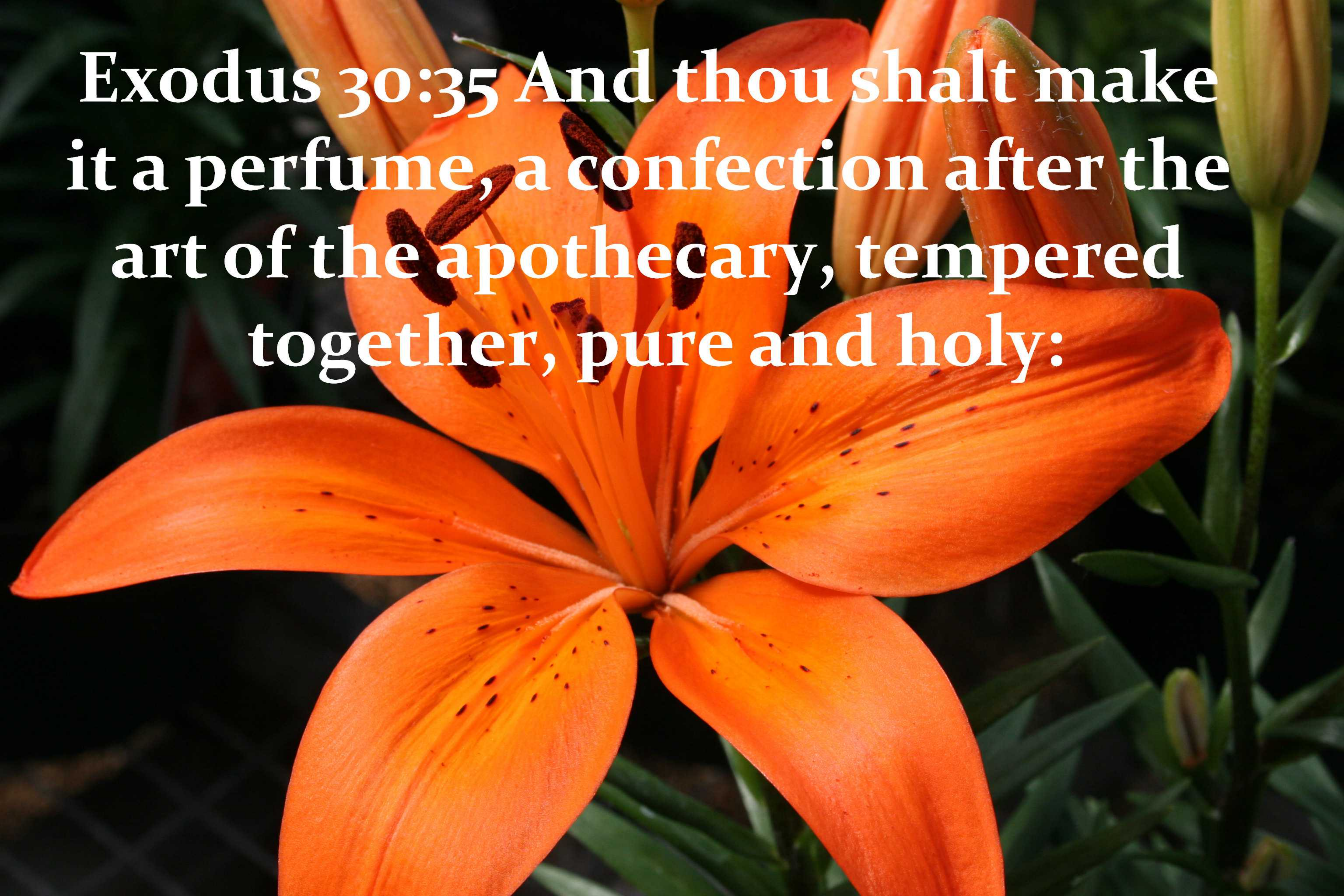


Word Study for --- TEMPERED
