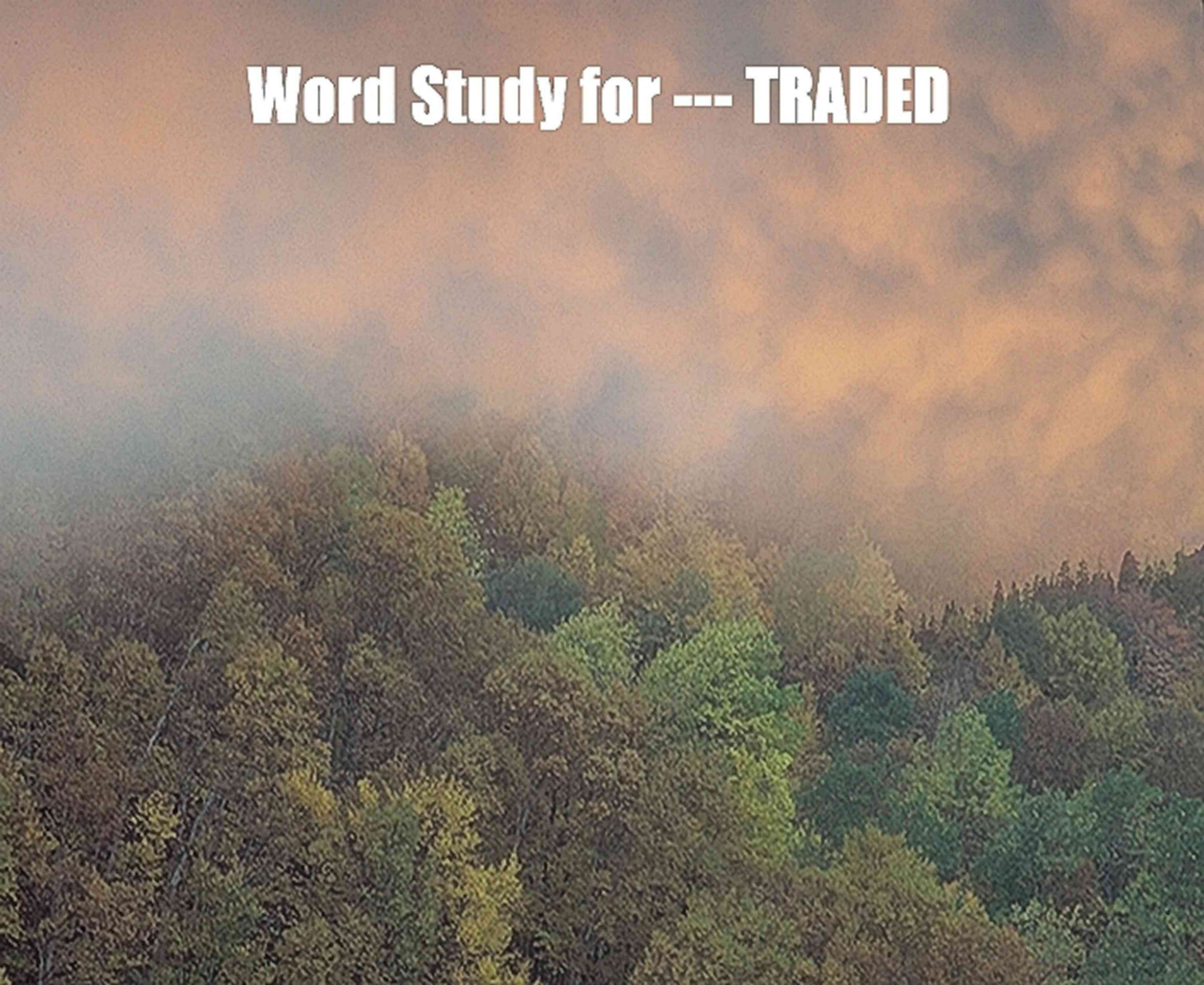
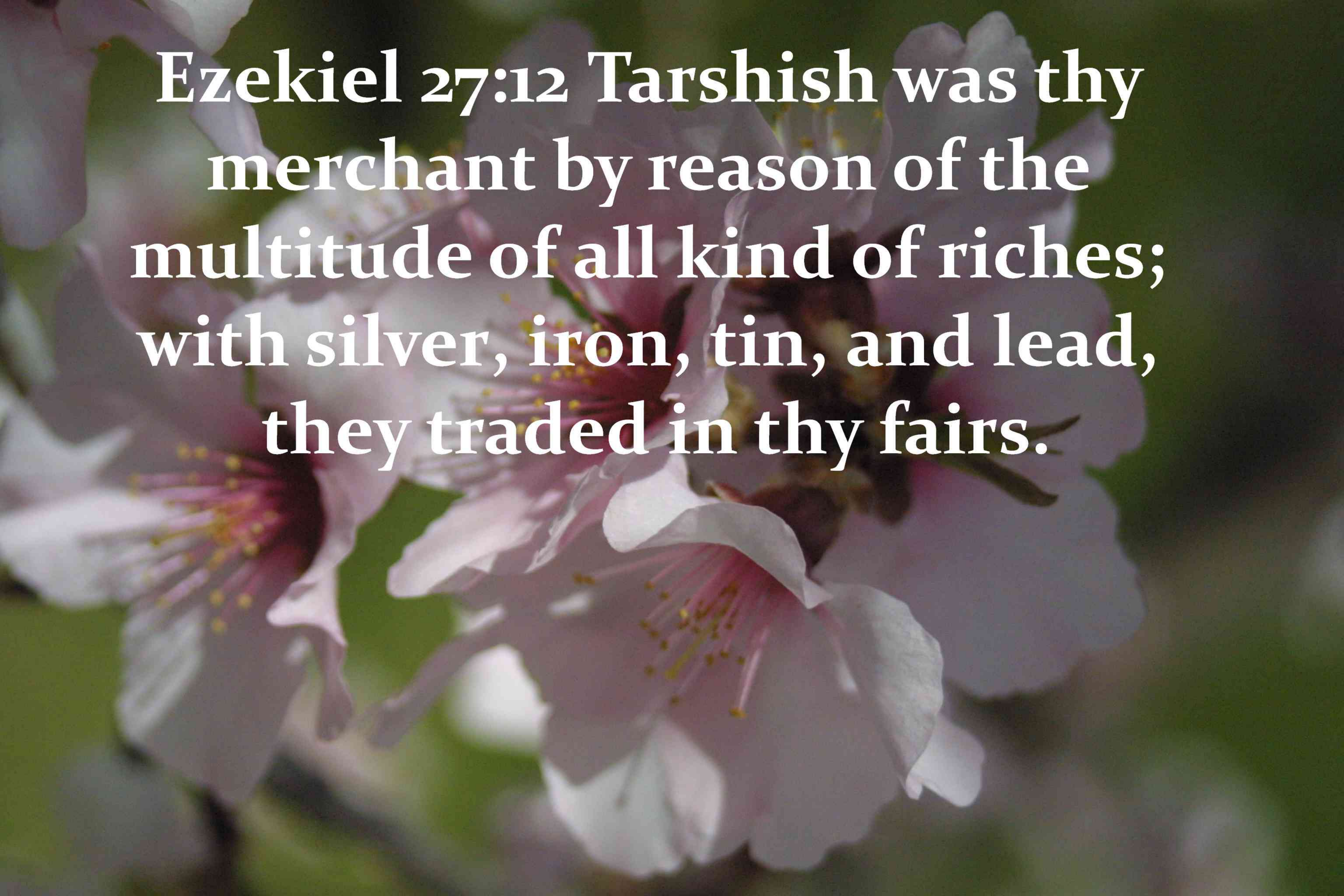


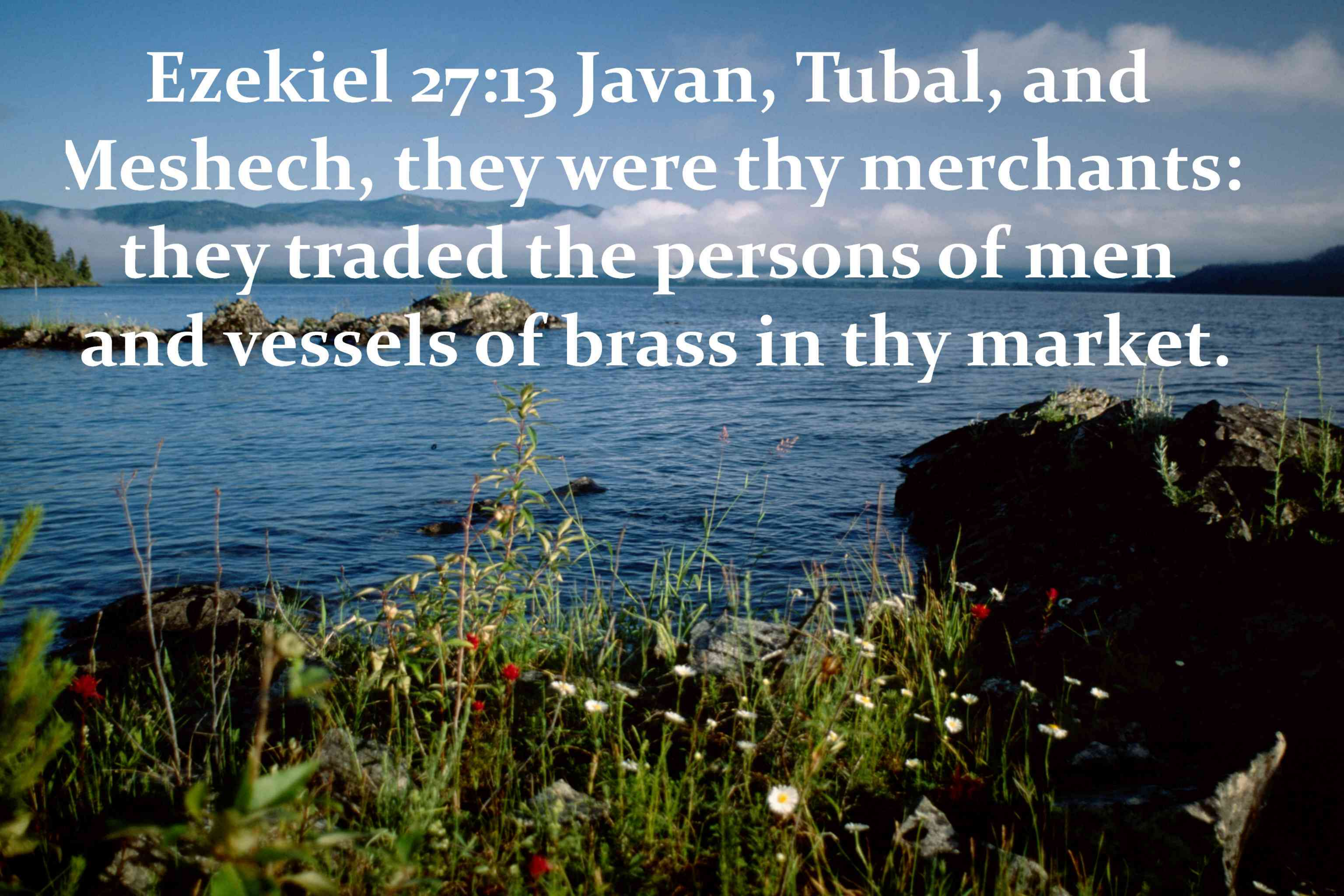

they traded in thy fairs.

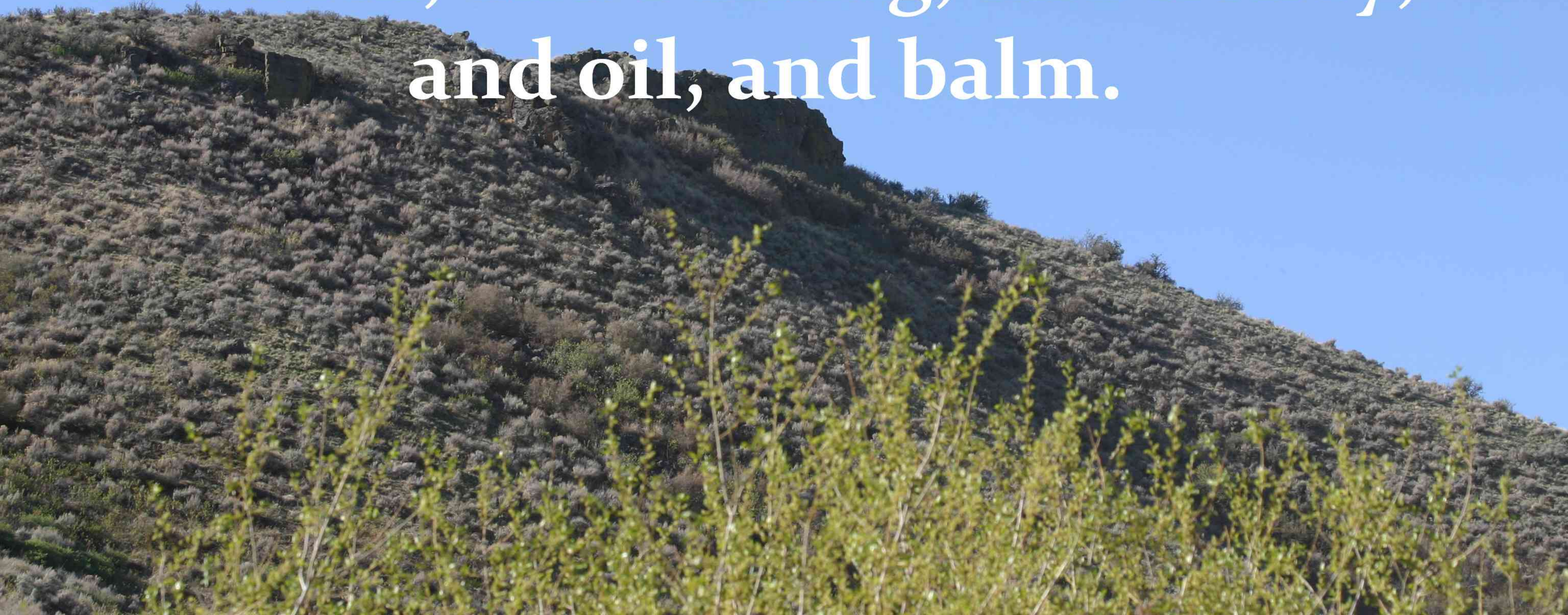
