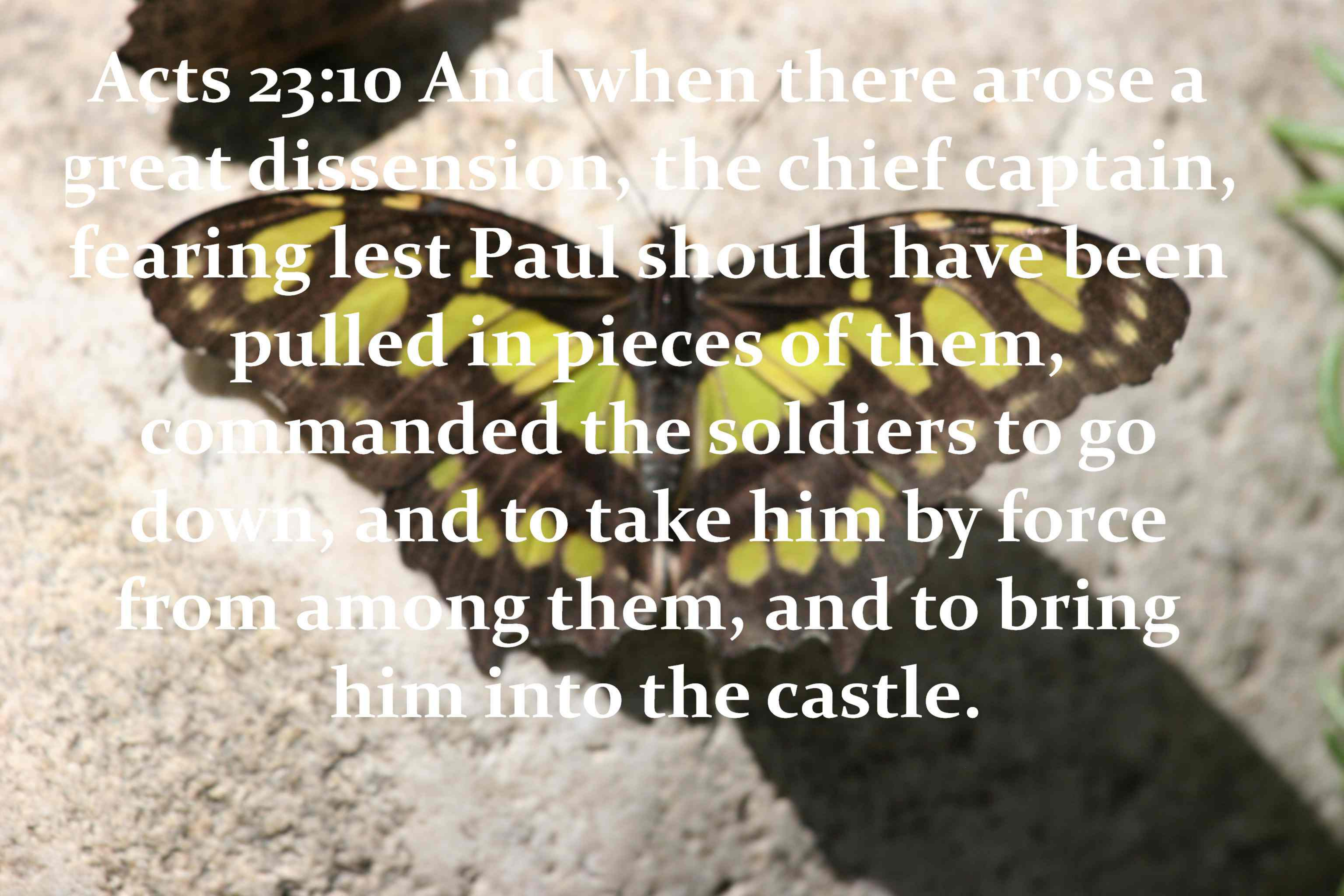
