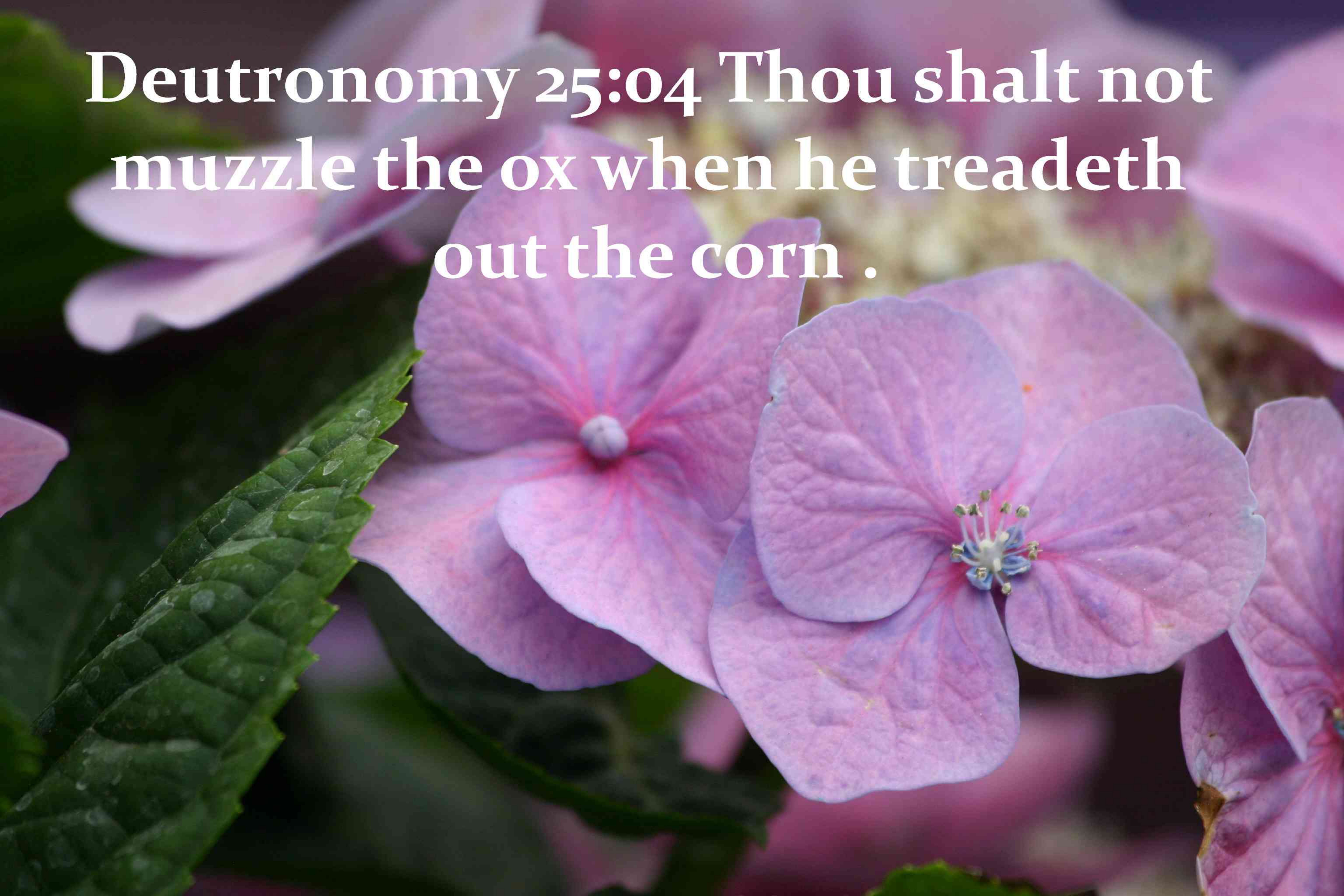


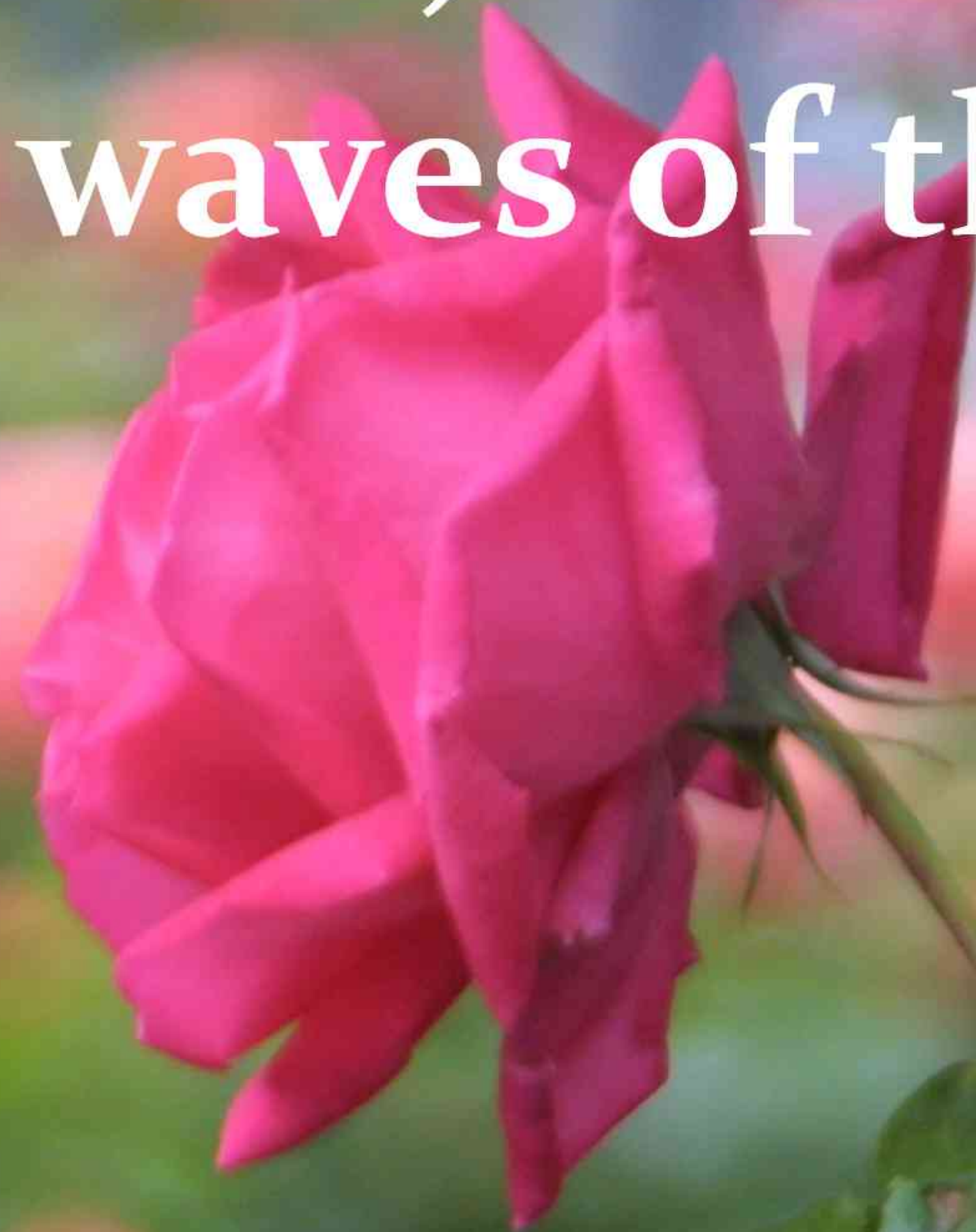

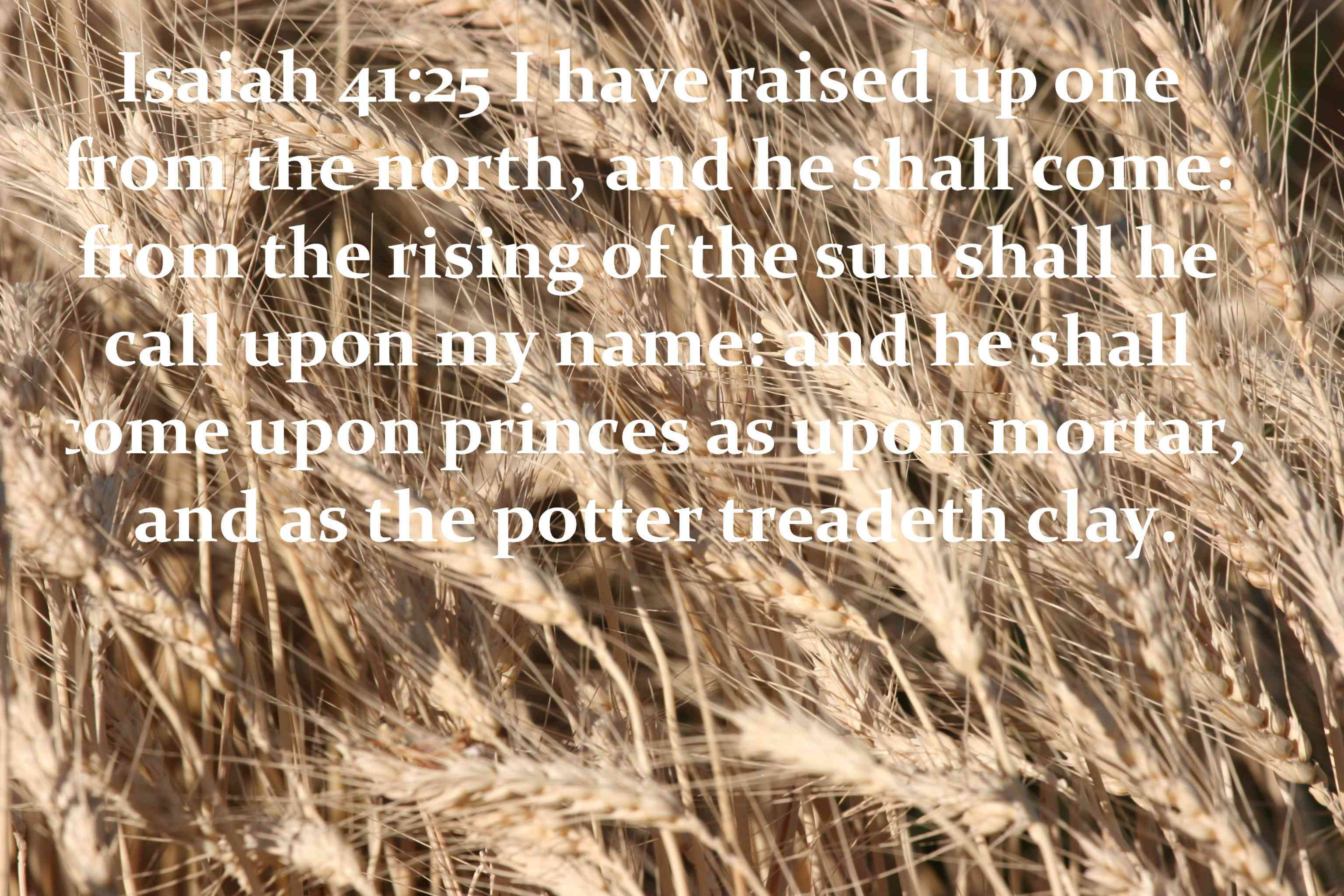


Deuteronomy 25:04 Thou shalt not

upon the waves of the sea.

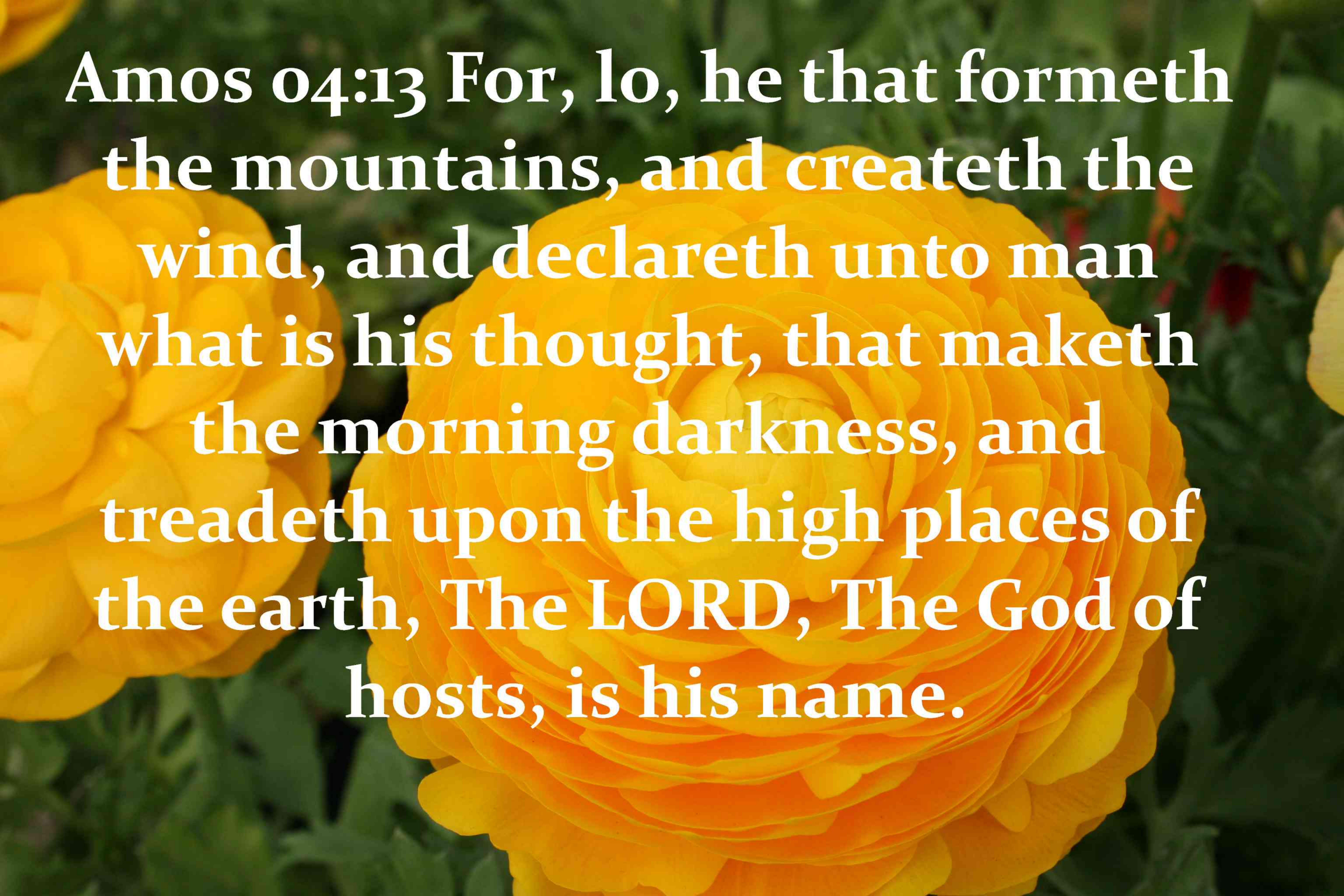




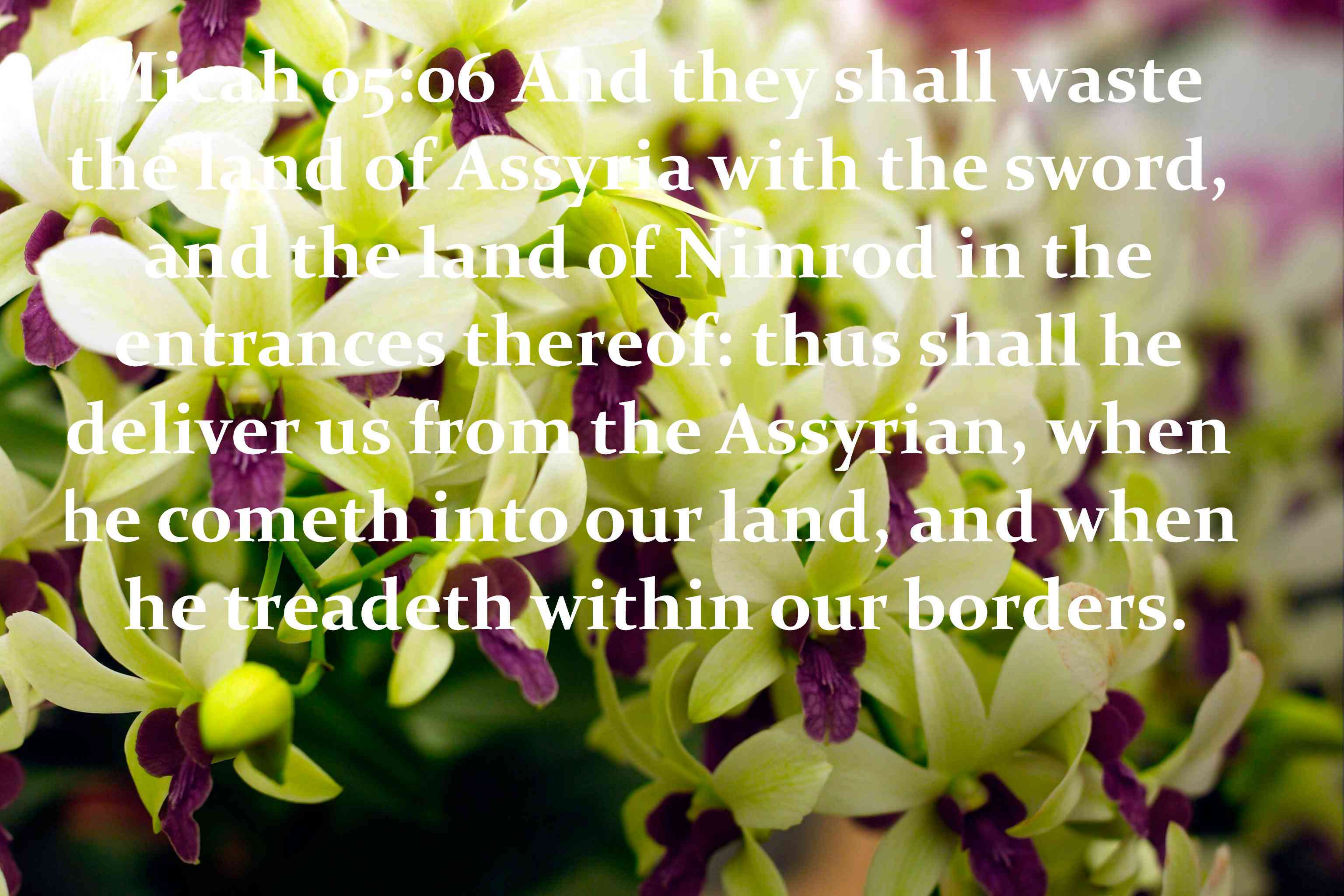
Isaiah 41:25 I have raised up one

and as the potter treadeth clay.



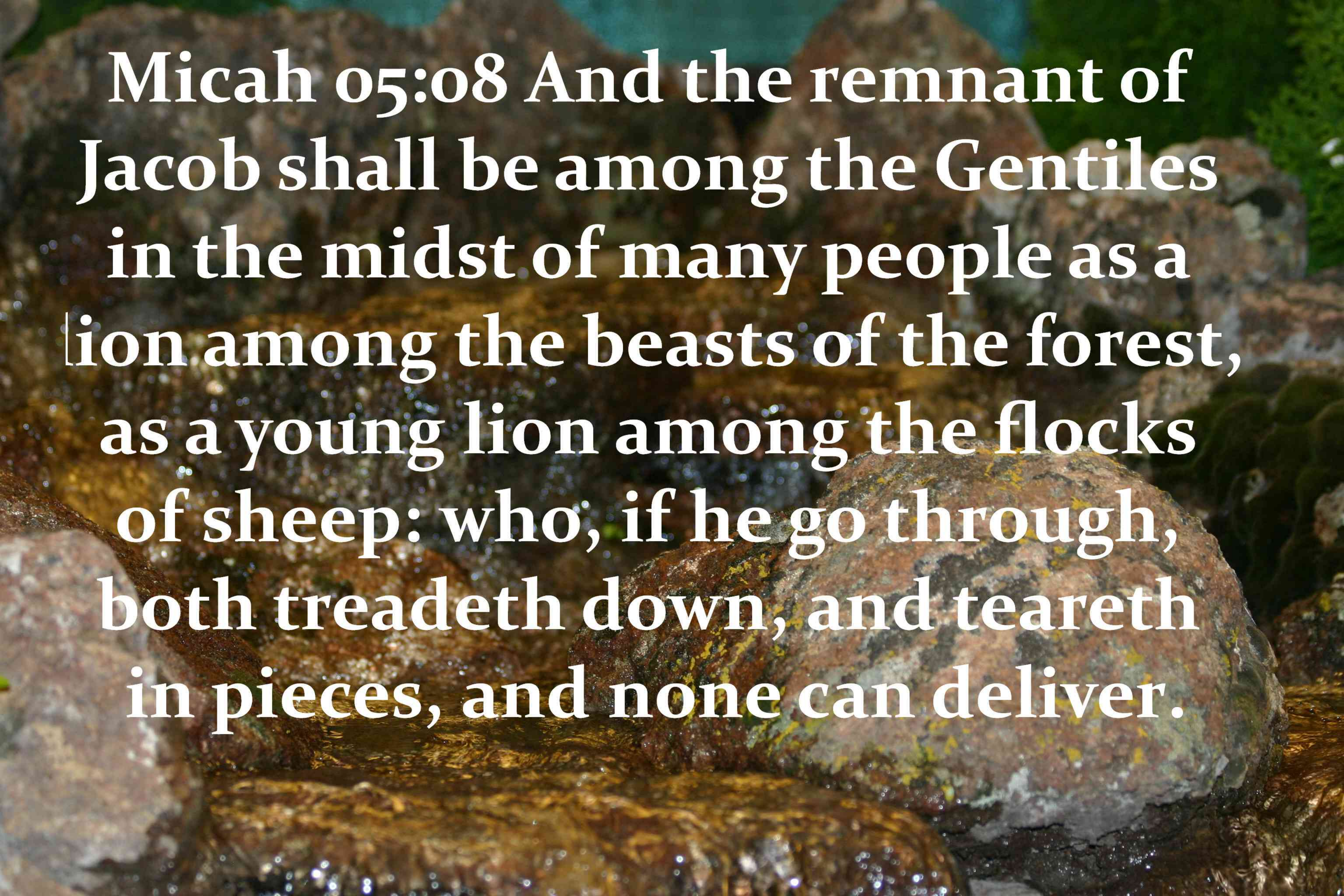
Isaiah 63:02 Wherefore art thou

hosts, is his name.



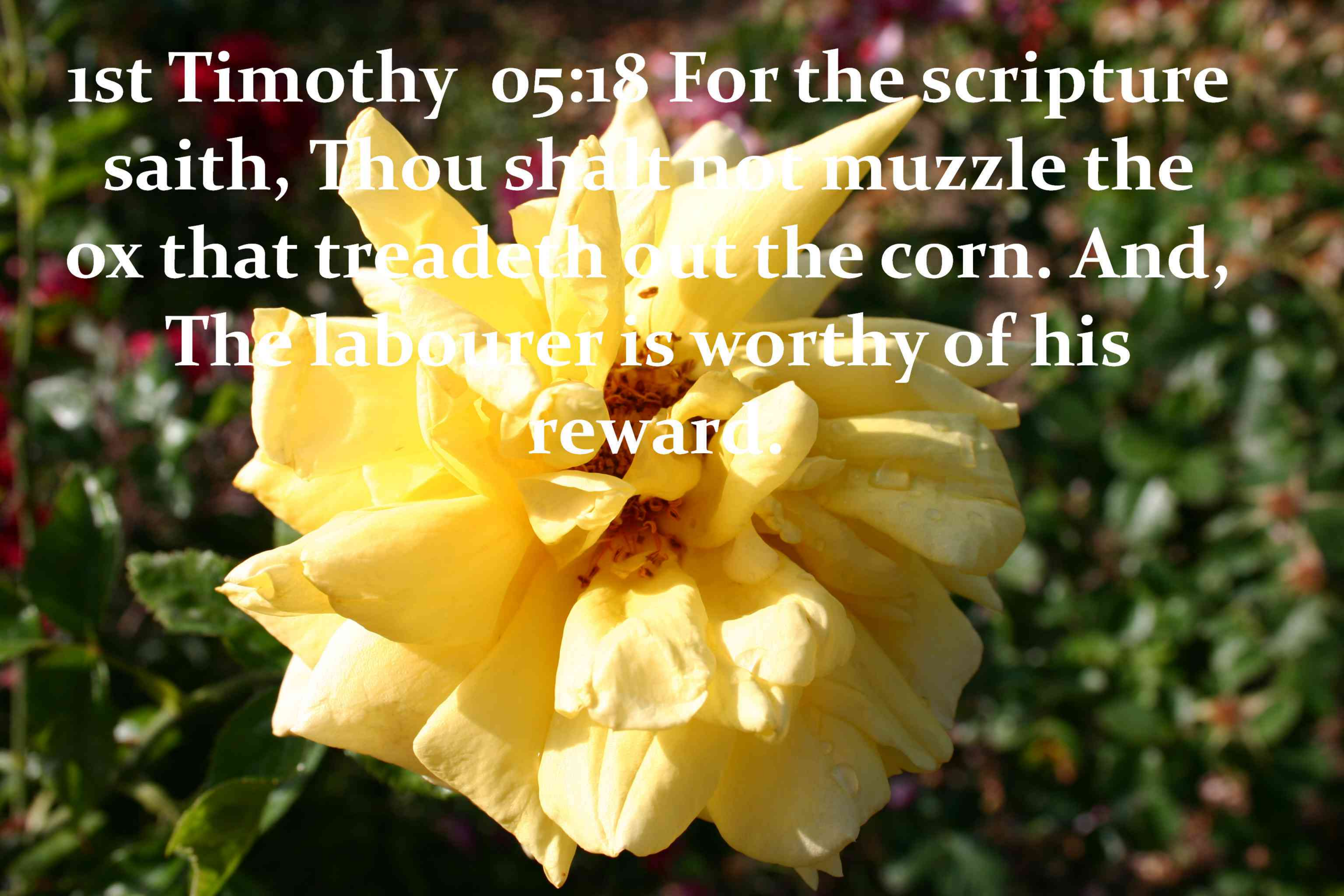
Micah 05:06 And they shall waste

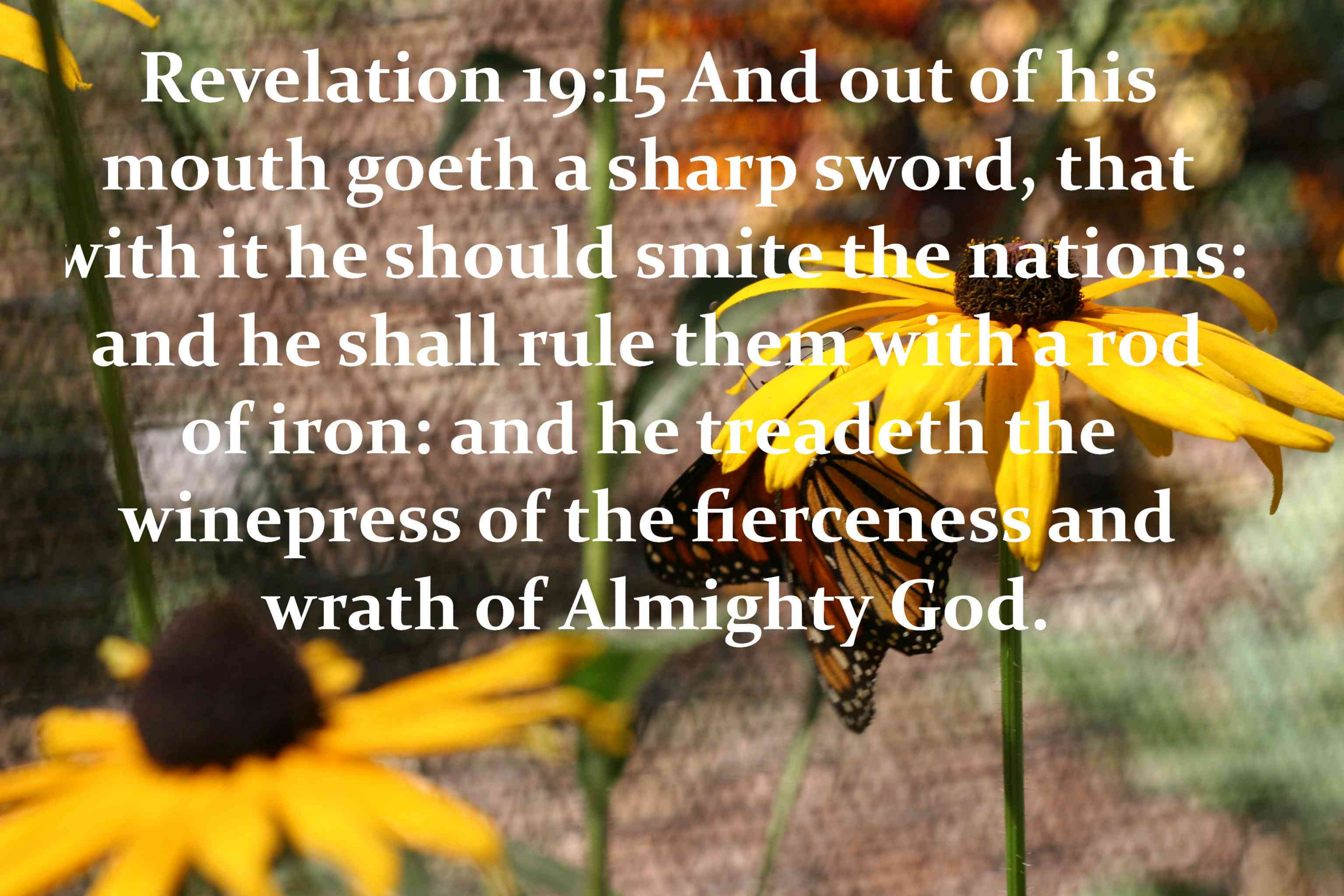
Micah 05:08 And the remnant of
